

GENERAL INFORMATION

Conformation Show Rules and Regulations and Obedience Trial & Rally Obedience Trial Rules & Regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. In Canada call toll free 1-800-250-8040, in the United States call 1-416-675-5511. They are also online at www.ckc.ca. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show which will be governed by CKC Rules. Entries will be acknowledged after close of entries with receipt and judging schedule. This Show will be open from 7:00 AM until completion of judging. Dogs must be on the show grounds one hour before the judging of their class. Judging will not commence before 8:00 AM.

Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. The starting time for each ring will be specified in the Judging Schedule.

PLEASE NOTE: You are responsible for cleaning up if your dog relieves itself.

The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors, patrons, or property.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: (Chapter 19, Section 19.7 of Conformation Show Rules and Regulations) "It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities.

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Obedience comes into season, after the entry of the bitch has been submitted, if a Veterinarian certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial) to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial. Entry fees shall NOT be refunded after the closing date. Nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the EKKOC it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Dogs and children must be kept under control as a courtesy to fellow exhibitors and spectators.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in U.S. funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

BREEDS, CLASSES, AWARDS AND STAKES 12.2.1

OFFICIAL CLASSES - CONFORMATION

All of these classes must be divided by sex. Every dog within these precincts (exceptions are IN TRANSIT AREA) must be entered in one of the Regular Official Classes or for Exhibition Only.

The following classes will be provided:

JUNIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
SENIOR PUPPY	Dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
12-18 MONTHS	Dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show
CANADIAN BRED	Dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded.
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for
BRED BT EXHIBITOR	further awards.
OPEN CLASS	For all dogs
SPECIALS ONLY	For dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number, ERN or MSC Number must
SPECIALS UNLT	be indicated on the entry form at time of closing.

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES - CONFORMATION

In order for a dog to be entered in any Non-Regular or Unofficial class, dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. Dogs may be spayed or neutered.

The following classes will be provided:

The following diasses will be provided.	<u> </u>
BABY PUPPY	Dogs between 3 months and under 6 months on day of show. These puppies are not eligible to compete for championship points. This class will be judged after Best Puppy in Breed, after Best Puppy in Group and BEFORE Best in Show. Puppies in this category may enter and compete in Sweepstakes if a 3-6 months class is offered.
VETERAN	Dogs 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Best of Breed. Dogs may be spayed or neutered. This class will be judged after Best Baby Puppy in Breed, after Best Baby Puppy in Group and BEFORE Best in Show.
EXHIBITION ONLY	Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MONTHS)	Puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 Months <u>provided the owner(s)</u> has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. Puppies in this category may enter and compete in <u>Sweepstakes if a 3-6 months class is offered.</u>

OFFICIAL CLASSES - OBEDIENCE

The following classes will be provided:

PRE NOVICE	This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of P.C.D (Pre-Companion Dog). Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together in the Group Exercise. A dog that has earned the title of C.D. is not eligible for this class. This class is an elective class and earning the title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.
NOVICE A	This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. No person who has previously trained or exhibited a dog through its C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent) title shall be allowed to handle a dog in this class.
NOVICE B	This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has not earned the title of C.D. (Companion Dog). Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Novice A and Novice B class at any one trial.
NOVICE C	This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D., C.D.X., U.D., or any Obedience Trial Championship Title prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Dogs in this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog must have a separate handler for the group exercises. Dogs may compete in the Novice C class indefinitely. Scores earned by dog in the Novice C Class are not eligible for High in Trial and do not qualify a dog for any title.

