Canine Companion Number

As of July 1, 2014, mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds are allowed to compete in the CKC Performance events of Obedience, Rally and Agility, provided that the club in question has so declared in it's premium list to enter any trial. The dog must have a CCN number. A dog in this category may not be entered as 'listed'. The application form for the CCN (Canine Companion Number) can be found on the CKC website, under Forms On-Line, Registration.

Border Crossing - A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and must be dated at least 30 days prior to the entry into Canada. Passports or enhanced Drivers Licenses are also required to enter Canada.

Note: Day of Trial entries will be accepted in both Obedience & Rally. These entries must be submitted to the Trial Secretary one hour prior to the commencement of the said trials.

BITCHES IN SEASON (6.10.1 & 6.10.2) - Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entry has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial. The Trial giving club must refund the entry fee, service charges and listing fees. The refund and terms thereof must be clearly stated in premium list.

Rally Obedience Classes

No dog may be entered in both Novice "A" and Novice "B" or Open "A" & Open "B" at the same trial.

RALLY NOVICE A - Dogs competing in this class may not have won a CKC Rally Novice (R.N.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY NOVICE B - Any dog may compete in this class until a qualifying score in the Rally Advanced Class is earned. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged on leash, and all dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY INTERMEDIATE - This class shall be for dogs that have earned the R.N. title. A dog completing the R.I. or any other obedience or rally titles may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class

RALLY ADVANCED A - This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title but have not won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner, or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY ADVANCED B - This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Novice (R.N.) title. A dog completing the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off leash. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

RALLY EXCELLENT A - This class shall be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R. A.) title, but have not won the Rally Excellent (R. E.) title or any CKC Novice Obedience title. The handler of any dog in this class must be the owner, co-owner or a member of their immediate families. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. A dog may continue to compete in this class after the owner has been notified by at least 2 different judges that the dog has won 3 qualifying scores in this class. However, a dog may not be entered or exhibited in this class in any rally trial after the owner has received official notification from the CKC that the dog has won the title.

RALLY EXCELLENT B - This class will be for dogs that have won the Rally Advanced (R.A.) title. A dog completing the Rally Excellent (R.E.) title may continue to compete in this class indefinitely. The owner or any other person may handle dogs in this class. A person may enter more than one dog in this class. All exercises are judged off-leash except the Honor Exercise. All dogs must enter and leave the ring on leash.

Obedience Classes

No dog may be entered in both Novice "A" and Novice "B" at the same trial. No dog may be entered in both Open "A" and Open "B" at the same trial.

NOVICE "A" - This class is open to all dogs, providing the dog has not earned the title of "CD" in ANY COUNTRY. The dog does not have to be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class. One dog *ONLY* may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor *MUST BE THE OWNER* or *A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY* and *MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES*. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in Canada or Elsewhere shall be allowed to compete in this class, but must compete in the Novice "B" class.

NOVICE "B" - This class is open to all dogs that have not earned the title of "CD" in Canada. Dogs in this class may be shown by the owner or any other person. The dog does not have to be CKC or ERN Reg'd to compete in this class.

OPEN "A" - This class is open to all dogs which have earned the title of "CD" IN CANADA, but have not earned the title of "CDX" in any country. One dog *ONLY* may be entered in this class by any one exhibitor. The exhibitor *MUST BE THE OWNER* or *A MEMBER OF HIS/HER IMMEDIATE FAMILY* and *MUST SHOW THE DOG IN ALL EXERCISES*. No licensed handler, trainer or any person who has previously exhibited a dog through its "UD" title in

Canada or elsewhere shall be allowed to compete, but must compete in the Open "B" class. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class.

OPEN "B" - This class is open to all dogs that have earned the title of "CD" in CANADA, and may be shown by the owner or any other person. This dog *MAY ALSO COMPETE IN THE UTILITY CLASS*. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class

UTILITY CLASS 'A' - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" but has not earned the title of U.D. Any person who has trained or exhibited a dog that has earned a M.O.T.Ch title may not handle dogs in this class. This dog must be shown by the owner or a member of their immediate families. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter More than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. When a dog is wrongfully entered in this class any score will be cancelled.

UTILITY CLASS 'B' - This class is open to any dog of any recognized or listed breed which has earned the title of "CDX" or U.D. Dogs in this class may be handled by the owner or any other person. A CKC or ERN Reg'd number must be provided on the entry form at time of closing of entries to be eligible to compete in this class. Owners may enter more than one dog in this class. The same person must handle the dog in all exercises. No dog may be entered in both the Utility A and Utility B classes at any one trial. Prior to the start of judging, the judge will decide the order of exercises to be performed. This order will not be disclosed to exhibitors until it is posted at ringside, approx. 30 mins prior to the start of the class.

Transition Obedience Classes

PRE - NOVICE – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have not earned the title of P.C.D. (Pre-Companion Dog) in Canada. Dogs being entered in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class and must have an additional handler for each dog when they are judged together on the Group exercise. A dog may be entered in the Pre-Novice that has not earned the title of C.D. in Canada or a comparable title in any other country. The Pre-Novice class is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to the Novice Classes.

