\*\*\*\*\*CHANGES TO BABY PUPPY CLASS\*\*\*\*\*

**Baby Puppy class is for dogs 4 months but under 6 months of age on the day of the show.** Dogs entered in the Baby Puppy class DO NOT compete for points. Puppies entered in this class will compete for Best Baby puppy in breed, group and show. Baby puppies require a TCN.

As per CKC rules “Baby Puppy classes may be offered at only one (1) show per day “

Therefore there will be NO Baby Puppy Classes offered in the Limited Shows

**Junior Handling under CKC Rules. Judge to be announced day of show.**

Classes: Itsy Bitsy—under 4yrs. (non-competitive—bring their stuffed animal or toy to compete with)

Saturday only, Pee Wee - 4-6 yrs. (non-competitive) Saturday only

Junior - 7-10 yrs. (Novice and Open) Intermediate 11-14 yrs. (Novice and Open)

Senior 15- up to but not including 18 yrs. (Novice and Open) Best Overall (excluding Pee Wee)

All dogs must be entered in one of the official classes or Exhibition Only on the day of the competition.

Entry to be made at the show. Age for all classes is December 31st, as of the preceding year

If coming in from the East or West on Hwy 11/17, head south to Hwy 61 heading towards the US border

Turn Left at Chippewa Park Road (Hwy61B/City Road) and follow until you reach the park.

If coming from the USA continue North on Hwy 61 until you reach Hwy 61B and

Merge right onto 61B/ City Road and follow to the park

## Temporary Competition Numbers: Self-serve Online Registration for Listed Dogs

With the implementation of CKC's IT system, a new process requires all owners of unregistered, recognized breeds entering events to obtain a *Temporary Competition Number* (TCN). TCNs will replace the current system of entering events with "listed dogs", and will allow dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered. Once a dog is permanently registered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN or (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN Fees (formerly called *listing fees*) when entering events using this number.

**The process of obtaining a TCN will be self-serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.**

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC via mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

### Chapter 15: Champions and Championship Points

**Section 1.** A dog awarded Winners at a Conformation Show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

**Section 2.** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs Competing*	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

\* Includes the dog awarded Winners

**Section 15.1.8.** In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level a dog awarded WINNERS which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog at the group level,

A class dog awarded Best In Show at a championship show will be credited five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

Effective January 1, 2012 to read as follows: In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculation for championship points

In addition to the 10 point/3 judges rule: "In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion.....the dog must.....have earned ~~a~~ least one 2- point win either at the breed or group level".

#### CKC Rules & Regulations 4.1.5

No person may approach a judge either directly or otherwise, orally, in writing or electronically, to favour his entry. Disciplinary action will be taken against any person who violates this rule, or against a judge who fails to report any contravention of this rule to the CKC within 14 days of the action.

It shall be the duty and obligation of the show giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
