- o Pre-ordered catalogues will be available for pick up at the AKC desk, Friday, August 3, 2018, no sooner than 1.5 hrs. prior to start of judging & whenever the desk is open. Limited quantities available for sale.

RV Parking:

- RV Parking Thursday, August 2, 2018 @ 9 am to 11 pm
- All Motorhomes and Trailers must have boards placed under the tires that park in Lot 10 (grass). Motorhome generators must be vented up (no matter the lot)
- If you have prepaid for a spot in our Handicapped area, you must provide a valid, government issued handicapped placard, if you do not have one of these we will have to assign you a space in Lot 10 or 11.
- Complimentary Shower Trailer provided by the Alberta Kennel Club ask at the AKC desk for directions or follow the signs the showers are East of the Fountain "Dog Spa". Donations to help with the cost of this service are greatly appreciated ©
- All parking is a privilege at Spruce Meadows. Anyone abusing these privileges will be excused immediately from the show, and all future shows on this venue by the parking authorities and/or show superintendent. Please be advised that there is absolutely no overnight tenting allowed at Spruce Meadows.
- All guests will sign a document that they understand the restricted areas as indicated in this judging schedule and subsequent AKC Summer Classic Site map.
- There is no overnight tenting or sleeping in vehicles permitted at Spruce Meadows.
- No Open Fires of any kind (wood or propane) are permitted on the grounds of Spruce Meadows.
- No balloons of any sort are permitted on the grounds of Spruce Meadows they frighten the horses!
- Quiet Time is from <u>11:00 pm to 6:00 am</u> <u>NO GENERATORS</u> may run during this time. Please be courteous to your neighbours.

Parking:

- -Ample free parking is permitted in Lot 7, between B-Barn and C-Barn, and along the east side of E-Barn only.
- -Designated Handicapped parking areas are between K Barn (South Side) and the Wash Bays, the North End of B & C Barn. Please observe and respect the Handicapped (clearly marked) and Designated Parking (clearly marked) areas.

The Alberta Kennel Club, and Spruce Meadows reserve the right to have vehicles towed that are in areas other than described, this includes those areas that are designated "No Parking." Our **complimentary shuttles** are available Friday to Monday, and are able to accommodate dogs and equipment.

Reserved Benching:

- K-Barn Reserved Benching Thursday, August 2, 2018 @ 1 pm
- If you are leaving dogs in the stalls, your contact information must be visible in your benching area in the event of an emergency.
- Absolutely no smoking in the barn at any time!
- You are responsible for leaving your stall as you found it.... **CLEAN!** Please ensure that you have a broom handy to sweep out your stall, left behind garbage, dog hair, etc. is not the responsibility of the Alberta Kennel Club Volunteers or Spruce Meadows Personnel to clean up. We thank you for your cooperation in this regard!

All-Alberta Ring & North American Ring Outdoor Benching:

- Outdoor Reserved Benching Thursday, August 2, 2018 @ 2 pm
- Absolutely no smoking in the benching area or the competition fields at any time!
- Absolutely no vehicles on the fields at any time, please ensure you have a cart/trolley to move your items to your reserved benching spot
- Generators (civilized ones please, excessively loud generators will not be permitted) are permitted in the day tenting area, however the generators must be housed up against the fence line and at no time are to infringe on your neighbors space whereby fumes would enter their area. Please ensure you have a long extension cord if you are using a generator.
- Grass mats are not permitted in the day tenting areas of the North American or All Alberta Fields.
- You are responsible for leaving your space as you found it.... **CLEAN!** Please ensure that you have a rake/tool handy to clean up your area, left behind garbage, dog hair, rubber bands, etc. are not the responsibility of the Alberta Kennel Club Volunteers or Spruce Meadows Personnel to clean up. We thank you for your cooperation in this regard!
- Once the show commences you are welcome to drive into the designated Pick-up / Drop-off area on the north and south side of the wash bay areas. This area will be in operation all day. Note that you only have 15 minutes to drop off/pick up.
- Once you have dropped off your items, please make your way to Lot 7 for parking.

*Golf Cart Rental:

- If you prepaid for a Golf Cart for the weekend, please see Wendy at the AKC Desk at 4 pm on Thursday, August 2nd for pick up. Please ensure you have your valid insurance documents with you.

Private golf carts are not permitted on either field at any time.

