NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- These trials are being held under the Canadian Kennel Club (CKC) regulations.
- Competitors, through the submission of an entry, acknowledge that they know CKC Obedience and/or Rally rules.
- On line registration only: www.guidescanins.com/en/trials. No paper version. Please phone us to register over the phone if you have trouble or if you don't have access to a computer: 450-424-1469.
- This trial is open to all dogs, purebred and non purebred that have a CKC number.
- Entries are limited. We reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- The payment must be received with or immediately follow the registration form.
- The classes cost \$30. A listing fee of \$8,80 per dog for each entry per trial must be included with your entry, if you are not able to show on your entry form the CKC individual registration number or an event registration number.
- It will be possible to register after the closing date or on site, if there is still room. The cost for late entries will be \$35/class.
- A ribbon will be awarded to each team earning a qualifying score. Placement rosette will be awarded from 1st to 4th place. Tittle ribbons will be awarded for each titles.
- Trophies and prices will be offered to
 - o All the 1st places by Eukanuba

- o All the High in Trial will get a rosette and \$50
- o The highest scoring Doberman per trial by the DPCGM
- o The highest scoring Change of Pace Student per day by Jane McNee
- Dogs who have earned a CKC title may advance to a higher level provided that the secretary is notified in writing as soon as the results are published or before the end of the day. Same day move ups are accepted.
- There shall be no refunds, cancellation or changes after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition regardless of the reason for such a dismissal or in the event of inclement weather.
- Participants cancelling before the closing date will obtain a refund (by check or on their credit card).
- A refund will be issued for bitches that come into heat or dogs that are injured, providing that the trial secretary is advised within 24 hours of the start of the trial.
- Any refund issued will be minus a 10% administrative fee.
- A \$20 fees will be charged for NSF checks and refused credit cards.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION

- These trials will take place at GUIDES CANINS, 1200A montée Poirier, St-Lazare, indoors, on synthetic grass. Crating will be in an other big room.
- The ring fences are 24 inches high and have aluminium uprights with a mesh curtain.
- The Rally ring is 40'X50' and the obedience ones 30'X40'
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report that this has occurred.
