In July of 1985, Margaret acquired her first Soft Coated Wheaten Terrier. She was encouraged to take "Shawnie" to obedience classes. The astute instructors realized he was registered, and encouraged Margaret to train Shawnie with the hopes of entering obedience trials. Shawnie learned guickly and they both enjoyed the classes, so she continued.

At her first obedience trial a woman approached her and asked "why is that dog in obedience – he should be in the conformation ring!" And so started Margaret's love of competing in several dog related competitions including conformation, obedience, agility, scent hurdle racing and rally obedience. Margaret and her dogs were also active visiting schools, hospitals, Christmas parties and nursing homes.

As a breeder, Margaret's first concern was always temperament. She heavily scrutinized everyone who was interested in acquiring one of her puppies.

Margaret was a life member of the Regina Kennel and Obedience Club. She put many titles on her dogs and in later years continued to compete in rally and obedience – all while using a walker. She was an inspiration to many of us and was admired by her competitors. Margaret continued to train her dogs until shortly before her passing. We will miss her gregarious personality. Her love of the Soft Coated Wheaten Terrier breed was second to none. Rest in Peace Margaret.



CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

<u>SECTION 1</u> – A dog awarded *Winners* at a championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be accredited to a dog awarded Winners shall be provided hereunder.

SECTION 2 – The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded. **Winners** shall be as follows.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge **shall not** be included in the calculation for championship points.

The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded Winners also places in the GROUP as listed below.

A class dog awarded **Best in Show** at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In **no** case may a dog earn more than **five** (5) points at a **single show.** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number. (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level. (15.1.13).

<u>Best Puppy in Breed</u> – Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award for Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed, is NOT required to stay to compete for Best Puppy in Group (15.3.1f)

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles, (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career. NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above. 2. Grandfathering of the previous version of the Grand Champion Excellent title will be honored up until Dec 31, 2022.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of **Chapter 20** of the **Dog Show Rules**, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing **at least one (1) hour prior to breed judging**, by the owner or handler.

Effective January 1994: If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration before the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes with a **TCN** number. A move up form will be required to do this. TCN fees, however, WILL NOT be refunded.

An error in an age specific class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the judging of the breed in question. Rule (8.2.5)

EXHIBITORS ARE EXPECTED TO KNOW THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR DOG SHOWS AND OBEDIENCE TRIALS. BOOKLETS ON DOG SHOW AND OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES ARE AVAILABLE FROM THE C.K.C.

SHOW RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Providing correct information on entry forms is the responsibility of the entrant. The show committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Entry forms must be the same size and format as those included or they will be rejected.
- 2. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone entries WILL NOT be accepted. Email will be accepted. See instructions elsewhere in this premium list.
- 3. Post-dated cheques ARE NOT accepted. Tendering of an N.S.F. cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offense punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A \$25.00 SERVICE CHARGE WILL BE LEVIED ON ALL N.S.F. CHEQUES AND INVALID OR DECLINED CREDIT CARDS.
- 4. Entry fees WILL NOT be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, sick, lame, excused by the veterinarian or judge, in season or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly.
- 5. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date may be made by telephone, but MUST BE FOLLOWED UP **IN WRITING** to the Show Secretary so as to be received prior to closing.
- 6. The entry of any dog cannot be altered or canceled after entries close, except as provided in the Dog Show Rules.
- 7. After the closing of entries, an identification/receipt and judging schedule will be emailed to each exhibitor or agent. Owners making entries please include agent's email address. All online will receive a conformation email, this is your receipt for our shows. Please print your email address clearly.
- 8. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES.
- 9. The Show Committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dog, exhibitor or patron. The Show Giving Club will not be liable for any loss or injury that may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft, and/or death of dogs entered in the show under any circumstances.
- 10. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- 11. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Chapter 24, Section 6, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules states "Any person participating in any capacity at a dog show held under these Rules shall not be subjected to indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and the obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out."
- 12. ACCORDING TO CITY BYLAW, DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OFF LEAD WITHIN CITY LIMITS. Exercise dogs only in designated areas. Anyone not following stop and scoop policy will be excused from the shows and trials.
- 13. There will be a 10% processing fee for any entries paid by credit card or by using on the online entry service.

Non-Member Participation Fee

24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.
