Acceptance Date: 8:00 AM, Monday, 10 June, 2013. Entries received before this date and time will be returned.

Closing Date: 6:00 PM, Friday, 5 July, 2013. Entries must be delivered to the Test Secretary by the closing date. The club cannot accept entries delivered after this date and time. After the closing date, the Test Secretary will send out acceptance letters or emails, advising entrants of the status of their entry.

These tests are held in accordance with CKC Rules and Regulations 2.2.4 Option #2. Entries will be accepted in the following order:

- Draw (1) Speciality breed without a title;
- Draw (2) Other breeds without a title;
- Draw (3) Speciality breed with a title;
- Draw (4) Other breeds with a title.

Entries must be mailed or sent by courier to the postal address of the Test Secretary. Faxed, e-mailed or hand delivered entries are not acceptable. Each entry must be mailed in a separate envelope. Entries will close automatically when the advertised limit has been reached, even if the official closing date for entries has not arrived. All entries must be made on an official CKC entry form. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, regardless of who completes the entry form. ***Incomplete or improper entry forms will not be accepted.*** To prevent delays, entrants

using couriers are encouraged to mark their envelope with the instructions "No Signature Required".

DRAW FOR TRACKS for TD & TDX on Wednesday, July 24th, 2013, will occur at 7:30 AM at the rendezvous site. The first TD Track will start at 8:00 AM. The first TDX Track will start at 10:00 AM.

NO POST DATED CHEQUES accepted. ALL NSF cheques are subject to a charge of \$20.00. N.S.F. Cheques are considered Non-Payment of entry fees and are punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. All fees must be paid before the tests. ***Attention Foreign exhibitors:*** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you.

Withdrawals and Entry Fee Refunds – If any entry withdrawals between the closing date and the test date, and is replaced by an alternate, the entry fee will be refunded. Withdrawals must be made in writing to the Test Secretary. Entries will be refunded within ten days of the tracking test to those on the alternate list who did not participate in the test. Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee.

Bitches in Season – Bitches in season will be allowed to participate but must run last and must be kept separated from all other dogs during the event.

ATTENTION ALL CANADIANS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS
Effective January 1, 2011, the CKC has instituted an annual Non-Member Participation Fee for awards and titles for a CANADIAN non-member of the CKC. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by a non-CKC member and are not applicable to CKC members. Non CKC member participants must either purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member participation fee within 30 days of notification or the CKC will cancel any awards and titles. At that time there were only Field Tracking titles. Since then she has titled several dogs in both field and urban tests. Presently she is training Groguard's Chaos who has gained his TD, TDX and UTD titles in tracking, CD and RA in Obedience and Rally Obedience and IPO3 in Schutzhund. She became a Tracking Judge in 2010 and has judged in Ontario, Quebec, Nova Scotia, PEI and New Brunswick. She is the CKC Tracking Representative for NB and PEI. Louise also shows in Conformation and trials in Obedience and Rally Obedience.
