Credit card and Interac entries are available at www.Dogshow.ca; 10% service charge applies.

Listing Fee: A listing fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form. The current listing fee is \$10 per trial (i.e. per dog, per day).

Event Registration Number: All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned require an event registration number (ERN) to enable them to be awarded titles by the CKC. Dogs may be entered as "listed"; however, an ERN must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation. Application forms may be obtained from the Field Trial Secretary.

Non-Member Participation Fee: An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled. NOTE: it is less expensive to become a CKC member than to pay this fee each year!

Puppy Stake: “A Puppy Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs at least 6 months of age and under 2 years of age on the day of the trial at which the Puppy Stake is judged.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 10, section 2*

Limit Stake: “A Limit Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for dogs that have not placed in an Open All-Age Stake, or received 2 first placements in any Regular Official Stake (Puppy Stake excepted), at an approved trial in Canada or any equivalent Spaniel trial in any other country. Dogs must be at least 6 months of age on the day of the trial.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 3*

Open All-Age Stake: “An Open All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 4*

Amateur All-Age: “An Amateur All-Age Stake at a Spaniel Field Trial shall be for all dogs at least six months of age on the day of the trial at which the stake is judged. A person shall be considered an amateur if, he has not attempted to receive any part of his livelihood from the training, handling or showing of field trial or hunting dogs in the calendar year of the trial or the preceding calendar year. Dogs running an Amateur Stake must be owned by an amateur and handled by an amateur.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations, Chapter 10, section 6*

Points: Championship Points are awarded for placements in the All-Age Stakes, provided that there are 12 or more starters:

1st Place - 5 Points, 2nd Place - 3 Points,
3rd Place - 2 Points, 4th Place - 1 Point

Indignities: “It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, field trial marshal, volunteer, or competitor at a field trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules and Regulations, Chapter 21, section 7*

TRIAL SITE – New. Rd. on Cape John outside of River John, NS

Take Exit #13 off Route 102 North to Provincial Route #2. Turn left on Provincial Route #2 and follow for approx. 2 miles. Turn left onto Hwy 311 and follow for approx 18.6 miles. Turn right onto Hwy 326 and follow for approx 12 miles. Turn right onto Provincial Secondary Route 6 and follow for approx. 6.5 miles. Turn left at Yap’s Restaurant (and gas station). Take the first right and follow trial signs. Map to follow.

- **Park** only as directed
- **Do not litter**
- Bring **water** for your dogs to the trial site
- **Lunch** - and pop, juice & bottled water will be available
- **Blaze Orange** “All Persons on trial grounds are required to wear an item with Blaze Orange above waist level for the sake of safety to be enforced by the Field Marshall” *CKC Sporting Spaniel Field Trial Rules & Regulations Chap. 17 Sec. 1*
 - **Please note that the club has instituted a new rule that both a blaze orange hat & vest must be worn by everyone when they are on the field. This will be strictly enforced by the Blaze Orange Police (BOP)!**
- **The consumption of alcoholic beverages on the property is strictly prohibited.**
