



### Directions to The Red Barn Event Centre:

From the 400: Take the Essa Road exit. Turn west on Essa (sign says Essa Road South). Turn right at Ardagh Road. Follow Ardagh to County Road 27. Go South on County Road 27. (aka Town Line Road) Property is on the west side of the road down a long driveway. There is a private residence at the front of the property.

From CR 27 South: Follow CR 27 northbound through Thorton. Continue north. After 5 minutes, look for signs on your right that show you have to turn LEFT to stay on CR 27. When you see that sign, turn left, continue on CR 27. When you come down the big hill look for our white flags on the west (left) side of the road. If you get to lights at Ardagh, you've gone too far.

General Information	Trial Secretary and Superintendent is in full charge of the Trials. The show precincts shall consist of the agility course, trial building and camping area. Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles, clickers, flexis or other instruments or devices in the ring or within in the building. Bitches in Season are also NOT permitted any where at the trial venue. Dogs must be ON LEASH at all times when outside the ring, in the building as well as on the trial grounds.
Event Information	Agility, Obedience & Rally Ring Surface is Top Dog rubber agility flooring with underlay. Agility handlers in all classes will be able to walk their course, without their dog prior to the start of the class. Handlers must be ready at the start line when called or risk forfeiting their run. If a dog is not at ringside after it has been called 3 times, it will be marked absent. Please advise us ASAP if you have a conflict and we will accommodate your needs.
Agility Obstacles	Obstacle familiarization will be available for Novice classes immediately prior to the first Novice Standard class. Obstacles shall meet the specifications in the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations effective January 1. 2010.
Agility Eligibility	To be eligible to compete in the agility trials, a dog must be 18 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN) Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.
Obedience & Rally Eligibility	To be eligible to compete in the obedience or rally trials, a dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN or CKC Miscellaneous Certificate or Performance Event Number (PEN) Spayed bitches, debarked dogs, and neutered males are eligible to participate.
Bitches in Season	Bitches in season <u>may not compete</u> . When a bitch comes into season after the entry has closed a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial must reach the secretary on or before the start of the trial. A full refund of entry fees and listing fees will be given. However, if a credit card was used, the processing fee will not be refunded.
Ribbons/Trophies	Ribbons will be given for 1st through 4th qualifying scores in all Jump Heights in Agility trials and in all classes in Obedience and Rally Obedience. <b>To prevent an increase in entry fees, New Title Rosettes will be available at a cost of \$6.00. Tabs with the title name are still no charge.</b>

## **HELP WANTED for Agility Trials**

Without the help from volunteers, we could not host these trials. We cannot do it alone! We need your help to make our trial a success. PLEASE sign up to work at the registration desk at the trials.

### **Job Descriptions**

**Gate Steward:** Makes sure exhibitors are at the gate, in the correct order and ready to run

**Ring Steward:** Sets bars to correct positions prior to each jump height in a class. Re-sets dropped bars, straightens chute

**Leash Runner:** Takes exhibitor's leash from start line and places it at finish

**Scribe:** Marks faults on scribe sheet as they are called by the judge

**Timer:** Times the dogs' runs using a stopwatch

**Course Builder:** Assists the Chief Course Builder with putting obstacles in the correct position as indicated by the judge

---

### **Are you in the correct Class, please note changes?**

**Selected Class:** Any dog eligible to enter an agility trial may enter the Selected Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Selected and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Dogs will jump one jump height lower than its Regular jump height and get 10% more time than the STC.

**Novice** is for dogs that have never acquired a CKC agility title in that class. Dogs may continue to compete in Novice once they have acquired that title, but must be moved up once they have a leg in Intermediate in that class.

**Excellent** is for dogs that have acquired the Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title in either Standard or JWW.

**Master Excellent (formerly Excellent B)** is for dogs that have acquired the Excellent title or the Master Excellent Title. A dog may move up into Master Excellent in only the Standard or JWW class that they have earned an Excellent Title in. A dog only needs to be entered in Master Excellent for the class that he/she has achieved the excellent title in. ie. A dog can be in Excellent JWW and Master Excellent Standard.

**Veteran Class:** a dog 7 years of age or older may be entered in the Veterans Class. Once a dog has been designated as a Veteran and entered in this class, the dog cannot revert/transfer back to the Regular or Selected Classes. The dog will retain titles and/or Qualifying scores towards titles accumulated. Dogs will jump one or two jump heights lower than its Regular jump height and this class will get 10% more time than the Regular Standard course time.
