### Equipment and course familiarization:

- Electronic Timers will be used.
- Rubberized Contacts
- There will be NO contact equipment familiarization.
- A warm – up area with a single practice jump will be provided for dogs entered in the trials.
- NO toys that make squeaky sounds will be permitted within 15 feet of the rings.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class
- **As per CKC Rules move ups are allowed one hour prior to commencement of the start of each trial each day. Same day move ups will be allowed.**
- **Day of entries allowed (space permitting) up to one hour prior to the commencement of the start of trials each day.**
- **We will try to accommodate dogs with conflicts in conformation/obedience/rally provided handlers inform gate stewards in advance, however we cannot hold the rings. Handlers please call out your dog's name to the scribe when entering the ring.**

### CKC AGILITY HEIGHT CLASSES

**Height Divisions** - owners are responsible for entering the correct height divisions. The judge may require any dog to be measured.

#### **REGULAR CLASSES: Standard, JWW, Steeplechase, Jumps and Tunnels & PAD**

8 inches ----- -for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers  
12 inches----- -for dogs over 11 inches up to and including 14 inches at the withers  
16 inches----- -for dogs over 14 inches up to and including 18 inches at the withers  
20 inches----- -for dogs over 18 inches up to and including 22 inches at the withers  
24 inches----- -for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

#### **SELECTED CLASSES: Standard, JWW, Steeplechase Jumps and Tunnels & PAD**

4 inches ----- -for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers  
8 inches ----- -for dogs over 11 inches up to and including 14 inches at the withers  
12 inches----- -for dogs over 14 inches up to and including 18 inches at the withers  
16 inches----- -for dogs over 18 inches up to and including 22 inches at the withers  
20 inches----- -for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

#### **VETERANS CLASSES: Standard, JWW, Steeplechase Jumps and Tunnels & PAD**

4 inches ----- -for dogs 11 inches and under at the withers  
4 or 8 inches ----- -for dogs over 11 inches up to and including 14 inches at the withers  
8 or 12 inches----- -for dogs over 14 inches up to and including 18 inches at the withers  
12 or 16 inches ---- -for dogs over 18 inches up to and including 22 inches at the withers  
16 or 20 inches ---- -for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

The following breeds, or mixed breed dogs that resemble these breeds in relation to weight to shoulder height ratios, are permitted (but not required) to jump either ONE or TWO jump height(s) lower than the designated shoulder height when they show in the Selected division.

Small Breeds: Basset Hound, Bulldog, Cesky Terrier, Clumber spaniel, Dachshund (all six varieties), Dandie Dinmont Terrier, French bulldog, Pekingese, Petit Basset Griffon Vendeen, Scottish Terrier, Sealyham Terrier, Skye Terrier, Welsh Corgi (Cardigan & Pembroke)

Giant Breeds: Bernese Mountain Dog, Black Russian Terrier, Bloodhound, Bullmastiff, Great Dane, Great Pyrenees, Greater Swiss Mountain Dog, Irish Wolfhound, Leonberger, Mastiff, Neopolitan Mastiff, Newfoundland, Saint Bernard

If a CKC registration number is received after the closing date but prior to the date of the show, this number may be added to the entry and noted in the marked catalogue. TCN fees will not be refunded. This will then allow a dog who completes the requirements for Championship status to be moved up to "Specials"

**Entries will be accepted after the pre-entry deadline with the following conditions:**

- There will be no discount packages allowed; the price of each run will be \$30.00.
- Entry must be received by 1 hour prior to the scheduled start of the trial being entered.
- Additional classes added after pre-entry closing to an existing entry will be processed at the exhibitor's previous discount, no further discounts will be applied.
- FFO\* (For Fun Only) Runs are NOT included in the discounted total run fee. No refunds will be given for any difference in fees already paid if an exhibitor switches a regular run to a FFO run at the trial.
- **CASH ONLY FOR POST CLOSING ENTRIES**
- NO Refunds will be given after early bird close of entries (July 24, 2023 at 10pm MDT) except in the case of a bitch in season or an injured dog – see rules on the next page.

Cheques post-dated up until closing date of entries will be accepted as meeting the closing date.

Cheques post-dated after pre-entry date will be accepted at post deadline rate – NO DISCOUNTS ALLOWED.

## **ENTRY FEE INFORMATION**

**NO entry will be accepted without payment in full.** Tendering of a N.S.F. cheque in payment of entry fees or declined credit card in payment of entry is considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards.

**All N.S.F. cheques and declined credit cards will be assessed a \$50.00 service charge.** (Chapter 8.8, C.K.C. Dog Show Rules). There will not be any refunds on duplicate entries or over payments.

The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any errors in the entering of the dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

**Courier entries must be prepaid for delivery, no signature required and WILL NOT BE PICKED UP.**

**Do not send entries by Registered Mail.**

Please note that personal cheques will be accepted, however, fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors:

Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank You.

