The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue. (15.7)

A judge officiating at a trial under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out. (3.7.1)

#### **REFUND POLICY**

If, due to COVID, these Trials are not able to be held; refunds will be issued to exhibitors - MINUS 20%. While all efforts will be taken to expedite refunds, they may take up to 14 days (depending on volume & other work commitments).

If because of; an act of God, riot, civil disturbance, extreme weather event, governmental orders, regulations, or decree, or other acts or circumstances beyond the control of the CDC, it is impossible to open or complete the Shows/Trials, no refund of entry fees will be made.

**ENTRIES CLOSE at 7:00 p.m. AST on Wednesday, May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023  
DRAWING at 8:00 p.m. AST on Saturday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023**

- Entries will be limited to the number of dogs able to run during daylight hours, and based on the availability of birds.
- Entries may close prior to 7:00 p.m. AST Wednesday, May 31<sup>st</sup>, if full
- Entries withdrawn after closing must still pay the appropriate fees, failure to do so, will be considered "outstanding" payment
- Running order draw will take place at the home of the Test Secretary and will be published after drawing
- The order & time of tests will be determined once entries close
- The drawing will be "random", and specific times cannot be assigned
- It is the responsibility of entrants to confirm receipt of their entries
- **An INCOMPLETE ENTRY FORM WILL BE RETURNED. Please ensure that your postal code is included.**

### **Temporary Competition Number (TCN) - Effective January 1, 2023**

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). **Listed Breeds that do not yet have a Miscellaneous Class Number (MCN) number will be eligible to apply for a TCN.**

There is no fee to obtain a TCN however exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN fees (formerly called Listing Fees) when entering events using a TCN.

TCN Numbers may be obtained online via the CKC website where the number is issued instantly. Exhibitors may also mail in a printed application or contact CKC Shows and Trials by phone for a number. If your dog does not have a registration number or ERN and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores or awards, before applying for a TCN online, exhibitors are encouraged to check their dog's profiles to determine if the CKC has already created a TCN for that dog. There will be a tab call TCN Dogs in the owner's Portal account.

### **Event Registration Number (ERN)**

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN) from the Canadian Kennel Club. **Effective January 1, 2023**, the policy has been changed to allow Listed Breeds registered with a different Canadian registry to also apply for an ERN. **Canadian Born dogs that are registrable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an ERN.**

To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

1. Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership to CKC, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you.
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicated your Visa/MasterCard number expiry date, cardholders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "LISTED", however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores. Please forward your request to:

**COURSE & GAME:**

- Chukar will be used in all categories. If DNR will not allow the import of Chukar, Quail will be used in all categories.
- Ducks/chukar/and/or pigeons will be used in the FDX, FDXCh water retrieve
- Gunning will be done by "official" gunners only
- FDJ, FD, FDA, FDX, FDXCh course will be single course with bird field
- FDJ and FD dogs will be run individually, FDA, FDX, FDXCh dogs will be run in braces
- Handlers must carry a starter pistol. For safety reasons, we require **ALL** entrants & **ALL** gallery members to wear blaze orange outer garments (vest or jacket) and blaze orange headgear.

**It is mandatory that Judges, Handlers of the working dogs and Marshals wear a blaze orange outer garment (vest or jacket) and blaze orange headgear in any tests where shotguns are used. The requirements will also apply to any gallery members on the course. (11.5.1)**

**OTHER RULES:**

No training of dogs on the grounds during the tests

**Bitches in Season:** Bitches in season will be allowed to run only at the end of the final test on each day. We request that handlers please keep them away from all other dogs so that they do not become a hindrance to other dogs entered in the tests. A separate airing area will be made available.

**AWARDS:** Standard CKC Blue Ribbon to all dogs with a qualifying score.  
HQS Certificate in each category

A current record of vaccination may be required
