Entry Information

1. No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Handlers or agents please note the full name and address of all owners must be filled in.
2. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by entry fees. Telephone and telegraph entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries were made.
3. There is no refund for duplicate cheques. Every effort will be made to find all duplicate entries, however if the entry has been processed and appears in the official catalogue, no refund will be made.
4. Alterations, substitutions or cancellations of any entry after the closing date is prohibited. Moving Class Dogs to Specials or unfinished Specials back to the classes is permitted. An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Only dogs already registered in the Canadian Kennel Club Stud Book, or eligible for such registration, can be entered. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules. **Entries close 8 P.M. (ET) Wednesday, May 3, 2023, and must be in the hands of the Show Secretary by that date.**
5. Identification cards and judging schedules will be e-mailed as soon as possible after the entries close.
6. Tendering of NSF cheques in payment of fees shall be considered non-payment of fees and is punishable by disciplinary action. **Any NSF cheques will be subject to a \$35 service charge.**

General Information

1. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC Rules.
2. The K-W Kennel Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability in the event of accident, or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
3. If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.
4. Dogs should arrive in adequate time for their breed judging (allowing for absentees) and will be excused each show when not required for further judging. It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to have the dog at ringside when the dog's class is scheduled for judging. Waiting for dogs will not be possible and handlers with several breeds must arrange for alternate handlers if judging times conflict.
5. Judging will commence at 8 a.m. each day. A later starting time may be specified in the judging schedule. Starting time of each ring will be specified in judging schedule.
6. The building will be open from 6:30 a.m. on Saturday, Sunday and Monday. Access to the building will be available from 2:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Friday night for setup.
7. **A LIMITED AMOUNT OF GROOMING FLOOR SPACE IS AVAILABLE TO HANDLERS/GROUPS WITH 10 OR MORE DOGS. OTHERWISE GROOMING SPACE IS FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE. NO SETTING UP IN CORRIDORS BETWEEN ARENAS.**

Refund Policy If, because of riot, civil disturbance or other acts beyond the control of management, it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of Entry will be made.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN) A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN).

A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event.

The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

TCNs can be obtained through your CKC member portal or by contacting the CKC.

Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN. However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.

Event Registration Number (ERN) All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registration number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Fee is \$64.00 per dog, plus applicable taxes.

Non-Member Participation Fee Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$170.00 plus applicable taxes.
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.

The Examination

1. A short health survey regarding the dog's breathing history.
2. A brief physical exam while the dog is calm including auscultation where the assessor listens to the dog's breathing with a stethoscope gently positioned on the side of the neck. This establishes a baseline for any clinical signs of BOAS.
3. A short exercise testing consisting of a brisk three-minute walk. This is designed to expose clinical signs of the disease in an otherwise calm and asymptomatic dog. It is not designed to assess cardiovascular fitness.
4. A post exercise auscultation after increased airway activity to compare to the pre-exercise baseline.

RFG Scheme Screening

The noise the trained veterinarians are listening for during auscultation include:

- **Stertor** - a low pitched vibrational noise heard above the level of the larynx
- **Stridor** - higher pitched 'sawing' noise heard over the larynx
- **Nasal stertor** - low pitched nasal snort/vibration
- **Nasal stridor** - high pitched nasal whistle, usually on breathing in

RFG Scheme - What Does the Grading Mean?

The Respiratory Function Grading Scheme (RFGS) utilizes a sliding scale of 0 to 3 to objectively diagnosis BOAS:

- **Grade 0** - the dog is clinically unaffected and free of respiratory signs of BOAS (no evidence of disease, no BOAS related noise heard even with a stethoscope)
- **Grade 1** - the dog is clinically unaffected but have mild respiratory signs linked to BOAS (noise is mild and only audible with a stethoscope)
- **Grade 2** - the dog is clinically affected and has moderate respiratory signs of BOAS (noise is audible even without a stethoscope)
- **Grade 3** - the dog is clinically affected and has severe respiratory signs of BOAS (noise is audible even without a stethoscope)

Publication of Results

Grade 0 and Grade 1 - are considered clinically normal and BOAS unaffected as they exercise without difficulty and do not appear to have any clinical signs related to airway obstruction.

