- Field Trial Rule 21.7: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The
- Retriever Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred".

There will be a system of rotation for running order in all stakes.

Any entry scratched after the catalogue has been printed, will require a veterinary certificate for any refund. A \$5.00 administration fee will be deducted from all refunds.


RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION OF LANDOWNERS AND OTTAWA RETRIEVER CLUB
