Entries may also be mailed or couriered to the Show Secretary (address inside front cover) or placed in any of the Northern Alberta Canine Association drop boxes listed in the NACA premium list ([www.canuckdogs.com](http://www.canuckdogs.com)) Please do not send entries by registered mail. To comply with CKC rules we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date. Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.

Cheques dated after close of entries will not be accepted. Returned cheques & declined credit cards will be assessed a \$25.00 service charge (Chapter 8.8, CKC Dog Show Rules).

**ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. If you send a cheque in US funds it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by our bank. Bank Drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds will be accepted.

**ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS:** All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). To obtain an ERN simply mail or fax a copy of the dog's registration certificate with a cheque, money order, or VISA/Mastercard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature) in the amount of \$61.40 payable to The Canadian Kennel Club. This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Please forward your request to:

**ALL EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:** It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Rule books are \$6.00 and can be obtained by contacting the Canadian Kennel Club as above.

**ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS**

**The following is provided for your information and payment of this fee is not required to enter this Specialty show**

**CKC Non-Member Participation Fee**

*(This only applies to dogs wholly owned by non members and is not applicable to CKC members or dogs co-owned with a CKC member, nor does it affect US exhibitors who must apply for an ERN number as noted above )*

A non-member resident in Canada is subject to the fee. Dogs co-owned with a CKC member are exempt.

There are 2 options for non-members: a) Join the CKC or b) Pay the Non-Member Participation Fee

The fee is a yearly charge based on the calendar year January 1<sup>st</sup> to December 31<sup>st</sup> in which the awards, legs, points, titles, etc. were achieved. It is not based on the number of dogs or titles or awards earned, and is assessed against the owner(s).

Non-members will receive a letter from CKC Head Office informing them that they have 30 days to join the Club or pay the Non-Member Participation Fee.

*\*Please note that the CKC Membership application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the website under CKC Services and then Forms On-Line. If submitting a Membership Application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that CKC is aware of the dogs involved.*

**CLASSIFICATION**

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided

BABY PUPPY (3-6 Months)	dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months on day of show
JUNIOR PUPPY	dogs between 6 months and under 9 months on day of show
SENIOR PUPPY	dogs between 9 months and under 12 months on day of show
12-18 MONTHS	dogs between 12 months and under 18 months on day of show
CANADIAN BRED	dogs born in Canada, Champions of any country are excluded
BRED BY EXHIBITOR	dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog in further awards
OPEN CLASS	for all dogs
VETERANS CLASS	for all dogs over 7 years of age on day of show. These dogs to compete for regular placements and the winner of this class will go on to compete for BEST OF BREED (they do not compete for Winners). Dogs in this class may be spayed or neutered
SPECIALS ONLY	dogs who are Canadian Champions. A CKC Registration Number or ERN number must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing
EXHIBITION ONLY	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in the premium list
EXHIBITION ONLY (3-6 MTHS)	puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 mths provided the owner(s) has entered a dog in a Regular Official Class. These Puppies may <u>not</u> participate in any regular, non-regular or unofficial classes or Parades
BRACE	for two Pugs, not necessarily of the same sex, handled by 1 person on one lead
SIRE & GET	for Stud Dog & 2 or more of his get. Stud may be neutered but must be in a regular class or Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a regular specialty class
DAM & PROGENY	For Dam and 2 or more of her get. Dam may be spayed but must be in a regular class or Exhibition Only. Get must be entered in a regular specialty class

As per CKC Rules, dogs entered in these Juvenile Sweepstakes must be entered in a regular specialty class. Classes will be divided males and females in the following classes:

Baby Puppy (3-6 months) Junior Puppy (6-9 months) Senior Puppy (9-12 months)

Pugs entered in these Veteran Sweepstakes must be 7 years or older on the day of the Sweepstakes. Dogs may be spayed or neutered and must be entered in a regular specialty class or for Exhibition Only. Classes will be divided males and females in the following age categories:

7-9 years 9-12 years 12+ years

The club will retain 25% of the entry fees for expenses. The remaining fees will be divided as follows in both Juvenile & Veteran Sweepstakes:

1<sup>st</sup> in each class – 30%

2<sup>nd</sup> in each class – 20%

3<sup>rd</sup> in each class – 10%
