If applicable, **TCN Fee** (See note below): \$10.50 per event. Note: formerly recorded as Listing Fee

LURE COURSING FIELD TRIAL STAKES OFFERED

- Open Stake – for all dogs, including Field Champions
- Mixed Stake – for multiple breeds with entries of three or less, upon agreement of all owners
- Unofficial Singles Stake – hounds run alone. Maximum 6 hounds per day. Open to ineligible or un-certified hounds otherwise ready to run a full course.

FIELD TRIAL CONFORMATION SHOW CLASSES

- Open - for all eligible lure coursing breeds
- Veterans - for dogs over 7 years, may be spayed or neutered
- Bred by Exhibitor
- Specials Only - for Canadian Champions only.
- Altered

NOTE: Hounds must be pre-entered to compete in the Conformation show and must complete the field trial with a qualifying score to be eligible to continue into the show. The owner of a dog entered in this trial is entirely responsible for any errors in the entering of the dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. The Conformation Show will commence approx. 45 minutes after the completion of the regular lure coursing stakes.

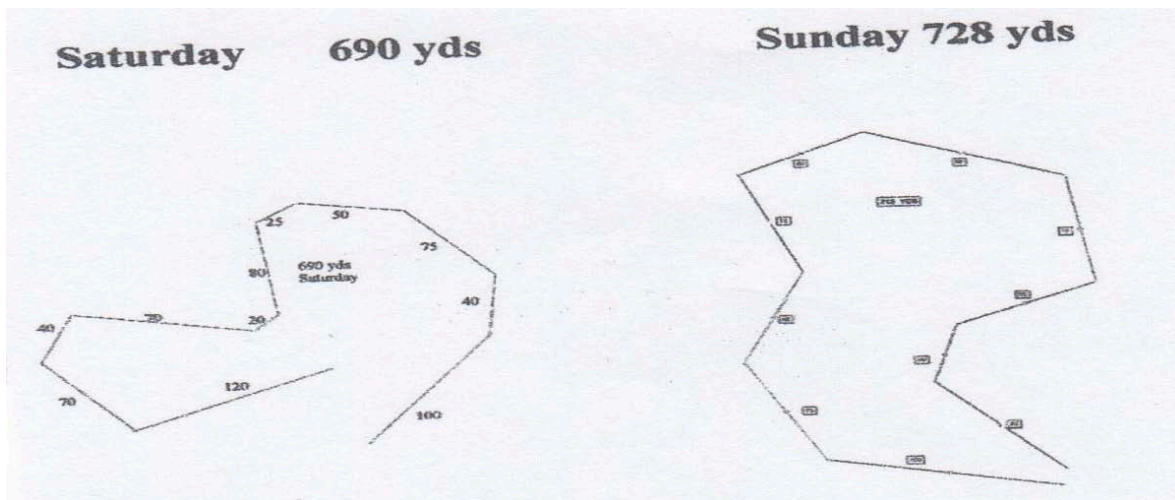

RUNNING ORDER SATURDAY AND SUNDAY: Italian Greyhound, Whippet, Greyhound, Basenji, Irish Wolfhound, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Scottish Deerhound, Ibizan, Afghan, Saluki, Pharaoh Hound, Borzoi, Azawakh, Mixed Stakes, Singles (Order may change)

EQUIPMENT & FIELD CONDITIONS: Course plans not to scale & may be altered to suit weather, field conditions and/or safety. Battery powered drag line with white plastic streamers. The field is gently rolling pasture **Note:** Layouts are subject to change.



NOTES AND INFORMATION

- All handlers must use a slip lead when releasing their hounds;
- Hounds may wear muzzles and/or catch collars at the owner/agent's discretion. Leg wraps must be in neutral colours;
- Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused and will have their entry fee returned if notice is given to the secretary prior to roll call. A Veterinarian certificate may be required;
- The Chairperson may excuse any hound from competition for any reason deemed justifiable;
- A \$10.00 fine, payable to WCOBC, will be levied for any hound loose on the field at any time between Roll Call and the completion of Regular classes;
- A \$10.00 fine, payable to WCOBC, will be levied for any exhibitor not cleaning up after their dog;
- There is limited shade and water is available to cool off/wash (NOT for drinking), so please come prepared;
- Limited overnight camping — no hookups. Contact Darlene Wolney timberidgetrails.com
- Our Field Trial Conformation Show will begin approx. 45 minutes after the Lure trial on Saturday;
- It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial

Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

- Any sighthound puppies of registered participants may arrange a Practice Run immediately after the lure coursing events are completed on Saturday, time permitting. Adults to be entered in unofficial singles.

