Please note that effective January 1, 2016, in accordance with Section 3.4.1 of the Junior Handling Rules & Regulations, Junior Handlers will be required to apply to CKC Head Office for a Junior Handling Number.

**Section 3.4.1** "Junior Handler with the exception of Pee Wees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

**Attention US Exhibitors:** Current exchange rate favours the American dollar. To take full advantage of this, please purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Personal cheques will be accepted, however they must be payable in US funds, and for the full amount of the entry. Please do no mark personal cheques payable in Canadian fund, or "at par" as such items are not readily cleared through the bank. Your co-operation is appreciated.

ATTENTION: ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS - ERN NUMBERS All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an event registration number (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the CKC. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN number, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with a cheque or VISA/Mastercard number, (expiry date, cardholders name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of ERN number. ERN number must be applied for within 30 DAYS of the FIRST day of entering a CKC event.

<u>Temporary Competition Numbers or (TCN)</u> – A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event and the same TCN must be used foor all event entries for a dog until the dog is pemanently reistered or has an ERN, the TCN will be replaced with the registration number or ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds (MCN) or dogs that will require a (Performance Event Number) PEN off (Canine Companion Number) CCN.

While there is no fee to obtain a TCN, exhibitors will still be required to pay TCN fees (formelry called lsiting fees) when entering events using this number.

The process of obtaining a TCN will be self serve; exhibitors will be directed to the CKC website to complete an online application and a TCN will be issued instantly upon completion.

Exhibitors may also obtain a TCN by completing a printed application and submitting it to the CKC by mail, or by contacting the Shows and Trials Division by telephone.

Please note that if your dog does not have a registration number or ERN, and has already competed in a CKC event and earned points, score, or awards, there is not need to apply for a TCN. CKC records will updated accordingly.

## **MOVING A CLASS DOG TO SPECIALS**

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of chapter 20 of the dog show rules, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "specials only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing at least one (1) hour prior to the opening of the show, by the owner or handler. When one or more all-breed championship shows or specialty shows are held on the same date, same venue and in

When one or more all-breed championship shows or specialty shows are held on the same date, same venue and i conjunction, the moving of the class dogs to specials must be completed not less than one (1) hour prior to the scheduled opening of the first (1st) show.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 2. ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN OBEDIENCE COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted if a Veterinarians certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED AFTER CLOSING DATE. Receipts, judging schedules, and exhibitors passes will be mailed.
- 4. ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH WHILE ON THE GROUNDS. You are responsible for cleaning up if you permit your dog to relieve itself outside the show building. Failure to do so may result in being expelled from the building for one day's showing by the Superintendent.
- 5. All empty rings are to be kept free of dogs.
- 6. SHOW PRECINCTS: Whitemud Equine Learning Centre Assoc., excluding the commercial booth space.
- 7. "ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES." If not in competition the dog must wear a collar and be on leash a maximum of six (6) feet or appropriately confined in the benching area.
- 8. 19.7 It shall be the duty and obligation of the show-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to indignities. The Conformation Show Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue

#### **CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS**

Section 1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

<sup>\*</sup> includes the dog awadred Winners

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall be **not** in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded WINNERS, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule as set forth above.

The new system provides for additional points, provided that the dog has defeated another dog, either at the breed level or at the group level, if a dog awarded WINNERS also placed in the Group, as listed hereunder.

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than 5 points at any single show.

## **Grand Champion (GCh) Point Schedule**

The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, at breed level, are awarded to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level

#### Best in Show (5 points)

(b) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.

#### **Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx)**

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may only be earned after the completion of the CKC grand championship title. Points for this title may be accumulated at any time after the completion of the CKC grand championship but does not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship or the grand championship. A minimum of 100 points, which must include one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) plus three (3) Group 1st or three (3) breed specialty wins.

