Location & Facility

Camping

Camping is in a separate field from the Obedience / Rally area and will be open from 5:00 pm onwards on Wednesday, July 10th. When you arrive at Wet Noses, the camping area is on your right-hand side in a field north of the Obedience / Rally rings. Concession


Coffee and snacks are offered each morning. Limited Lunch concession each day \$10. Cash Only.
