AGILITY CLASSES OFFERED

The following C.K.C. classes (divided by heights) will be offered:

REGULAR CLASSES

Standard Novice A: For persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or organization.

Standard Novice B: For agility instructors and judges and for dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice Title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate; and for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any agility organization.

Standard Intermediate: Is open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and to those dogs which have acquired the Agility Intermediate title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent Title.

Standard Excellent A: For dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.

Standard Excellent B: For dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title or the Agility Master Excellent title.

Jumpers with Weaves: same classes, heights, and conditions as for Standard Regular.

SELECTED CLASSES

The Selected Classes (both Standard & Jumpers with Weaves) follow the Agility Trials Rules & Regulations. The courses will be the same as in the Regular Classes but will have adjusted height and course times. Novice Select Class is not divided into A and B Divisions. The same rules apply for Excellent A & B as those described for the Regular Classes. A dog must be entered only in Selected Class or in Regular Classes at the same set of trials. They may move back and forth between the two Classes but not at the same set of trials offered by a club on the same day or on consecutive days.

VETERANS CLASS

At the option of the handler, a dog 7 years of age or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Veteran and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Any new titles earned will be designated with the letter "V" for Veteran following the title (e.g. AGMXV)

All veterans will compete as if running in the Selected Classes at one or two jump heights lower than regular and with the 10% additional time allocated to the Selected Class.

Height Divisions - owners are responsible for entering the correct height divisions. The judge may require any dog to be measured.

REGULAR CLASSES: Standard & Jumpers with Weaves

- 8 inches - for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
- 12 inches - for dogs over 10 inches up to and including 14 inches at the withers
- 16 inches - for dogs over 14 inches up to and including 18 inches at the withers
- 20 inches - for dogs over 18 inches up to and including 22 inches at the withers
- 24 inches - for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

SELECTED/VETERANS CLASSES: Standard & Jumpers with Weaves

- 4 inches - for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
- 8 inches - for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
- 12 inches - for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
- 16 inches - for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
- 20 inches - for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

Exhibitor Information

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of and will comply with the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations. At the option of the handler, a dog may wear either a well-fitting plain buckle collar, a quick-release collar, or no collar. Fancy collars, choke collars, pinch collars, or other training collars are prohibited. Collars which are too tight or so large that they hang down unreasonable in front of the dog are not permitted. There shall be nothing hanging from the collar (12.3.1) Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other training devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the course (12.1.1)

Agility Rules and Regulations: (4.1.3.t) It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred

All N.S.F. cheques will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge.

The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any errors in the entering of the dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted. Returned cheques and declined credit cards will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge (Chapter 8.8, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules). There will not be any refunds on duplicate entries or overpayments.

Greyhound Express entries must be prepaid for delivery and will not be picked up.

Do not send entries by Registered Mail. Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted.

Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor.

Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks.

Entry Requirements:

Every dog entered in a CKC Agility Trial must be purebred and must be registered with the CKC, or have an ERN (Event Registration Number), a PEN (Performance Event Number) or be eligible for Registration with the CKC, or have a CKC miscellaneous Class Certification Number.

The dog must be at least 18 months of age, may be spayed or neutered. The dog may not be lame or compete if it has tape or bandages.

A dog may only be entered in one Standard Class & one Jumpers With Weaves Class at each trial.

To simplify the process, we urge that you pay by credit card, bank draft or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

Planning Your Stay at the Summer Classic

The Alberta Kennel Club is thrilled to be holding our show at Spruce Meadows once again! Holding our event there comes with some significant responsibilities for ALL OF US – volunteers and exhibitors alike. You will agree that this is not your normal facility and rules must be followed. You must clean up after your dog. Please Keep Baggies With You At All Times. Discourage the boys from casually lifting their legs on fences, posts, trees or shrubs. Think of this as your home for the weekend – we are sure that you wouldn't allow it in your house so don't let it happen on the show grounds. *Failure to pick-up after your dogs will result in automatic expulsion from the show and the show grounds. This will be enforced.*

Our aim is to build a long relationship with Spruce Meadows and that will happen if we all work together.

Some Basic Requests:

1. Spruce Meadows does not allow overnight tenting (i.e. no tenting on their grounds).
2. Parking will be allowed only in areas designated by the Parking Superintendent.
3. All RV's must have boards under all of their tires and generators – Sorry, No exceptions!
4. Please be prepared to bring leveling materials for your unit.
5. For all Motor homes, please ensure you have your exhaust pipe extension, this is a mandatory request.
6. There will be absolutely NO dumping of grey water or sewage on Spruce Meadows grounds permitted – Thank-you☺.
7. We will have potable fresh water available for the weekend and delivered right to you in your RV spot, the cost is \$25 per fill/unit, we will also have Septic & Grey water dumping available for \$30.00 per unit. These are special rates provided by "Alberta Water Systems" These services are on a cash only basis, and can be requested/paid for at the AKC Show Secretary Table.
8. Water & electrical hook-ups are not available for RV units.
9. Parking is a privilege extended by Spruce Meadows and the Alberta Kennel Club.
10. All parking is at your own risk.
11. We will be providing a large tent for benching on the Chinook field for those people who are camping with us for the weekend; a power source will be available. Space will be on a first come first served basis – spaces are 10 x 10 – sorry no x-pens.
12. Complimentary shuttle services to and from the RV areas and public parking lot throughout the entire day, pick-up and drop off locations will be made available to you upon arrival in your welcome package.
13. We offer Complimentary Showers for our exhibitors
14. Generators - Please ensure they are off please between the hours of 11 PM and 6:00 AM – this is the designated "quiet time" for our friends and neighbors.
15. Enjoy yourself! We wish you all the best during the weekend and hope you enjoy your stay with us! Good luck at the show!

RV Parking Reservations:

RV RESERVATIONS can be made **ON-LINE** or **hard copy reservation form**. There are no preferred sites. Each camping site will be 25Ft X 60Ft. **Price: \$120.00**. Fee must be paid by entry closing, June 30, 2011, 10:00 p.m.

If a group wishes to be together, ONE person must pay for all sites on a single form (ie. one form per group).

If you have a diesel pusher or large motor home longer than 35 ft, you have an option of parking on grass or pavement.

We have Lots 7 (paved) and Lots 10 & 11 secured for RV Parking – your choice

RV Parking and Indoor Benching must be ordered separately from online dog show entries.