## **VOLUNTEER RULES**

**ANYONE volunteering or AKC representative who is in the ring is NOT to have a cell phone, or any food or drink except water. For liability reasons, ALL "ring Crew" (volunteer/AKC representative) must be AT least 14 years of age unless previously approved by the AKC Agility committee. Proof of age may be requested. There will be volunteer basket draw for each day.**

### **Bitch in Season**

Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch entered in Agility, Rally/Obedience comes into season after the close of entries if a Veterinarian's Certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Show Secretary on or before the starting date and time of the trial. The Alberta Kennel Club will refund entry, recording and TCN fees if the above conditions are met. A 50% refund of entry fees only will be made for a bitch in season without a veterinarian's certificate with written notification presented to the Show Secretary at least ONE HOUR before the start of the Trials. The bitch must be available to be examined by the Show Superintendent to verify she is in season.

### **Injured Dogs (12-05-19)**

6.11.1 If a dog is injured after entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the dog was injured before a 3 day period preceding the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the start of the trial. The trial-giving club may refund the entry fee but will keep a service charge and TCN fee. The refund and the terms thereof must be clearly stated in the premium list. The Alberta Kennel Club will be keeping a \$5/run service fee and any TCN fees collected (if applicable).

**No other refunds will be issued after early bird closing (July 24, 2023).**

## AGILITY ONLY BENCHING

Pre-paid reserved benching, in close proximity to the agility rings, will be available to CKC agility exhibitors beginning 3:00 pm Thursday, Aug 3. You **MUST** reserve benching for this area. The cost will be \$55 for the weekend. **Very limited space** will be available free of charge in the Day Benching area. **THERE WILL BE NO SHADE TENT FOR DAY BENCHING PROVIDED THIS YEAR, SO PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY.** Spots will be first come first served and once the day space is filled no other spots will be made available. **Nothing** can remain in the Day Benching area overnight. **No overnight benching is allowed other than the prepaid reserved benching.** **You will be asked to move if you are benched outside of designated benching areas.**

## AGILITY PRIZES

Jennifer Chipperfield of **CHIPPERFIELD PHOTOGRAPHY** is pleased to offer 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place cash prizes in the amounts of \$175, \$150, \$100 and \$50 respectively to the agility top dogs achieving the top 4 aggregate scores in Standard and JWW Classes in the CKC Agility Trials being held from August 4 to 7, 2023. In the case of a tie, prize money for that place and the one(s) below it (if applicable) will be combined and then split between those competitors. Steeplechase, Jumps & Tunnels and PAD scores will not be considered when calculating placements for the cash prizes. Prizes may be mailed out.

***Again, this year:*** To be eligible for these prizes, competitors **must** obtain a tracking sheet from the Trial Secretary to record the dog's qualifying runs. This form must be completed and submitted to the Trial Secretary's desk within 1/2 hour of the completion of the Standard Runs/Jumpers with Weaves runs of Trial 8 on Monday.

The points will be awarded as follows for each Qualifying run earned over the two days:

<u>Novice:</u>	<u>2 pts</u>
<u>Intermediate:</u>	<u>3 pts</u>
<u>Excellent:</u>	<u>4 pts</u>
<u>Master Excellent:</u>	<u>5 pts</u>

**JUNIOR HANDLER PRIZE** – Marnie Harrison and Praderia Spanish Water Dogs is pleased to offer a prize to the Junior Handler (Under 18 as of Aug 1, 2023) achieving the most qualifying Standard runs with one or more dogs over the 4 days of trials. To be eligible, Junior Handlers must sign up at the Agility Secretary's desk by noon Saturday, Aug 5, 2023. In the case of a tie, the prize will be split between those competitors.

Flat Ribbons will be provided for all dogs receiving a qualifying score & 1<sup>st</sup> – 4<sup>th</sup> in each height class. Rosettes will be provided for dogs earning new titles. Rosettes will also be provided for dogs achieving Agility Master Champion.

### ***NEW THIS YEAR – TRACKING SHEET FOR BOOSTER PRIZES!!!***

*In order to streamline the prizes this year, and to ensure that everyone gets their prize in a timely manner, AKC has decided to have prize tracking sheets for boosters. To be eligible for these prizes, competitors **must** obtain a tracking sheet from the Trial Secretary to record the dog's qualifying runs. This form must be completed and submitted to the Trial Secretary's desk within 15 minutes of the completion of the trials on Saturday.*

*Agility Booster Prizes will be available for pick up after Noon on Sunday. Any booster prizes not picked up by the end of the day on Monday will be considered a donation to AKC to be used for future prizes.*

A prize and/or rosette will be offered to the Keeshond achieving the highest qualifying score in a Jumpers with Weaves round at the Alberta Kennel Club All-breed Agility Trials. In the event of a tie, the award will be given to the class of higher difficulty.

**The Southern Alberta Toy Dog Fanciers – AKC Agility Trial - on Friday, August 4, 2023**

An SATDF rosette will be offered to the Toy Dog achieving the highest qualifying score in a Standard round at the Alberta Kennel Club All-breed Agility Trials. In the event of a tie, the award will be given to the class of higher difficulty.

**The Staffordshire Bull Terrier Club of Canada – AKC Agility Trial # 1, # 2, # 3 and #4 – Fri Aug 4 and Sat Aug 5, 2023**

A prize and/or rosette will be offered to the Staffordshire Bull Terrier achieving the high point average based on Trials #1, #2, #3 & #4 and the new point format system, in a Standard or Jumpers with Weaves round at the Alberta Kennel Club All-breed Agility Trials.
