NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

An annual "Non-member" participation fee for Awards and Titles will be charged to a Canadian "non-member" of the Canadian Kennel Club. This fee will match the fee charged for Event Registration Number.

In order to protect the Awards and Titles earned, the "non-member" will have a choice to (a) either become a CKC member; or (b) pay the "non-member" participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause All Awards and Titles to be cancelled.

Please Note: These fees only apply to dogs wholly owned by "Non-CKC" members and are not applicable to CKC members.

NO POST DATED CHEQUES ACCEPTED. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of **\$25.00**. N.S.F. cheques are considered **Non-Payment of entry fees** and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the shows/trials.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian Funds. If you send a cheque in US Funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable In Canadian Funds", they will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge you to purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

Champion & Championship Points ~ Chapter 1 Section 1 ~ A dog awarded Winners at a Championship Show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of Championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to the dog awarded winners shall be as provided hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an All Breed Championship Show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points won at the Breed or Group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at a single show. **NOTE: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation of Championship points.**

CONFORMATION MOVING UP TO SPECIALS

A dog individually registered in the records of the CKC and has completed the requirement for a Championship in accordance with CKC Rules, after the closing date and time for the show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "specials Only", providing the request is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING and on the appropriate form at least one hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. When one or more Championship shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving a Class dog to Specials must be made a minimum one hour prior to the scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up.

NON-PUREBRED DOGS IN OBEDIENCE AND RALLY TRIALS

Non-purebred dogs will be accepted in both Obedience and Rally Obedience Trials. If entering your non-purebred dog in either of these trials, your dog will be required to have a Canine Companion Number. Please check the CKC Policy and Procedures Manual Chapter 6.34 (found on line at the CKC website) for requirements to obtain your dog's CCN.

RALLY OBEDIENCE CLASSES

Exhibitors entering both obedience and Rally must fill out separate entry forms
Rally Obedience Classes are as follows: Novice “A”, Novice “B”, Advanced “A”, Advanced “B”
Excellent “A” and Excellent “B” and the new Intermediate Class.

BITCHES IN SEASON REFUND

Bitches coming into season MAY NOT compete in Obedience. Entry fees will be refunded ONLY if the Trial Secretary receives a Veterinarian’s Certificate PRIOR to the commencement of the Trial.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL MOVE UP

A dog that is individually registered in the records of the CKC and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with Section 9.4.2 and 10.4.2 of the Obedience Rules may be moved up to the next level of Obedience Competition providing the transfer was submitted to the Trial Secretary in WRITING, by the owner or handler, one hour prior to the opening of the first trial. When one or more trials are held on the same day in the same venue, the request for moving the dog up must be made a minimum of one hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial for which the dog is being moved up, TRIAL SCHEDULE PERMITTING.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will require an Events Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply do the following:

1. send a photocopy of the dog’s Registration Certificate reflecting current ownership, for example AKC Registration Certificate with a written request for an ERN.
2. Include with the above a cheque or money order in the amount currently required payable to the Canadian Kennel Club.
3. Ensure that you provide the CKC with your full return address to enable the ERN to be sent to you
4. Faxed requests will be accepted. Please indicate your VISA/MasterCard number and expiry date, the card holders name and signature.

This Event Registration Number **MUST** be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as “LISTED”, however, failure to apply for an ERN within 30 days will result in cancellation of any wins, awards or scores.

PRIZES

Suitable prizes & rosettes will be offered each day for the following: Best In Show, Best Puppy in Show, Best Altered in Show and Best Baby Puppy in Show. Rosettes will be awarded each day for: Reserve Best In Show, Best in Group, Puppy In Group, Baby Puppy In Group, Altered In Group, all dogs placing Group 2nd to 4th. Best of Breed and all other class placings will receive Flat Ribbons. Obedience prizes: a suitable prize and Rosette will be awarded for High In Trial and High In Class. All Qualifying Scores will receive flat ribbons. Rally- Obedience ~ flat ribbons will be awarded to all Qualifying Dogs. A Rosette and suitable award to dog attaining High In Class, a Rosette will be awarded to dogs placing 2nd through 4th in each class.

RULES & RULE BOOKS

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer or participant at any event held under CKC Rules, is not subjected to indignities of any kind. The Show Committee shall promptly report any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of report, indicating that this has occurred.

A copy of the Rules pertaining Dog Shows and/or Obedience Trials is available from the Canadian Kennel Club 1-416-675-5511. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to know the rules pertaining to these events.

PRECINCTS OF THE SHOW

The precincts of the Show and Trials will be the entire building.

JUDGING SCHEDULES

Judging Schedules and receipts will be mailed to all entrants as soon as possible after the closing date. The schedule will also be posted to the “Canuck Dog” website at

www.canuckdogs.com

Instructions to getting to the show site are to be found at the end of the Judging Schedule.

GENERAL INFORMATON

1. The Show Superintendent will be in complete charge of these events, which are governed by CKC rules.
2. The Building will be open at 5:30 P.M. Friday 25 Sept 2015 for set up. The building will open daily at 7:00 a.m. & close at 10:00 p.m.

3. To comply with **CITY OF MIRAMICHI & TOWN OF SUNNY CORNER** regulations **NO SMOKING WILL BE PERMITTED WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE BUILDING.**
4. Dogs should be on standby at their respective areas 30 minutes prior to commencement of judging. Judges are not required to wait for late arrivals and will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. There will be no PA system used to call dogs to the ring. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to advise that a dog is absent.
5. **No “Puppy or Dog For Sale” signs will be permitted in the building.**
6. The Miramichi Kennel Club will use all care and diligence for the welfare of the dogs and the exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume liability, in the event of an accident or any misfortune to either dog, exhibitor or patron.
7. If because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund or return of entry fees will be made.
