**As per CKC Section 2.2.4, this test is open to mixed breeds and unrecognized breeds.  
As per Section 6, all entries must be registered with CKC or have one of the following:**

**CCN: Canine Companion Number** A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows mixed and unrecognized breed dogs to participate in CKC Performance Events.

**ERN: Event Registration Number** All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned that enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number. The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Please visit the CKC website for further details.

**MCN: Miscellaneous Certification Number** A Miscellaneous Certification Number can be obtained upon written request, accompanied by copies of the dog's certified pedigree and certificate of registration, verified in writing by the owner as being current and valid, and a fee as noted in the Schedule of Fees available on the CKC website.

**TCN: Temporary Competition Number** As of March 2, 2020, all owners of unregistered, CKC recognized breeds, entering events are required to obtain a TCN. TCNs replace the previous system of entering dogs as Listed and allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN. A TCN cannot be used for Listed Breeds with a Miscellaneous Competition Number (MCN) or dogs that will require a Performance Event Number (PEN) or Canine Companion Number (CCN). Please visit the CKC website for further details. Or call Shows and Trials Division 1-855-364-7252 A Temporary Competition fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.

**Non-Member Participation Fee:** A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual. In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level. The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members

## ENTRIES

Entries must be delivered by mail, courier (no signature required) or hand delivery to the Test Secretary by the closing date. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate fee. The club cannot accept entries delivered after this date and time. Fees are payable to: Fredericton Kennel Club. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. NSF cheques are considered non-payment of entry fees and will be charged a fee of \$25. Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Bank drafts or INTERNATIONAL money orders payable in Canadian funds are acceptable. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

All entries received prior to the closing date will be acknowledged by email or telephone and entered in the entry draw. A random draw of all non-duplicate entries will be conducted 19 September 2020 at 9 am at the home of the test secretary. Any interested parties may attend the draw. After all the tracks have been filled, the draw will continue to create a list of alternates in the order drawn.

After the random draw, the club will send out emails or will telephone advising entrants of the status of their entry. A map showing directions to the rendezvous site will be provided if necessary. Entries from the Alternate List may fill any absentee spaces up until one hour before the start of the Tracking Test. Entries will be refunded within ten (10) days of the Tracking Test to those on the Alternate List who did not participate in the Test.

As per Sec 6.6.2, one test track will be set aside for FKC Club workers.

Test sites shall not be used nor entrants train with the judge 14 days prior to the test.

**Draw for tracks on 4 Oct 2020 at 8.30AM** at the rendezvous site, Hugh John Flemming Forestry Centre, 1350 Regent St, Fredericton, NB E3C 2G6. **The first track will be ready at 8:45am.** Passing dogs will receive a rosette.

**Bitches in Season – Bitches in season will be allowed to participate but must run last and must be kept separated from all other dogs during the event.**

**Entry fees:** \$85.00 UTD

**Temporary Competition fee** -\$11.50 "A Temporary Competition fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form." (Section 4.1(k))

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

**Withdrawals and Entry Fee Refunds** – If an entry withdraws between the closing date and the test date and is replaced by an alternate, the entry fee will be refunded. Withdrawals must be made in writing and sent by e-mail to the Test Secretary who will confirm receipt. Entries will be refunded within ten days of the tracking test to those on the alternate list who did not participate in the test. Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Judge or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee.

***CKC Tracking Rules (14.7): It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the CKC shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue.***

Fredericton Kennel Club will use all reasonable care to ensure the safety of dogs and persons at the test. However, neither Fredericton Kennel Club nor any individual will accept the responsibility for loss or injury, however caused, to any dog, person or property. ALL dogs must be kept on leash and under control at all times.
