Rules and General Information

Eligibility: This test is open to all purebred registered dogs of sufficient height and weight that are physically capable of performing all if the exercises in a particular class, and that are eighteen months of age or older on the day of the test. Draft Dog Excellent and Brace Draft Dog entries must have previously earned D.D. titles in order to enter the D.D.X or B.D.D. class. Brace Draft Dog Excellent entries must have previously earned both D.D.X. and B.D.D. titles. Re-qualifications will be accepted only after all untitled entries are included. Re-qualifications shall be judged as the last team in the section for which they are entered. Judges may excuse a dog at any time during a test for lack of physical capacity.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Every foreign born and owned dog that is entered in a Canadian Kennel Club event must obtain an [Event Registration Number](#) (ERN) within 30 days of that event. An Event Registration Number Application must be completed and submitted along with a copy of registration documents from a CKC recognized foreign kennel club and the required fee. Download the Event Registration Number Application from the online forms section under CKC Services or contact the CKC Order Desk at 1-800-250-8040.

PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER

A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows an unregistrable dog of a CKC recognized or listed breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. In order for a dog to be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following criteria must be met:

- 1) The dog must be of a CKC recognized or listed breed.
- 2) The dog, for one reason or another, must not be eligible for CKC registration.
- 3) The dog must be spayed or neutered.
- 4) The dog must be properly identified with a CKC approved microchip (this requirement is not necessary for ILP dogs).
- 5) In the case of a foreign born dog residing in the USA, in addition to the above, the dog must have been issued an AKC PAL number.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee is \$59.40 + applicable tax.

In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members. Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website, <http://www.ckc.ca> under Events and then Event forms on the drop down menu.

GROUP EXERCISES

Draft Dog and Brace Draft Dog Field Work, Draft Dog Excellent Freight Haul and/or the Draft Dog Excellent Backpacking Exercises may be performed using the Group Option as stated in Section 11.2 of the CKC Draft Dog Rules and Regulations, using the recommended methodology as stated in Appendix A.

Day of Test Entries: The option of entering on the day of the test will be available for exhibitors, if the test has not reached its stated entry limits, and/or all alternates have been accommodated. No bitches in season will be accepted under this provision. Entries will be assessed a \$25.00 additional fee, and all fees for this entry will be made in cash only. Test entry will be assigned at the end of all the pre-entered dogs. Entry must be received 90 minutes prior to the start time of the test.

Confirmation of Entry: After the closing date, all entrants and alternates will be notified by e-mail, post, or telephone of their placement. A map and directions will be provided with this confirmation. Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Refunds: It is the option of the exhibitor to request a refund for a bitch that has come into season, should they so desire. A veterinarian's certificate will be required for the refund to be issued. Otherwise, bitches in season may compete, but will be judged after all other entrants have been tested. Bitches in season must be kept away from the test site prior to being tested. Day of test entries will NOT be accepted for bitches in season.

The Test Site: This test is held at a private community facility, and all rules and regulations pertaining to their site will be in force for this test. A map will be provided with entry confirmation for location of this facility. The Draft Test Committee will exercise due care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs entered, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of any accident or other misfortune to any dog, exhibitor or patron.

Date of closing is October 8, 2015, 6:00 p.m. M. D. T. or when entry limit is reached. There are no drop off facilities for entries. When entering in the Brace class, please fill out a separate entry form for each dog and attach the entries together.

AWARDS:

- All participating entrants will receive an exhibitor's gift.
- Each dog receiving a qualifying score will earn a red rosette, per judge, to a maximum of three rosettes; and all dogs achieving a title will receive an award.

*Listing Fee: Please note that if your dog does not have an individual CKC number, an Event Registration Number or a Performance Event Number at the time entry is made, a listing fee of \$8.93 MUST accompany your entry fee.

Closing Date: 6:00 p.m. M. D. T., October 8, 2015 or when the limit total reaches seven hours of judging, even if the official closing date for entries has not arrived. If the limit is reached prior to the closing date, a list of alternates will be kept to fill any vacancies created up to and including the day of the test. Entry fees will be refunded following the test to all withdrawals replaced by an alternate and to all alternates who did not participate in the test. Requalifications are accepted pending "space available". Requalifications shall be judged as the last team in the level for which they are entered.

Equipment: Each entrant is to supply their own equipment. The freight load will be supplied by the test committee. Draft Dog Excellent participants must provide their own back pack loads and should wear appropriate foot wear to cross a small creek.

Test Regulations: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the level in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC Draft Test Regulations are available through the Canadian Kennel Club. Telephone: (416) 675 - 5511. All dogs entered in the Draft Dog level must perform the control exercises, regardless of obedience titles held.

Section 17.7 of the CKC Draft Dog Rules and Regulations states:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Draft Dog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.