Shuttle Services:

-We offer complimentary shuttle services daily from 8 am to 5 pm (Friday to Sunday) 8 am to 3 pm on Monday; this service is provided by our local Rotarians. Shuttles will be rotating Lot 7 and RV Lots 10, 11 and Group Camping throughout the day.

Dog Bathing:

-We have 4 stalls available on the south side of the horse wash bays, complete with hot and cold running water, 2 stalls are complete with bath tubs. Please be advised that this water is non-potable and not for drinking.

Concessions:

- The Time Faults Pub is open at 7 am to 11 am daily for breakfast, and open the rest of the day until 9 pm for lunch or dinner. (Friday to Monday) **unless private functions are scheduled for the evening**
- There are concessions stands on the East end of the horse wash bays as well as the SE entrance of the North American Field. (Friday to Monday)

- You are TOTALLY responsible for picking up after your dog. Spruce Meadows and the Alberta Kennel Club have ZERO tolerance for dog droppings on the grounds. Exhibitors please note:

- All Adult Group judging and Best in Show judging will be held in Ring # 7 on the North American field throughout the day; Individual breeds, dogs and classes will NOT be paged. Exhibitors and handlers with more than one dog must have an alternate handler available.
- For your convenience the division of sexes has been carefully tabulated, however the Alberta Kennel Club does not assume responsibility for absolute accuracy. The number before each breed is the total number of that breed; following the breed is the following division males females special males special females. *denotes booster and/or supported entry.
- Dogs must enter the show premises 1 (one) hour prior to the scheduled judging of the breed. Dogs which are not required for further judging may leave the show grounds after their judging is completed.
- Exhibitors and handlers are solely responsible for having their dogs at ringside at the scheduled time (absent dogs must be allowed for). It is not the responsibility of the Alberta Kennel Club or the ring steward to locate dogs.
- Exhibitors noting possible dog conflicts between Conformation and Obedience and Rally must notify the Obedience / Rally-Obedience Chairman, Maureen O'Neil before the start of judging in the ring in question on the day in question. Judges will complete morning assignments before breaking for lunch.

 - South on MacLeod Trail, then turn west on Spruce Meadows Trail (also known as Hwy 22X/Stoney Trail)
 and travel approximately 2 km, watch for signs to Tournament Lane (turn left here), then follow the signs
 to AKC RV Parking, North American Entrance or Lot 7.
- o From Edmonton via Deerfoot Trail:
 - South on Deerfoot Trail, then turn west on Spruce Meadows Trail (also known as Hwy 22X/Stoney Trail)
 and travel approximately 2 km, watch for signs to Tournament Lane (turn left here), then follow the signs
 to AKC RV Parking, North American Entrance or Lot 7.
- o From US Border via Highway 2:
 - Before reaching the southern city limits of Calgary, turn west on Spruce Meadows Trail (also known as Hwy 22x/Stoney Trail) and travel approximately 2 km, watch for signs to Tournament Lane (turn left here), then follow the signs to AKC RV Parking Lot 10, North American Entrance or Lot 7.

Planning your stay at Spruce Meadows

The Alberta Kennel Club is thrilled to be holding our show at Spruce Meadows once again! Holding our event there comes with some significant responsibilities for ALL OF US – volunteers and exhibitors alike. You will agree that this is not your normal facility and rules must be followed. You must clean up after your dog. Discourage the boys from casually lifting their legs on fences, posts, trees or shrubs. Think of this as your home for the weekend – we are sure that you wouldn't allow it in your house so don't let it happen on the show grounds.

Please Keep Baggies With You At All Times.

Failure to pick-up after your dogs will result in automatic expulsion from the show and the show grounds. This request will be enforced.

Some Basic Requests:

- 1. No Open Fires of any kind (wood or propane) are permitted on the grounds of Spruce Meadows.
- 2. No Smoking on the fields or K Barn at any time, includes the reserved and unreserved benching area
- 3. Spruce Meadows does not allow overnight tenting/sleeping in vehicles on their grounds.
- 4. Parking will be allowed only in areas designated by the Parking Superintendent.
- 5. All RV's must have boards under all of their tires (lot 10 only) and generators sorry, No Exceptions!
- 6. Please be prepared to bring leveling materials for your unit.
- 7. For all Motor homes, please ensure you have your exhaust pipe extension, this is a mandatory requirement.
- 8. There will be absolutely NO dumping of grey water or sewage on Spruce Meadows grounds.
- 9. Water & electrical hook-ups are not available for RV units.