	This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D., C.D.X., U.D., or any	
	Obedience Trial Championship. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High in	
NOVICE INTERMEDIATE	Trial. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. This class is an elective class and earning the title	
NOVICE INTERMEDIATE	is not a requirement to enter the Open classes.	
	This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. but has not earned the	
OPEN A	title of C.D.X. (Companion Dog Excellent). Only one dog may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor.	
OFENA	The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person who has previously	
	trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a U.D. title may not handle a dog in this class.	
	This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of C.D. in Canada. Dogs in	
	this class may be handled by any person. More than one dog may be entered by any handler, but each dog	
OPEN B	must have a separate handler for the group exercises. No dog may be entered in both Open A and Open B at	
	any one trial. A dog that has earned the title of C.D.X. must compete in Open B. Dogs eligible for entry in the	
	Utility Class are also eligible for entry in this class.	
	This is for any dog of any recognized or listed breed that has earned the title of C.D.X., but has not earned	
UTILITY A	the title of U.D The dog must be handled by the owner or a member of his immediate family. Any person	
	who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.C.H title may not handle dogs in this class.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES - OBEDIENCE

The following classes will be provided (Saturday Only):

VETERAN CLASS	For any dog that has earned the title or CD or higher and is 7 years old or older on the day of the trial.
BRACE CLASS	Open to any 2 dogs of any breed that have earned the title of CD or higher.
TEAM CLASS	Open to any 4 dogs of any breed that have earned the title of CD or higher.

OFFICIAL CLASSES – RALLY OBEDIENCE (Ring Size: 50 ft. x 70 ft.)

The following classes will be provided:

RALLY NOVICE A	Dogs entered in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (RN) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or member of their immediate family. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. Dogs that have earned titles or are not the owners may enter in the Novice B class. All exercises are judged on leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.
RALLY NOVICE B	Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced class has been earned. The owner or any person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged on leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
RALLY INTERMEDIATE	This class shall be for dogs that have earned the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other Obedience of Rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely.
RALLY ADVANCED A	This class is for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (RA) titleor any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate family. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
RALLY ADVANCED B	This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (RN) title. Upon completing the Rally Advanced (RA) title a dog may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any person may handle dogs in this class. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
RALLY EXCELLENT A	This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (RE) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. A dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class after official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title (RE). No dog may be entered in both Rally Excellent A & B at any one trial. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or member of their immediate family. All exercises are judge off leash and the dog must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.
RALLY EXCELLENT B	This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (RA) title. A dog may compete in this class indefinitely. Any person is allowed to handle a dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash and dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

UNOFFICIAL CLASSES - RALLY OBEDIENCE

(Ring Size: 50 ft. x 70 ft.)

The following classes will be provided (Saturday Only):

BRACE CLASS	Open to any 2 dogs of any breed that have earned the title of RN or higher.
TEAM CLASS	Open to any 4 dogs of any breed that have earned the title of RN or higher.

For information only: Rally Advanced Excellent title -- Upon completion of the Rally Excellent title, qualifying scores may be accumulated from Rally Advanced B and Rally Excellent B to earn the Rally Advanced Excellent (RAE) title. To receive the RAE title, a dog must qualify ten (10) times in both Rally Advanced and Rally Excellent at the same trial. The title will appear at the end of the dog's name and a numeric designation will indicate the number of times the dog has met the requirements, i.e. RAE2, RAE3, etc.

To be eligible to compete in these obedience or rally obedience trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked.

It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to know the CKC rules governing rally or obedience trials.

Listing fees are required for any dog without an individual CKC or ERN Registration number. The owner(s) must then submit an application for registration to the CKC within thirty (30) days. Failure to comply with these rulings will automatically cancel all points on record. Any "Listed Breed" MUST HAVE A MSC NUMBER PRIOR TO ENTERING ANY CKC EVENT.

Please use the official entry form enclosed. <u>IF THE SAME DOG IS ENTERED IN 2 REGULAR OFFICIAL OBEDIENCE OR RALLY</u> OBEDIENCE TRIAL CLASSES ON THE SAME DAY, PLEASE FILL OUT SEPARATE ENTRY FORMS FOR EACH CLASS.

Cheques post-dated to closing date WILL be accepted. Any NSF cheques will be assessed a \$50 service charge. Tendering a dishonoured cheque or declined credit card in payment of an entry fee shall be considered non-payment of said fee and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards (Chapter 8.8.2, Conformation Show Rules and Regulations).

No entry will be accepted without payment in full. There will be no refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments.

The owner of the dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of their dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.
