Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. (For a Membership application, please go to www.ckc.ca under CKC Services and Forms On-Line). The Non-Member Participation Fee is fee paid in the calendar year (January – December) in which the dog achieved its title and/or titles.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

A class dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five points at any single show.

- To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club we will be unable to accept, cancel
 or substitute an entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing date. Moving class dogs to
 specials is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex many be amended on the entryform
 up to one hour before the start of the show.
- 2. All entry confirmations and Judging Schedules will be sent as soon as possible after entries close.
- 3. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY the receive of any electronic entries prior to the advertised closing date. A valid means of payment must accompany all entries.
- All exhibitors should review Section 4.1-Judges-General, sub sections 4.1.3, 4.1.4 & 4.1.5 of the CKC Conformation Rules and Regulations.
- Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
