# IMPORTANT!! IMPORTANT!!! PLEASE READ

RV'S AT THIS SHOW: Once again we have a large number of RV's at this show and because of this and very strict City of Edmonton and City Fire Marshall regulations, IT IS

ABSOLUTELY MANDATORY THAT YOU FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS OF THE RV PARKING PERSONNEL ... failure to do so will result in expulsion from the show and any future

NACA shows. No exceptions! An RV information sheet is included in this mailing-please read it and be familiar with the rules. RV parking will commence at 3:00. You are
welcome to line up at the gate before this, but you will not be parked prior to 3:00 unless the whole show is set up earlier. If you see RV's on the grounds, they are NACA
members who are setting up the show or commercial booths who will be let in at noon. If you did not reserve and pay for a spot in advance you will have to find a
campground in Edmonton or surrounding areas.

**TENT CITY:** If you reserved and paid for a tent spot please check in with the parking people at the gate who will direct you to your spot. If you did not reserve a spot please park your vehicle and look for a spot on the berms or around the fence edges.

<u>DAY VEHICLE PARKING:</u> Please park where directed. If parking to the south of the field is full, please go around to the North of the building and park on the residential streets. <u>Do not block driveways or park in no parking zones – by-law enforcers will be out writing tickets.</u>

WARM WATER DOG BATH AND HUMAN PAY SHOWERS - are located at the cement pad behind the building.

CONCESSION IN THE BUILDING & OUTDOOR HOT DOG STAND (next to the building) with hotdogs, chips, beer and pop.

**LICENSED LOUNGE WITH BIG SCREEN TV** upstairs in the building.

Thank you all for your acceptance of the rules we have to enforce – and know that we have tried our best to make this show an enjoyable one for everyone, despite the complications which arise at a show this size. We also know you understand how difficult it is to draft a judging schedule that makes everyone happy ... we are aware that some of you have a lot of grooming, some of you have more than one breed, etc. but with 15 specialties and a large all-breed entry it is difficult to make a "perfect" schedule for everyone. ## **CHANGE OF JUDGING ASSIGNMENTS**

CKC rules, 3.5.1. – "exhibitors affected by changes may withdraw their entries up to one hour before judging of the breed, providing that notice of withdrawal is made in writing. All entry and listing fees for withdrawn dogs shall be refunded." These changes also mean that dogs may be entered under the new judge if they were not previously entered but are listed in the show catalogue.

<u>June 4</u> – Dr. Terill Udenberg will judge Mastiffs, Newfoundlands, Portuguese Water Dogs, Rottweilers, Samoyeds, Schnauzers (Giant & Standard) Siberian Huskies, and St. Bernards.

<u>Directions to the show site:</u> Google or Garmin main hub: 50 Street and 101 Avenue (also called Baseline Road). All RV's must enter at the access off 101 Avenue (Baseline Rd). <u>Regular day parking</u> use the residential area north of the curling building (NO RV ACCESS TO GROUNDS). – vehicle only parking follow these directions: at the main corner of 50<sup>th</sup> Street and Baseline (101 Ave) go N past the little strip mall, turn R at the big steel post, continue turning R at intersections until you come to the curling building. <u>RV parking:</u> from South, follow Gateway Blvd N to Whitemud Dr, then E (R) to exit 50 St N (up off ramp, turn L) continue on 50 St to 101 Avenue, turn R at 101 and then L at first traffic lights. From N or W: Yellowhead Tr, exit on Wayne Gretzy Dr S to 101 Ave, then L (east) past 50 St. and L at next traffic lights. From E, Yellowhead Tr, exit 17 St S to 101 Ave, turn W (r) continue on 101 Ave past ESSO Strathcona refinery and turn R at first lights past refinery (Tiger Goldstick Park sign).

## THURSDAY JUNE 2/11 from 3:00PM to 10PM

### \*\*ALL EXHIBITORS WHO WISH TO CAMP TOGETHER MUST ARRIVE TOGETHER-NO EXCEPTIONS AS SPOTS CANNOT BE SAVED\*\*

- 1. Due to the large number of RV's our space is limited. We will be limiting sites as required by the size of the RV's. No more than 20-22 ft wide will be permitted. This is quite adequate for your trailer, awnings, and slide outs.
- 2. Attendants will direct you to your parking area. Abusive language and/or behaviour towards any Parking Attendant, Club Official, Ottewell Management or NACA member will result in the loss of parking privileges. The parking attendant will have a master list of paid reservations.
- 3. All tow vehicles must be kept within your designated site (not in the fire lanes) or parked in the designated parking areas.
- 4. There will be NO DRIVING allowed on the show grounds during the show hours. This is for the safety of everyone (two and four-legged). Day parking will be in designated areas only. Gates will be open during the lunch hour and after Best in Show each day.
- 5. All generator exhaust on motorhomes must have an upward pipe or exhaust hose pointing away from your neighbour's site. Small generators must have adequate ground cover. All generators must be turned off from 11:00PM to 6:00AM.
- 6. Exhibitors are responsible for their own property insurance. NACA will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- 7. No septic or grey water disposal is permitted on the grounds. There will be \$250.00 fine for anyone discharging septic or grey water.
- 8. This is a self clean-up event. All exhibitors will be held responsible for cleaning up after their dogs, grooming areas and camping sites. There are large waste bins for your convenience. Please use them.
- 9. No open fires allowed.
- 10. No camper's activities shall interfere with the activities of any other exhibitors.
- 11. If you reserved day tent spacing the parking personnel will direct you to your spot in TENT CITY, but whether you are in Tent City or find your own tenting spot, NO VEHICLES can be left at your tent. Please park out of the grounds.
- 12. Please be aware of the NO PARKING signs on the south service road as the City of Edmonton has advised us that they will be ticketing and towing any vehicles parked on the service road.
