WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

An Exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone, however written or e-mail notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

DAY-OF-TRIAL ENTRIES

Day-of-trial entries will be accepted both February 11 and 12, 2023 if limit not reached. Entries must be made at least 1 hour before the start of the trial. Day-of-trial entries will be cash only.

BENCHING

Limited Benching Only – Reserved spots for multiple dog competitors are crates only and must be reserved/approved. Sign up by emailing <u>slmogenson@sasktel.net</u> after entries close. No ex-pens allowed.

JUNIOR HANDLING (Obedience)

Junior Handling (Obedience) will be held Saturday following the award of High in Trial in Trial 2. Entries will be taken on Saturday, on site. Entry Fee: \$2.00.

Classes Offered: Junior Obedience Pre-Novice / Intermediate Obedience Pre-Novice / Senior Obedience Pre-Novice / Junior Obedience Novice / Intermediate Obedience Novice / Senior Obedience Novice / Junior Obedience Open / Intermediate Obedience Open / Senior Obedience Open

Held under CKC Rules. Dogs handled in the competition must be entered in the trial on that day.

Juniors must enter (at their appropriate age level) either Pre-Novice, Novice or Open.

The SKOC will be offering: Ribbons for placements 1 through 4 in all classes and a Rosette for the Best Overall in Junior Obedience.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The scoop-up requirements will be strictly enforced.
- There will be **NO "In Transit"** area provided. Only dogs entered in official classes are permitted within the precincts of the trial (6.7.2).
- There will be no "overnight" kenneling.
- Only approved CKC collars will be allowed in the precincts of the trials.
- SHOWING correct information on the entry form is the responsibility of the entrant. However, Exhibitors incorrectly entered in the "A" class are permitted to move the dog to the corresponding "B" class up to 30 minutes before the start of the trial. The SKOC takes no responsibility for omissions or errors made on the entry forms. The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to the CKC rules.

- BITCHES IN SEASON: Obedience entry fees WILL be gladly refunded to exhibitors whose females are in season during the trials (and must be withdrawn) IF: a dated veterinarian's certificate is produced prior to the trial.
- THE PRECINCTS of these trials shall be the Royal Canadian Legion at 3021 Louise Street, Saskatoon, building & grounds.
- KNOWLEDGE of the Canadian Kennel Club Rules is the responsibility of the entrant. Rule books may be obtained from the CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB, 200 Ronson Drive, Suite 400, ETOBICOKE ON M9W 5Z9, Telephone: 416-675-5511
- The SKOC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune, either to dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
- All dogs must be under complete control at all times
- ◆ 20.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an obedience or rally trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

PLEASE NOTE:

When entering the same dog in multiple classes using a PAPER ENTRY FORM, a separate entry form MUST be filled out for EACH class.

Payment may be made online using a credit card (VISA, MasterCard, American Express) <u>or</u> by Interac or e-Transfer. Paper entries may be paid by cash or cheque.
