IOVICE 'A" & OPEN 'A' CLASSES

entries cannot be accepted into the 'A' Classes for two dogs owned by the same person. One dog nay be entered in the 'A' Class; the other dog must be entered in 'B' The exhibitor, or a member of is immediate family, must handle the dog in all exercises.

A dog which has earned its CD degree in the USA or BERMUDA is not eligible for Novice 'A' lass. A dog which has earned its CDX in the USA or BERMUDA is not eligible in the Open 'A' lass. Such dogs must be entered in the 'B' Class lefer to the CKC Rule book for clarification

JISTED DOGS

isted dogs may not be entered in Open or Utility. There is no limitation on the number of trials at which a dog maybe entered as a LISTED DOG except that a dog which has obtained 3 qualifying cores at obedience trials held under CKC rules may not continue to compete at licensed obedience rials held under the club's rules until the dog is registered individually or has obtained an ERN umber with the CKC or until its owner has provided evidence satisfactory to the CKC that are ligible for registration in the club's records.

for Exhibition Only runs (FEO runs)

Jnder the CKC's new "show modeling" program we have been granted permission to offer FEO runs at these trials. No CKC number is needed to participate in FEO runs. CKC will not be tracking these scores nor will they count towards a CKC title, however SDKC will be awarding ribbons to qualifying scores. Exhibitors may enter FEO runs as nany times as they like at a trial, at any level they like, provided that evidence that a dog will have success at that level. (Have been successful in classes to the level entered). It is recommended that the dog start at the Novice level in the trial and progress. FEO entries MUST be received by the secretary no later than 15 minutes prior to the class you want to run in. FEO runs will run at the end of the order within the correct class.

Dbedience Rules & Regulations

Chapter 18- Section: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, sub-office, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to ridignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC my infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Junior Handling Obedience Competition, December 17 & 18, 2011

Entry must be made on a special entry form as provided by the CKC and available from the Trial Secretary. Any dog entered in the trial may be used with the owner's or agent's permission. The funior Handler will wear the armband number assigned to the dog for the trial.

Junior Novice A for handlers 7 years up to & including 11 years of age who have not achieved 300 point in the same class competition.

Junior Novice B for handlers 7 years up to & including 11 years of age who have achieved 300 point in the same class competition

ntermediate A & B Classes:

Junior Open A for handlers 7 years up to & including 11 year of age who have not achieved 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD to compete in this class.

Junior Open B for handlers 7 years up to & including 11 year of age who have achieved 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD to compete in this class.

Senior Novice A for handlers 12 years up to but not including 18 years of age who have not achieved 300 point in the same class competition.

Senior Novice B for handlers 12 years up to but not including 18 years of age who have achieved 300 point in the same class competition

Senior Open A for handlers 12 years up to but not including 18 years of age who have not achieved 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD to compete in this class. Senior Open B for handlers 12 years up to but not including 18 years of age who have achieved 300 points in the Open class. The dog must have its CD to compete in this class.

Any ties in individual classes or for High in Trial, will be determined by the judge of the trial in accordance with rule 7.8 whereby the dog and handler will be re-tested individually.

Eligibility: To be eligible to compete in an obedience trial, the dog must be registered with the CKC, be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, or have a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked.

Bitches in Season are not permitted to compete. The judge of an obedience trial must remove from competition any bitch in season, or any bitch which appears so attractive to males as to be a disturbing element. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the Trial Secretary and a Veterinarian's certificate that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial the Trial siving slub will refund entry cornice aboves and litting feet.
