Open to any Afghan, Basenji, Borzoi, Greyhound, Ibizan, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hound, Saluki, Scottish Deerhound, Whippet, Irish Wolfhound or CKC Miscellaneous Sighthound that is one year or older the day of the trial. All entrants must be registered or eligible for registration, with the Canadian Kennel Club, have ERN # or PEN #. Hounds presently disqualified or declared ineligible under CKC, ASFA, CSFA OR AKC rules cannot compete. Hounds with breed standard disqualifications, or altered/neutered are eligible to enter the lure field trial. **Hounds must pre-qualify prior to entering their first trial in Canada. See enclosed form.**

**From the North:**

Hwy #2 South to Stoney Trial Hwy #201. Follow Stoney Trial East to the Country Hills Blvd Exit (**exit 68**) Go East on Country Hills Blvd (Hwy # 564) for 17.2 km to Hwy #9. South on Hwy #9 3.2 km (2 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). East 1.6 km (1 mile) to Rge Rd 271. Right turn-South to first acreage. Use field entrance not private driveway.

**From the South:**

QE Hwy #2 North to Stoney Trail Exit 234A. Exit East (right) on Stoney Trail to Hwy #22X East Exit 96. Take Hwy #22X Exit East to Langdon Corner (Rge Rd 272). Signage for Boulder Creek Golf Course. North on Rge Rd 272 to 4-way Stop at Langdon. Continue North (now on Hwy 797) to Hwy #1. Cross Hwy #1 onto Hwy #9. North on Hwy #9 for 9.6 km (6 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). At this point, follow directions from North. **Your GPS may want to take you down Twp Rd 250. Ignore it and take Twp Rd 252.**

**From the West:**

Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Stoney Trial Hwy #201. Follow Stoney Trial to the Country Hills Blvd Exit (**exit 68**) At this point, follow directions from North.

Trans Canada Hwy (#1) to Hwy #9. Turn Right on Hwy #9 and go North on Hwy #9 for 9.6 km (6 miles) to Dalroy Road (Twp Rd 252). At this point, follow directions from North.

**SINGLES COMPETITION-Limit of Five Singles on Friday and Ten Saturday & Sunday**

**Roll Call 1:00PM July 3, 9:00 AM July 4&5.** Your dog is DQ'd or not ready for running

in competition, but you would like your dog judged? This is the place to be! Dogs will be run individually and scored by both judges. Hounds will run after the open stake has completed its preliminary round and then again after the open stake has completed its final round. A random draw will determine the order of running of dogs in this stake. Dogs must wear a blanket. No points are awarded and all ties are settled by a coin toss. A trophy and ribbon will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup> place and ribbons for 2<sup>nd</sup> to NBQ.

**Take a Walk with the Judges**

**As part of their judging assignment, our judges must walk the course to ensure that a safe course plan has been laid out for *your* hounds. On this field that means looking for and filling holes. You and a shovel are encouraged to join them in assuring the safety of *your* hounds.**



*Placements and Awards*

Chapter 7, Section 1: Championship points are awarded in regular stakes only on the following basis:

- 1st: 4 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 40 points
- 2nd: 3 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 30 points
- 3rd: 2 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 20 points
- 4th: 1 x # of hounds competing in stake, to a max. of 10 points
- NBQ: No points

No hound shall receive a placement or points if it does not score at least 50% of the total possible combined scores. If a hound has been **excused** in the preliminary run, that hound shall not count as having been in competition.

**All prizes must be claimed at the trial. They will NOT be mailed.**

## PRACTICES AND HOUND CERTIFICATION

### First Time Entered Hounds:

Effective July 1 1998, hounds entering their first trial in Canada must be tested with another hound, preferably not a kennel mate, and certified running clean by a licensed judge. The CKC Hound Certification Form (included with this premium list) must be completed and **submitted with the entry at the hound's first trial**. Hounds with the following titles are exempt: ASFA FCh or VFCh, AKC FC, SC or DC, but are still required to submit the Hound Certification Form with their name and exempt titles circled.

### ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective January 1, 1992 all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an **Event Registration Number (ERN)**. This ERN does not register a dog for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. Cost is \$58.85. ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT TO AVOID CANCELLATION OF AWARDS.

**Exhibitors Please Note:** It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules is not subject to any indignities of any kind. The Field Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

## Non Member Participation Fee

The following non-member participation fee now applies. The non-member participation fee applies to all Canadian residents who participate in a CKC event but are not CKC members and a participating non-member can chose to purchase a CKC membership or pay the non-member fee. This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member. In order for the CKC to efficiently manage recording and tracking points, it's important that non-members select one of the two options within 30 days of notification or, unfortunately, CKC will be forced to cancel any awards and titles

### Non-Member Participation Fee

#### 24-12-3. Non-member participation fee

- a) An **annual** non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members."

### Las Vegas Lure Coursing 50/50 May be offered

You may enter any sighthound you own or have owned. Entry is \$2/dog. Sign up at Roll Call to 10 am. Breeds are not split into multiple stakes.

Two judges start with scores of 70. At sign up two cards are drawn from a standard deck. These are your preliminary scores. Ace to ten are face value, Jacks-11, Queens-12, Kings-13 and a Joker is an excusal. E.G. drawing a 7 and King would equate to a 77 and an 83. During lunch break the second group of cards is drawn for the finals.

All scores are tallied to determine BoB winners. Any ties are determined by a "draw off". BoB winners will then draw for Best in Field

Best in Field takes 50% of the proceeds as does the Club.

Eligibility for the **Sexually Altered Dog Classes** shall be limited to dogs over 12 months of age which have been sexually altered by veterinary procedure. These classes will be judged immediately after Best of Breed of the regular classes. Two classes will be offered: **Altered Male & Altered Female**. Classes will be placed first through fourth in both sexes, the first place winner from each class will be declared Winners and the second place winner will be declared Reserve Winners. The Altered Winners Male and the Altered Winners Female will then compete for Best of Breed Altered and Best of Opposite Sex Altered in breed. Best of Breed Altered winners will compete for Best Altered in Specialty.
