GENERAL INFORMATION AND TEST RULES (page 4)

Validation of entries: All participants are required to fill out and sign the Earthdog Participation Agreement on the reverse of the entry form. Entries submitted without this agreement filled and signed will be refused participation in the tests. Entry Line entries must sign the EPA prior to competing.

Move-ups: Move ups are permissible from IQ to JE one (1) hour before the event or immediately upon completion of IQ level. Move-ups are **NOT** permissible in the regular classes in one test, but are permissible for the next test. (eg: dogs entered for JE for both Sat. & Sun. tests, but completing JE on Sat test may move up to SE for the Sun. test). The test secretary must be notified of any move up one (1) hour before the event.

Bitches in Season: 6.6.4 Bitches in season shall **NOT** be eligible to compete in the Test. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the Test Secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the test, must reach the Test Secretary on or before the date of the Test. Alternatively, the bitch may be presented to a member of the test committee no later than one (1) hour before the scheduled start time to determine that she is in season. The test giving club must refund the entry fee, service charge and listing fee.

Awards and Prizes: Qualifiers in the Introduction to Quarry test will receive flat ribbons. Qualifiers in Junior, Senior and Master Earthdog tests will receive rosettes and an individual prize. In order to be awarded a CKC title Canadian non-CKC members must pay a CKC fee ("these fees applly only to dogs wholly owned non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members")

Schedule: The secretary's taable will be open for check in from 7:30am on May11th and May 12th. Gate entries will be accepted up to one (1) hour before the scheduled starting time of each test.


Border Crossing: A valid rabies certificate is required to bring a dog into Canada. Government regulations require a certificate and it must be dated at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada. Canadian Food Inspection Agency regulation can be viewed at: http://www.inspection.gc.ca.

Event Registration Number (Foreign Born/Owned Dogs): For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain CKC titles, individual registration is not required for foreign born/owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of entering first CKC event to avoid cancellation. Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate and the appropriate fee (\$56.95 Canadian funds) along with completed application form. The form can be downloaded from www.ckc.ca or ordered from the CKC order desk at 1-800-250-8040.

Regulations: It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the CKC **Earthdog Test Rules & Regulations** are available from the Canadian Kennel Club at 1-800-250-8040.

CKC Regulation 15.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an Earthdog test held under these regulations, is not subject to any indignities. The Earthdog Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Disicipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.

CKC Regulation 10,5.3 (d): During the test, the dogs are expected to work together without interference or aggression. The judge may excuse from the test any dog which willfully interferes with its bracemate, either playfully or with malice, or any dog whose behaviour is out of control in the opinion of the judge The judge must dismiss any dog which attacks its bracemate. The judge must report any incident resulting in an excusal or dismissal to the test secretary, who shall report such to the CkC. Any dog that has been dismissed twice shall be barred from participation in CKC Earthdog Master tests until reinstated by the CKC. In th case of one dog being excused or dismissed, the remaining dog shall be picked up and run as or with the bye-dog.