Directions to the coursing and conformation site:

- About 25 minutes from Downtown Vernon BC
- From Vernon take Hwy 6 East (towards Lumby/Nelson)
- Drive through Lavington.
- Shortly after large lumber mill – turn Right onto Dure Meadow Road.
- At the T junction turn left onto WhiteVale Road
- Then turn Right onto Horner Road and follow windy way.
- Turn Left onto Kerby Road.
- Drive straight through gateway (your GPS will say you have arrived) which comes up shortly.
- Take the dirt road and at the fork go right. The field will appear on your left. Parking is at the far end of the Riding Ring.
- Cabins and the covered kitchen are ahead on the Right.

**** TEMPORARY COMPETITION NUMBERS (TCN) **** With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a Temporary Competition Number (TCN). TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs", and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent CKC registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). A TCN must be obtained BEFORE submitting an entry for any event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN. While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called listing fees) when entering events using this number. The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion. Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone. Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN, and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, scores, or awards, there is no need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will be updated accordingly. ALL RULES GOVERNING THESE EVENTS ARE AVAILABLE ON LINE FROM THE CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB. FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE RULES PERTAINING TO SOME FAQs ARE PRINTED BELOW.

ELIGIBLE COURSING ENTRIES

To be eligible for this trial, your dog **MUST** be a purebred of one of these following breeds: Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenjis, Borzois, Deerhounds (Scottish), Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgeback, Salukis, Whippets and 'Listed Sighthound Breeds' as defined by the CKC.

All entrants must be registered or be eligible for registration with the Canadian Kennel Club. Altered or neutered hounds **may** compete. Hounds presently disqualified under CKC, CSFA, ASFA or AKC rules are not eligible. Hounds must pre-qualify prior to entering their first trial in Canada.

ELIGIBLE CONFORMATION ENTRIES

Open to any AFGHAN, AZAWAKH, BASENJI, BORZOI, GREYHOUND, IBIZAN HOUND, PHARAOH HOUND, RHODESIAN RIDGEBACK, SALUKI, SCOTTISH DEERHOUND, WHIPPET, IRISH WOLFHOUND, ITALIAN GREYHOUND that has earned a qualifying score in the preceding lure course, except those with breed standard disqualifications. A hound excused, dismissed, disqualified, scratched, or not scored in the lure trial is not eligible to compete in the conformation show. All entrants must be registered or eligible for registration with the CKC. Spayed and neutered dogs may compete in the ALTERED class.

CERTIFICATION 7.1.1 (a) A hound must be tested with another dog, of the same breed or a breed with similar running style (preferably not a kennel mate), and certified running clean by a licensed judge. Hounds must be a minimum of 11 months old prior to being certified, and must run a normal course of 600 yards (548.4 m) in order to be certified. **NOTE:** If your dog is NOT certified to compete in coursing events prior to the closing date of the show and you pre-enter, you must bring the signed CKC Hound Certification Form with you to the Trial. If the dog is NOT certified by the start of the Trial on May 11, 2024, your dog will not be able to compete and there will be NO refund of any entry fees.

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS – INFO REGARDING TITLES The following is quoted from the CKC website: "The following non-member participation fee now applies and is retroactive to January 1, 2011. The non-member participation fee applies to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members and a participating non-member can choose to purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member fee. This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, we will be forced to cancel any awards and titles

Non-Member Participation Fee: An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled. The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

- In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the events and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win ribbons or trophies, I agree to hold the WHIPPET CLUB OF BC, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, show secretary and/or the owner or agent of the premises, and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show/trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto.
- I personally assume all responsibility and liability and I further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.
- I hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by an person or persons, including myself, or on account of damage of property, arising out of or in consequence of my participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
- I understand while participating in this activity, I or my canine(s) may be photographed. I agree to allow my photo, video, or film likeness to be used for any legitimate purpose by the activity holders, producers, sponsors, organizers, and assigns.
