Open	All dogs
Veteran	Dogs 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered into this class may be spayed of neutered.
Specials Only	Dogs which have recorded CKC registration number or ERN number and have attained the required points for Championship status.
Sexually Altered	For dogs over 6 months of age and have been spayed or neutered.
Non Regular Class	ses
Baby Puppy	Dogs 3 months of age but less than 6 months
Brace	For 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) and handled by 1 person

For 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily of the same sex) and handled by 1 person on 1 lead.

dog may be neutered and must be entered in one of the Regular classes or Exhibition

Dog Show Rule 5.1.6The officials of a show giving club will be held responsible for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators during the show. Any person acting in an objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendant.