Clinically normal dogs (**Grade 0 and 1**) will receive OFA certificate numbers, and their results will be posted on the OFA website.

Grade 2 and Grade 3 - when stertor or stridor noise is heard without a stethoscope, whether intermittent or continuous, these dogs are considered affected with clinical signs affecting their quality or life.

Grade 2 or 3 results will only be posted on the OFA website if their owners authorize release of abnormal data.

BOAS Breeding Recommendations

Using the RFG Scheme grades are the guidelines in the chart, concerned responsible breeders can apply the selective genetic pressure to reduce the chances of producing puppies affected by BOAS.

However, since the inheritance of BOAS is not fully understood and is not entirely predictable, this guideline cannot guarantee that all puppies from unaffected parents will be free of BOAS.

Ultimately, responsible breeders use the RFG Scheme to screen their breeding stock and include the results in their selection criteria.

SENIOR PUPPY – A dog between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show.

12-18 MONTHS – A dog between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show.

12-15 MONTHS – A dog between 12 months and under 15 months on day of show.

15-18 MONTHS – A dog between 15 months and under 18 months on day of show.

CANADIAN BRED – A dog born in Canada.

BRED BY EXHIBITOR – Dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder. The handler must be the owner/co-owner AND breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The breeder/owner must handle the dog in this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards.

OPEN CLASS – For all dogs.

FIELD CLASS – Dogs must have attained a title or placement in a field trial or test. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

VETERANS CLASS – For all dogs over 7 years of age as of the date of the show. These dogs compete for the regular placements, and the 1st-place dog and bitch will compete for Best of Breed. Veterans may be broken down into separate age categories. The winner of the Veterans Class will not compete for points but go directly into the Best of Breed competition. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered.

ALTERED – Limited to dogs and bitches over 6 months of age that have been sexually altered by veterinarian procedure.

SPECIALS ONLY – Dogs that are Canadian Champions.

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CLASSES:

BABY PUPPY – A dog between 4 months and under 6 months on day of show. Baby Puppies do not compete for points.

STUD DOG & GET – Stud Dog and two or more of his get. Stud must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a Regular class. Stud Dog may be neutered. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

BROOD BITCH & PROGENY – Brood Bitch and two or more of her progeny. Brood Bitch must be entered in a Regular class or Exhibition Only. Progeny must be entered in a Regular class. Brood Bitch may be spayed. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

BRACE – Two dogs shown by a single handler on one lead. Ownership in this class need not be identical.

EXHIBITION ONLY – All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in Regular competition. Dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular/Unofficial classes and/or Parades.

CH and Champion Points

Section 15.1.1 A dog awarded Winners at a conformation show shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the number of championship points credited to a dog awarded Winners shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 15.1.2 The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

Dogs competing*	1	2	3 to 5	6 to 9	10 to 12	13 or more
Points allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

**includes the dog awarded Winners*

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge **SHALL NOT** be included in the calculation for championship points.

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed, or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above.

Section 15.1.8 In addition to championship points allocated at the breed level, a dog awarded Best of Breed that also places in the regular group competition shall be credited with the following additional points, provided that a dog was defeated at the group level.

Section 15.1.11 A class dog awarded Best in Show at an all-breed Championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned 10 championship points under at least three (3) different judges, with at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

GCH and Grand Champion Points

Section 15.2.1 The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship.

15.2.2 Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship.

Section 15.2.3 To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

- a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title, are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

- c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points.
- d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Section 15.2.4 Grand Champion Bronze (GChB)

The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.
- c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

Section 15.2.5 Grand Champion Silver (GChS)

The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Section 15.2.6 Grand Champion Gold (GChG)

The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained.

- a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver.
- b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best In Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

GCHEx and Grand Champion Excellent Points

The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website.

Section 15.3.2 To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special:

- a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed).
- b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty Best of Breed wins.
- c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles.

Section 15.3.3 Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career.

