BOOSTERS & SPECIALTY FEATURES

VETERANS BOOSTER

Must be entered in the Veterans Class. The Best Veteran from each breed will compete for Best Veteran in Group. The Best Veteran in each Group will then compete for Best Veteran in Specialty. Best Veteran in Group and Best Veteran in Specialty will be judged following Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Specialty, respectively. Each entry in the veteran class will receive an award.

SWEEPSTAKES

Dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in a regular class. Judging will occur during the mid-day break.

Juvenile Sweepstakes

For dogs 6 to 18 months of age.

CLASSES: 6-9 months, 9-12 months, 12-18 months; sexes combined
Class winners will compete for Best in Juvenile Sweepstakes

- PRIZES: Best In Juvenile Sweepstakes 5% of total entries
First in Each Class 25% of entry fees for the class
Second in Each Class 20% of entry fees for the class
Third in Each Class 15% of entry fees for the class
Fourth in Each Class 10% of entry fees for the class
The remainder of the entry fees will be retained to defray costs.

Veterans Sweepstakes

For dogs 7 years and older. Dogs may be spayed or neutered. Judging will follow Juvenile Sweepstakes

CLASSES: 7- 9 years, 9-12 years, 12 and over; sexes combined
Class winners will compete for Best in Veterans Sweepstakes

- PRIZES: Best In Veterans Sweepstakes 5% of total entries
First in Each Class 25% of entry fees for the class
Second in Each Class 20% of entry fees for the class
Third in Each Class 15% of entry fees for the class
Fourth in Each Class 10% of entry fees for the class
The remainder of the entry fees will be retained to defray costs.

### Judging Schedules will be emailed and posted online

All exhibitors are required to ensure that their dogs eliminate in designated areas inside and outside the building. All feces MUST be picked up and indoor urination cleaned-up thoroughly – supplies will be available.

**This specialty operates under the CKC Conformation Show Rules. As per these rules, the following sections are published here:**

#### 19 Discipline

**19.7** It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

#### 15.1 Championship Points

**15.1.1** A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

**15.1.2** The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points awarded Winners shall be as follows:

| *DOGS COMPETING  | 1 | 2 | 3 to 5 | 6 to 9 | 10 to 12 | 13 & More |
|------------------|---|---|--------|--------|----------|-----------|
| POINTS ALLOCATED | 0 | 1 | 2      | 3      | 4        | 5         |

\*Includes the dog awarded Winners. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be included in the calculation for championship points.

**15.1.8** In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Winners which also places in the regular Group competition shall be credited with the following additional points provided that a dog was defeated at the Group level.

| Number of Dogs Competing at Group Level | Dogs Placed First | Dogs Placed Second | Dogs Placed Third | Dogs Placed Fourth |
|---|-------------------|--------------------|-------------------|--------------------|
| 13 or more                              | 5                 | 4                  | 3                 | 2                  |
| 10 to 12                                | 4                 | 3                  | 2                 | 1                  |
| 6 to 9                                  | 3                 | 2                  | 1                 | 1                  |
| 5                                       | 2                 | 1                  | 1                 | 1                  |
| 4                                       | 2                 | 1                  | 1                 | 0                  |
| 3                                       | 2                 | 1                  | 0                 | 0                  |
| 2                                       | 1                 | 0                  | 0                 | 0                  |
| 1                                       | 0                 | 0                  | 0                 | 0                  |

**15.1.9** A dog may not be credited with more than 5 championship points in a single show.

#### Non-Member Participation Fee

##### 24.12.3 Non-member participation fee

a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members".

#### OTHER RULES:

##### Respect for our Venue

As participants in the SWHDA Specialty Show we require you to **clean up** after your dogs and yourselves. This includes anything that would be considered litter. We want to leave the venue as clean or cleaner than when we arrived. Thank you for assisting us with this.

##### Hub City Kennel & Obedience Club Rules

Participants in the Saskatoon Working and Herding Dog Association, Inc. Specialty are required to comply with any rules stated in the Hub City Kennel & Obedience Club Premium List.
