

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques Will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a Cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no Exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques: Payable in Canadian Funds, or At Par, they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the Process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and co-operation is appreciated. Thank you!

Information for US Exhibitors on entering Canada

To enter Canada from the States, US Citizens must show proof of identity: however As of June 1, 2009, to enter back into the U.S.A., all U.S. Citizens age 16 or older Must have a valid Passport or Approved Secure Travel Document.

*Please be aware that all dogs must have a valid rabies certificate to cross the border. NOTE: dogs less than three months of age do not require a rabies vaccination

NOTICE TO ALL CANADIAN RESIDENTS ONLY

NEW C.K.C RULE:

Section 24-12-3.(April 2011) Non-member participation fee

- A) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of C.K.C.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice to either become a C.K.C. member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER FOR FOREIGN DOGS

Effective Jan 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering C.K.C. events will no longer require a C.K.C. registration number but will require an EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the C.K.C. for breeding Purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign born and Foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the C.K.C. Each dog must have its own Number. Dogs may be entered as LISTED; however, failure to apply for an ERN Number within 30 days of the first event will result in the CANCELLATION of any Wins, awards, or scores. Forward your request to The Canadian Kennel club, Show And Trials Division, 200 Ronson Drive, Etobicoke, On. M9W 5Z9.

To obtain an ERN number, simply do the following: Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership With a written request for an ERN number. Include payment in full amount \$59.53 (Canadian). Provide a full return address. Faxed request will be accepted. Please Ensure that your Visa & or Mastercard number is legible and you have included the Expiry date and your signature. Fax: 1-416-675-6506.

GENERAL INFORMATION\

Meet at 8:00 a.m., dogs to line at 8:30 a.m.. Check in with the marshall on arrival. Running order will be determined by a draw: if possible handlers with more than One dog will run in non-consecutive order. Include the name of the handler on the Entry form. A running list will be available at the tests.

A dog that is individually registered in the records of the C.K.C. (or has an ERN or PEN), and has completed the requirements for a WC or WCI may be transferred to The next level provided the request is submitted to the test secretary in writing by 6 p.m. the day prior to the test.

Pheasants, duck, chukars or any other regional game birds may be used on land for the Hunt test. Pheasants, ducks or pigeons may be used on land for the WC tests.

General Information continued;

Ducks will be used in water for both the hunt and working certificate tests.

No confirmation of receipt of entry will be sent.

All qualifying dogs will be awarded a rosette or ribbon.

Separate entry forms should be completed for each dog and each test entered.

All handlers in the hunt test must wear dark or camouflage clothing. No white

Or light clothing is allowed in the working certificate test.

All dogs must be kept under control at all times.

Bitches in season may NOT be entered in the WC tests or the Hunt tests.

Lunches must be pre-ordered at a cost of \$8.00 per lunch.

Tailgate dinner on Saturday night at a cost of \$8.00 per person. Bring your own meat To BBQ, all else will be provided.

SECTION 19.7 of the Hunt Test Regulations and SECTION 14.7 of the Working Certificate Regulations state that: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving Club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held Under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Test committee Chair Shall promptly report to the C.K.C. any infringement of this regulations, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as is deemed fit on Receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.


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Driving directions to Mud Lake Rd
