**COURSES & BIRDS:** The test will be run on a single course. Depending on course conditions, the Field Test Committee may adjust the course, including the addition of a bird field, to suit. All dogs with bird work will be shot over with blank cartridges on game contact. Released birds will be quail, chukar, pheasant and/or pigeons. Any dog encountering native game birds on the course must point, a shot must be fired and will be judged according to their test level. Dogs will be run individually for FDJ and FD tests and braced for FDA &FDX. All tests are walking tests (foot-handled) only.

**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Best Western Plus Mission City Lodge 32281 Lougheed Hwy, Mission, BC (604) 820-5500 or book.bestwestern.com. They have "pet friendly" rooms and their fee for pets is +\$15 per night.

**CAMPING:** Self-contained units or tents are permitted on the site. There are **no hook-ups** and **no potable water**. Bring water for yourself and your dogs. A porta-potti will be provided on-site.

**HOSPITALITY:** There will not be a concession at the grounds. Lunches will be provided for workers so feel free to volunteer!

HELPERS LIST: All entrants are expected to assist during the weekend of the tests. There will be a sign up sheet at the Field Secretary's table.

**HORSES**: We will not be using horses for this event. Judges will be on foot – handlers must be on foot.

**SITE RULES**: BCABPC is grateful to the Kerkoven Family for the use of these grounds. Please respect and abide by all good neighbor rules. Please clean up all garbage before leaving.

**ENTRY FEES**: Are payable in Canadian funds via Pay Pal through the club website and <u>due at time of entry</u>. Payment may also be made by Cheque or money order payable to BCABPC. U.S. participants please purchase bank drafts or money orders in Canadian funds. Your co-operation is appreciated, thank you. The Field Test Secretary will acknowledge the receipt of electronically transmitted entries. All entry forms are to be completed and in the hands of the Field Test Secretary and entry fees paid in full prior to the running of a dog. The tendering of NSF cheques or cheques post-dated beyond the closing date shall be considered as non-payment of entry fees and is punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. A collection fee of \$25.00 will be added to the amount of any returned cheque.

\* Listing Fee: A listing fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC Individual Registration Number, Event Registration Number (ERN), Performance Event Number (PEN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) is not shown on the entry form.

CANADIAN-RESIDENT ENTRANTS THAT ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS: Effective January 1, 2011, the Canadian Kennel Club has implemented an annual non-CKC-member participation fee. Canadian-resident owners who are not members of the CKC must pay this annual participation fee or join the CKC. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of awards and titles. For co-owned dogs, one of the owners must supply a CKC membership number or pay the fee/join CKC. The above applies only to Canadian residents; Americanowned dogs are exempt. The test secretary will have some of the forms available at the test; it is the entrants' responsibility to submit the form and fee to CKC.

**BORDER CROSSING:** A rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada and the USA. Government regulations require a valid Rabies Certificate dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. Please note that border crossings now involve more thorough inspection of vehicles, dogs and papers. Proof of citizenship is required for entry into Canada and return to the USA. Please carry a Passport, naturalization papers, etc. as proof of citizenship. You can borrow a starter pistol if you decide not to bring one across the border.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- The BCABPC wishes to remind all participants and spectators that there will be no exercising or training of any dogs on the grounds before, during or after the trial without the permission of the Field Test Chairman or Field Test Secretary.
- The BCABPC reserves the right to **limit entries** to the available daylight hours and, if necessary, to rearrange the running order.
- Day of test entries will be accepted if the schedule allows. Such entries must be presented to the Test Secretary no later than 1 hour before the scheduled start time for that test along with an additional fee of \$20.00.
- The duty of having a **dog ready in place when required** for judging rests solely with its handler or owner. If a dog is not present at the place where it is to start within 5 minutes after it is called for by the judges to run, it must be disqualified. The judges are responsible for keeping the time.
- No dog shall be **picked up** during a test except with permission from the judge.
- All participants must be familiar with the CKC Rules and also the rules and provisions of this
  Premium List. CKC Field Dog & Water Tests Rules & Regulations for Pointing Breeds Effective
  January 1, 2017 are available from the CKC or online at the CKC website for CKC members.
- Bitches in season may run at the end of the last test level scheduled for the last day. Entrants must notify event secretary prior to start of said stake, or run will be forfeited.
- Collaring is permitted only as allowed for in the CKC Field Dog Test rulebook.
- Backing Tests: If a dog has placed in one of the senior stakes of the Test and needs only a backing test co complete the requirements for a Championship, the owner may request a backing test. This test will be allowed at the discretion of the Field Test Chairman and will depend on the availability of birds. The test will cost \$20.00
- Tracking Collars: Approved electronic collars that are designed for tracking only may be used. Any questions regarding their use should be referred to the Field Test Chairman.
- The BC All Breed Pointer Club is committed to providing an environment free of discrimination and harassment, where all individuals are treated with respect. Members and participants are expected to be respectful at all times. Harassment, discrimination, physical and verbal assault by anyone will not be tolerated, condoned, or ignored within our membership or at any event sponsored or hosted by the BC All Breed Pointer Club. Any such claims will be reviewed by the Board. If a claim of harassment or discrimination is determined, disciplinary measures will be applied, up to and including termination of membership, or suspension from participation in future events for a length of time as determined by the Board.

**CKC, Chapter 16**: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge is not subject to indignities. The Field Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

**LIABILITY:** All entries for this Field Test are accepted on condition that the BCABPC, its officials and members, land and horse owners, are released from all liabilities for loss, damage or injury sustained by

dog, horse or person in conjunction with, or during the running of, this Field Dog Test. All minors shall be under the direct care and supervision of the parent or guardian.


## GETTING THERE: Directions to the Deroche Site: Kerkoven Farms, Nicomen Island

From Vancouver: East on Hwy 1– North on the McCallum turnoff – through Abbottsford to Mission – East on Lougheed Hwy (#7) to the stop sign (it's in center of highway). Following #7 turn right over the railroad tracks & over the bridge at Nicomen Slough, continue on Loughheed Hwy (#7) over the island to Athey Road (just before the bridge to get off island), turn right and follow Athey Road to the end (keeping to the right).

\*\*\*PLEASE NOTE: If you went into Deroche – **you have gone too far** – turn around, come back over the bridge and turn left at the first road (Athey Road).