Altered Champion and Altered Points

Section 13.8.1 Championship points will be awarded as per Chapter 15, with the exception of 15.1.11. The winner of an Altered Best in Show shall be awarded points according to the total number of dogs in competition following the point schedule in Section 15.1.2.

Section 15.1.12 In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion [Alt] and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.

Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. **Section 4.7.3** of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Moving Class Dog to Specials Only

Section 8.9 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations has been amended to allow a dog which is individually registered in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club, and has completed the requirements for a Championship, after the Closing Date for entries for a show, may be transferred from one of the Regular Classes to "Specials Only," providing the request for a transfer is submitted to the Show Secretary in WRITING at least one hour prior to the judging of your breed by the owner or handler.

When one or more all-breed and/or specialty shows are held on the same day, in the same venue, the request for moving of class dogs to Specials Only must be made a minimum of one (1) hour prior to the breed judging scheduled start of the show for which the dog is being moved up to Specials Only.

Moving from Specials Back to the Classes

Section 8.10.5 A dog can be moved back into the classes from a Special if it has been entered incorrectly, only where the shows have already closed.



HEALTH REMINDERS

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN)

A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.

A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a Miscellaneous Certificate Number (MCN), a PEN or a CCN number.

Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN. However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.

Event Registration Number (ERN)

All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registration number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.

Performance Event Number (PEN)

A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows a non-registrable dog of a **CKC-RECOGNIZED BREED** to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. To be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following must be met:

- The dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC (**not** on the CKC Miscellaneous Class List).
- The dog must not be eligible for CKC registration.
- The dog must be spayed or neutered.
- The dog must be properly identified with a CKC-approved microchip.

A dog that is eligible for a PEN may not be entered as a 'listed' dog.

Canine Companion Number (CCN)

A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows **MIXED-BREED DOGS** and **UNRECOGNIZED BREEDS** to compete in CKC performance events. To be eligible to receive a CCN, all the following must be met:

Mixed Breeds & Unrecognized Breeds

- The dog must be either a Mixed Breed or an Unrecognized Breed.
- Mixed Breed dogs must be spayed or neutered.
- Unrecognized Breeds are not required to be spayed or neutered.
- The dog must be properly identified with a CKC microchip.

A dog that is eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a 'listed' dog.

All the above 'registration' numbers can be obtained:

- Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit an application online); or
 - By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC.

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.

Trophy List

Through the generosity of members and friends, the K-W Kennel Club will offer, unless otherwise stated, the following awards:

A rosette will be offered for 1st to 4th in each class.

New Title Rosettes will be offered. Ribbons for all qualifying scores. Exhibitor prize for every dog entered.

Limited Entry

RALLY: Entry in each rally obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 10 dogs per hour less time for walk-throughs. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging.

Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial.

Mixed & Unrecognized Breeds

These trials are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered.

Unrecognized breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. ***A dog eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.***

Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club.

Section 17.7 of the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a rally Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Change of Entry / Moving Up

The entry of a dog entered in an official obedience or rally trial class in accordance with these rules may be changed to another official class within the same trial. The change must be on the appropriate form and submitted to the Trial Secretary by the owner or handler at least thirty (30) minutes before the start of the trial.

Rally Champion (RCH)

Section 16.1 The CKC will permit the use of the letters RCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.

Section 16.2 A dog may begin earning points toward the RCH title as soon as the Rally Master (RM) title requirements have been completed.

Section 16.3 The RCH title will be awarded to dogs that have successfully earned a minimum of 100 points total from competing in both the Excellent B and Master classes in the same trial.

- (a) 50 points must come from the Rally Excellent B class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.
- (b) 50 points must come from the Rally Master class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.

Section 16.4 A qualifying score must be earned in both the Excellent B class and the Master class in the same trial on five (5) different occasions under at least five (5) different judges

BEFORE YOU ENTER A RALLY "A" CLASS!

If the dog you are entering has earned any CKC obedience title other than a PCD (e.g., CD, CDX, OTCH), the dog CANNOT be entered in any Rally "A" class.

Handlers who have exhibited any dog to a CKC CDX title CANNOT enter the "A" classes.

Entering the wrong class will result in the cancellation of legs and titles.
