JUDGING PROCEDURE

Judging of the All-Breed Bred by Exhibitor Sweepstakes will commence at approximately 12:00 Noon. However, if necessary a later starting time may be announced for any one or more of the rings. (See judging program for further details). Breed judging will start again at the scheduled time. Within each group, dogs will be judged SEXES COMBINED. Baby Puppies are not eligible.

RULES and AWARDS

All dogs entered on the day shall be eligible to compete, regardless of place of birth. All dogs must be Bred and Owned by the Exhibitor. All dogs entered in the sweepstakes must also be entered in a regular class at the All Breed Show, on the day of the Sweepstakes. Money received as entry fee for the sweepstakes will be pooled and divided as follows:

Best in Sweeps.....	5% of entry fees received & Prize
1st in each Group	25% of entry fees received for that class
2nd in each Group.....	20% of entry fees received for that class
3rd in each Group.....	15% of entry fees received for that class
4th in each Group.....	10% of entry fees received for that class

The remaining 25% of all entry fees will be retained to cover administration cost. Rosettes will be awarded for Best in each Group and Best in Sweepstakes. Flat ribbons will be awarded for first to fourth place in each class. A prize from the Ottawa Kennel Club for Best in Sweepstakes will be awarded. If a dog is required for judging in one of the regular classes, judging of the sweepstakes in that group will be suspended until judging of the regular class has been completed.

OWNER HANDLED (OH)
Saturday May 26th & Sunday May 27th

RULES FOR OWNER HANDLED COMPETITION

Owner Handled Box must be checked on entry form to be eligible (A * will indicate each OH dog listed in both the catalogue and on the Judging sheets.) This is open to all **non-professional** owner-handlers. (Professional defined as anyone who has been hired to assist a handler or paid to handle or received remuneration or a licensed/permit judge). Dogs must be **OH** throughout the competition. Judging of **OH** will take place after Breed Judging Competition. **OH**, Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs eligible to compete for BB. If the BB is **OH** it will automatically be the **OH BB**. If ineligible, then the next highest OH placement will compete against the eligible dogs of the opposite sex. Should none of the BB competitive dogs be **OH** then any **OH** dogs (not directly or indirectly defeated in the classes by an **OH** dog) will be invited back. The **OH BB** dogs will compete for **BOH** in Group immediately after Regular Group Judging. Should the Regular Group 1st dog be **OH** then it will be automatically **OH in Group**. If no **OH** places in the Group (1-4) then all **BB OH** dogs will be called into the ring for **OH Group Judging**. If BIS dog is **OH**, then it will automatically be **OH BIS**. A prize and rosette will be offered for Best OH in Show. Rosettes will be offered for Best OH in Group.

RING RENTAL TIME

Hosted by Diane Solman

OKC will be offering Ring Rental time to exhibitors of the trials and conformation for their entered dogs. 7 minutes of Ring Rental will be available on Friday, May 25, 6:00 pm to 8 pm, in the Obedience Barn, to those entered in a trial or show. You will have the opportunity to spend 7 minutes in the ring to do exactly what you want to do. You may want to invite a friend or someone at the match to call a routine. You may want to just play with your dog or your puppy for 7 minutes. You may want to practice your go-outs or retrieves. You may want to just heel with distractions. The choice is yours. There will be a Novice (no equipment) ring and an Open/Utility ring set up.

You must pre-register by sending your interest to participate to Diane at cedarstone@cogeco.ca along with **non-refundable payment** via e-transfer or cheque. The cost is \$10 per slot. If there are unused slots you can pay \$15 at the door but check with Diane before going. So more people get a chance to play, you may request 1 slot per dog to work in the Novice Ring or the Open/Utility Ring. One exception! You may reserve 2 slots for the same dog in the Open/Utility ring if you are entered in Open and Utility.

If you are not entered but still would like to do both, let Diane know and she will put you on the waiting list for another slot. For the rest of you, if you really want more slots, let Diane know and she will put your additional requirements on the wait list as well.

Diane must receive your pre-registration with payment by Monday May 21st at 5pm. She will send out the schedule on Wednesday, May 23rd. Each person will be scheduled into a time slot between 6:00 and 8. If you have pre-registered and you find you cannot attend, let Diane know ASAP so someone else can benefit.

There will be a timer at each ring and when 7 minutes are up, you are out of there.

If you have pre-registered and there are some empty slots in the schedule, you may be able to book one if you think you needed more time. Waitlisted slots will be assigned after the closing time or before.

Novice Stays and Open Stays will be scheduled throughout the evening.

For this to benefit everyone, you must be prepared to come well before your slotted times, be willing to leave well after your slotted times and be willing to help your fellow competitors by calling a routine or two, being a post, putting out articles, just being a distraction, etc.

No food in the ring. You may step outside the ring to treat.

CANINE GOOD NEIGHBOUR (CGN)

To determine the numbers of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. The new system provides for additional points (provided that the dog has defeated another as listed hereunder:

A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case, may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

1. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching the Show Secretary after the official closing date as published in this premium list. Section 1 Chapter 13.
2. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are shown thereon. NO ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY THE ENTRY FEE.
3. TELEPHONE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
4. Conflicts between Dog Show Rules and New Breed Standards. The Board of Directors of the CKC, has ruled that where there is a conflict between the Breed Standards and the Dog Show Rules that the Dog Show Rules will take precedence.
5. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made. Cancellation of any entry after the closing day is prohibited.
6. The Ottawa Kennel Club reserves the right to refuse any entry, subject to C.K.C. Dog Show Rules.
7. THE SHOW SUPERINTENDENT WILL BE IN FULL CHARGE OF THE SHOW which will be governed by C.K.C.Rules.
8. Identification cards and judging schedule will be mailed as soon as possible after entries close.
9. The person accompanying the dog must show the Identification card before the dog is allowed in the show, and unless a dog is entered officially, it will not be allowed in the show precincts.
10. All dogs must be exercised in the exercise pens provided for that purpose. Plastic bags will be available at each entrance.
11. Dogs need only arrive 15 minutes before scheduled judging time, and will be excused, each show, when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have the dog in the ring when the dog's class is scheduled for judging.
12. The Ottawa Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of an accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or spectators.
13. The show will not start before 8:00 am.
14. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.
15. To avoid noise and confusion, there will be no individual dogs called to the ring by loud-speaker. Delays waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times for their breeds conflict.

WIFI and electricity is available for \$25.00 per weekend pre paid with your entry, \$10.00 per day if paid for at the show.