## **Non-Member Participation Fee**

#### 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

a)An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

b)In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled.

c)The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members

## **EKC COVID-19 INFORMATION**

The Edmonton Kennel Club recognizes the impact and risks that COVID-19 continues to have on our community. It is important to ensure the safety of our club members, volunteers, ring stewards, judges, and exhibitors. At minimum, the EKC will follow all federal, provincial, municipal and facility protocols related to COVID 19. However, public health guidelines, restrictions and show protocols may change between the posting of this Premium List and the publishing of the final Judging Schedule.

By entering our show, you agree to abide by any guidelines or protocols that the Edmonton Kennel Club has in place at the time the shows and trials are hosted. If you have any objection to following our guidelines or restrictions, please do not enter this show.

If any club members, volunteers, ring stewards, judges, or fellow exhibitors are subject to abusive language or behavior, or if you fail to abide by the show protocols, this may result in your dismissal from the show with no right of entry fee refund.

#### **Attending the Show**

- 1. The Alberta Chief Medical Officer of Health (CMOH) order 05:2020, order 28:2020, order 06-2021 and order 26-2021 outlines COVID-19 isolation and quarantine requirements. In accordance with these orders, <u>DO NOT</u> attend the dog show if:
  - you have any symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell, sore throat or runny nose). Take the Alberta online assessment to arrange testing (available here).
  - are awaiting results of a COVID-19 test,
  - you are confirmed to have an active case of COVID-19,
  - have had close contact with a person who is confirmed to have COVID-19, or
  - have returned from travel outside of Canada in the last 14 days.
- 2. If you generally do not feel well, DO NOT attend the show.
- 3. The *EKC COVID-19 Waiver/Disclaimer* found in this Premium List must be signed and presented to the Show Secretary your first day at the show.
- 4. The *EKC Daily Health Screening Questionnaire* found in this Premium List will be required EACH DAY you are entered at the show and must be presented to the Show Secretary.

## **Show Grounds**

- 1. There will be signs to indicate when you are entering the official show grounds.
- 2. There will be hand sanitizing stations located on the show grounds.
- 3. Porta-potties will be situated on the grounds with hand sanitizing stations.
- 4. Judges' tables and other touch surfaces will be sanitized regularly.
- 5. This year there will not be a large centre tent under which to wait before entering the rings. There will also be separate entrances and exits for each ring.
- 6. There will be no free bottled water or coffee available. A food vendor will be onsite should you require these.
- 7. RV Parking and Benching will be available. Please review to other parts of this Premium List for details.
- 8. There will be an official show photographer, and they may have their own COVID protocols.

#### **Mask Information**

- 1. Masks are mandatory while in the ring and the show precincts. Masks must be worn completely, covering both mouth and nose.
- 2. Face shields, neck warmers, masks with exhalation valves, handkerchiefs and any other loose fitting face coverings are NOT masks and are not recommended by Alberta Health Services. Face Shields are acceptable only when the exhibitor has a medical exception letter.
- 3. If you do not bring a mask, one will be provided for you at a cost.
- 4. Per Alberta CMOH Order 22-2021, anyone unable to wear a mask due to a medical condition will require a medical exception letter from an authorized health professional. You must be able to show the letter to the Show Secretary.
  - The medical exception letter must come from a nurse practitioner, physician, or psychologist.
  - The medical exception letter may be presented when in a public setting if requested by enforcement officials, or retrospectively in court if a ticket is issued.

## **Social Distancing**

- 1. Maintain at least 2 metres/7 feet of social distancing while at the show venue. The Edmonton Kennel Club is ensuring extra space is provided in the rings and surrounding area so that adequate space is available to socially distance.
- 2. No hugging or handshaking permitted on any of the official grounds of the show.
- 3. Wash hands and use hand sanitizer as frequently as possible.
- 4. Do not touch dogs that are not your own.

## **Refund Policy**

- 1. If the Edmonton Kennel Club is required to cancel the show due to any federal, provincial, City of Edmonton or Canadian Kennel Club guidelines, policies, or directives, a full refund of all entry fees will be offered.
- 2. All DogShow.ca service fees or and credit card fees are non-refundable.
- 3. If you are unable to attend the dog show, for any reason, after entries have closed, refunds will not be provided.
- 4. If you cannot travel to the show due to a government restriction on travel, refunds will not be provided.