NOVICE "C" – This class is open to any dog of either sex that has gained the title Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada prior to the closing date of the trial in which it is to be entered. Exhibitors may enter more than one dog in this class but must have a separate handler for each dog in the Long Sit and the Long Down Exercises when they are judged in the same group. The Novice 'C' exercises will be performed and judged as described in the official Novice Class except that exhibitors may compete in the Novice 'C' Class indefinitely. Scores earned by dogs entered in the Novice 'C' Class are not eligible for High In Trial. The P.C.D. and C.D.I. and Novice 'C' are elective classes which are offered for those people who feel the dog requires ring experience and acclimation to the trial situation or would like to earn additional titles. Dogs may be entered in the Novice – Intermediate (C.D.I.) and/or Novice 'C' class in addition to any of the Official Classes or Unofficial Classes.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS – This class shall be for all purebred dogs and those breeds as designated on the list of miscellaneous breeds and of either sex, which have earned the title of (C.D.) Companion Dog, Companion Dog Excellent, Utility Dog or any other advanced Obedience title in Canada. A dog eligible for entry in the Open A or B Class at any obedience trial held under these rules is also eligible for entry in the Novice 'C' and Novice Intermediate Class at the same trial. The Novice Intermediate class (C.D.I.) is an elective class and earning a title is not a requirement to advance to a Companion Dog Excellent title. Scores earned by dogs competing in this class are not eligible for High In Trial. Dogs are eligible to compete in this class indefinitely. Dogs in this class may be handled or exhibited by the owner or any other person. A person may enter more than one dog in this class.

PLEASE NOTE: The word 'trainer' means any person who conducts or has conducted a dog obedience training class or who regularly assists with the training of dogs in said class or who regularly trains dogs belonging to any person outside his/her immediate family.

NOTE: Miscellaneous breeds entered in Obedience Trials that DO NOT have a Certification Number MAY ONLY COMPETE AT THE NOVICE level and MUST pay the Listing Fee applicable daily.

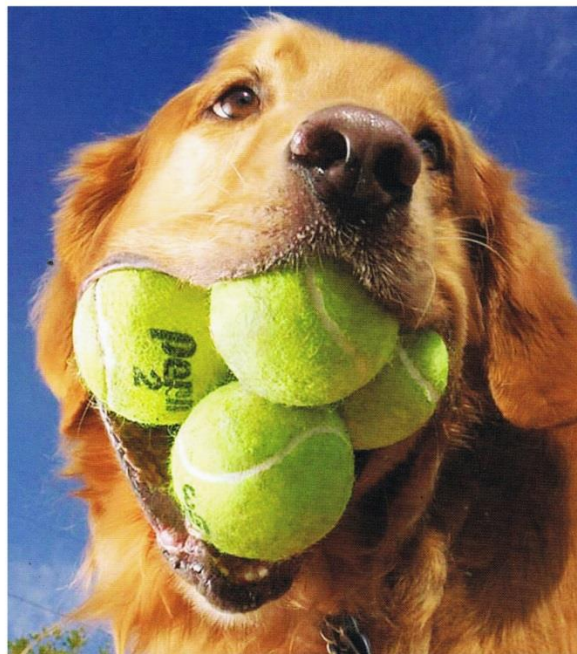

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THESE TRIALS

The club reserves the right to remove any person(s) from the show and the show grounds.

The Show Superintendent shall have full control of these shows and trials, which are governed by CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB (CKC) rules.

A Judge officiating at a trial held under the CKC rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

The Trial chairperson shall promptly investigate and report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation.

The Discipline committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on the report indicating that his rule has been violated.

Any person excused by the Show Superintendent or Veterinarian for any reason shall not compete in any class for any awards for the balance of the shows, trials and or events.

The Show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident or misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, spectators or vendors.

Dogs must be on the grounds 1 hour prior to their trialing. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.

Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and equipment left at the show grounds.

All recreational units will have buckets underneath for their sink drains. Anyone found discharging water on the grounds will be removed by order of the Health Department, and may be subject to fine.

If, because of civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, there is no refund of entry.

Dogs must be on leash at all times on show grounds or within the show building with the exception of the obedience rings.

Exhibitors are expected to maintain a clean area. Please be considerate when utilizing the building facilities. No dogs are permitted in the washrooms.

The welfare of any children is deemed to be the responsibility of the guardian or parent. Please exercise control and restraint over your child's behavior.

The club is not responsible for lost or stolen property from exhibitors or vendors/ concessions. The club reserves the right to refuse an individual entries vendors/concessions.

The club reserves the right to refuse an individuals entries, for just cause. The club reserves the right of restricting exhibitors space. Fire lanes in all areas will be maintained.

Entries which are incomplete after the closing date/time will not be accepted.

The precincts of these events will be the areas used exclusively by the Show-giving club
