	 Identification cards and judging schedules will be sent as soon as possible after the entries close. Identification cards must be presented to the Trial Secretary upon arrival at the trial.

General Information	1. The Trial Secretary will be in full charge of the trial, which will be governed by CKC rules.				
	2. The Komoka Top Dogs Obedience Club will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume liability, in the event of accident or other misfortunes, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.

	If the dog you are entering has earned any CKC obedience title other than a PCD (e.g., a CD title or higher), the dog CANNOT be entered in any Rally "A" class.

	<i>Rally Novice A:</i> Handlers who have exhibited any dog to a CKC RA title CANNOT enter the Novice A class.

	<i>Rally Excellent A:</i> Handlers who have exhibited any dog to a CKC RM title CANNOT enter the Excellent A class.

Limited Entry	 OBEDIENCE: Entry in each obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 9 Pre-Novice, 8 Novice and Novice Intermediate, 7 Open, and 6 Utility dogs per hour. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging. RALLY: Entry in each rally obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at the rate of 15 dogs per hour less time for walk-throughs. A judge may not be assigned more than 7 hours of judging. Once a judge has reached his/her capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a reserve list. Exhibitors will be notified of their
	position on the reserve list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the reserve list up to 24 hours prior to the trial.
Mixed & Unrecognized Breeds	These trials are open to mixed and unrecognized breeds. In order to compete, mixed and unrecognized breed dogs must have a Canine Companion Number (CCN) from the Canadian Kennel Club and must have a CKC-approved microchip. Mixed-breed dogs must be spayed or neutered.
	Unrecognized breed dogs do not need to be spayed or neutered. <i>A dog</i> eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a listed dog.

Bitches in Season	Bitches in season are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entries close, a Veterinarian's Certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within ten (10) days of the trial, must reach the Trial Secretary on or before the day of the trial, prior to the judging of the class, and the club will refund the entry fees.
Moving Up	Section 6.9.1 A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC with an eligible number according to these rules and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with these rules may be moved to the next level of competition if the schedule permits. The transfer must be on the appropriate move-up form and submitted to the trial secretary by the owner or handler at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial.
	Section 6.9.3 The Trial Secretary shall amend the judge's book and the marked catalogue, which is to be sent to the CKC with the requests attached to the appropriate entry forms.
	Section 6.9.5 In order for a dog to be eligible to move up, the dog must be individually registered with the CKC, have a Performance Event Number (PEN), or an Event Registration Number (ERN) before entries close. The addition of a CKC number after close of entries does not make the dog eligible and will result in referral to the Discipline Committee.

Temporary Competition Number (TCN)	A Temporary Competition Number (TCN) allows dogs to temporarily participate in CKC events while they pursue permanent registration or an Event Registration Number (ERN). A TCN must be obtained before submitting an entry for an event. The same TCN must be used for all event entries for a dog until the dog is permanently registered or has an ERN.		
	A TCN cannot be used for dogs that require a PEN or a CCN number.		
	Note: There is no CKC fee to obtain a TCN. However, a TCN 'listing' fee is required each time a dog with only a TCN is entered in an event.		
Event Registration Number (ERN)	All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events, and do not have a CKC registra- tion number, will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).		
	The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event.		
Performance Event Number (PEN)	A Performance Event Number (PEN) allows a non-registrable dog of a CKC-RECOGNIZED BREED to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. To be eligible to receive a PEN, all of the following must be met:		
	 The dog must be of a breed recognized by the CKC (<i>not</i> on the CKC Miscellaneous Class List). The dog must not be eligible for CKC registration. The dog must be spayed or neutered. The dog must be properly identified with a CKC-approved microchip. 		
	A dog that is eligible for a PEN may not be entered as a 'listed' dog.		
Canine Companion Number (CCN)	A Canine Companion Number (CCN) allows UNRECOGNIZED BREEDS to compete in CKC performance events. To be eligible to receive a CCN, all the following must be met:		
Unrecognized Breeds	 The dog must be either an Unrecognized Breed. Unrecognized Breeds are not required to be spayed or neutered. The dog must be properly identified with a CKC microchip. 		
	A dog that is eligible for a CCN may not be entered as a 'listed' dog.		
	 All the above 'registration' numbers can be obtained: Online through CKC's Portal (Note: Individuals who have not yet used the online Portal will be required to create a Portal account before they can submit an application online); or By submitting a completed paper application by mail to CKC.

Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations	The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Section 17.7 of the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer or competitor at a rally Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.				
Rally Champion (RCH)	Section 16.1 The CKC will permit the use of the letters RCH to be used as a prefix of the name of any dog that has met the requirements for that title as hereinafter provided.				
	Section 16.2 A dog may begin earning points toward the RCH title as soon as the Rally Master (RM) title requirements have been completed.				
	Section 16.3 The RCH title will be awarded to dogs that have successfully earned a minimum of 100 points total from competing in both the Excellent B and Master classes in the same trial.				
	(a) 50 points must come from the Rally Excellent B class, including a minimum of five (5) scores of 95 or higher.

TOP DOGS TRAINING CLUB 20215 VANNECK ROAD, KOMOKA, ON NOL 1R0

From Toronto: Take 401 west to 402 exit 82 (cty road 14 Glendon Drive/ Komoka/ Mt Brydges). Turn left onto 14 at stop sign. Proceed north until you get to lights at 14 and Vanneck Road (Home Hardware is on right). Turn left onto Vanneck Road. As you start up first grade it is on the left at 20215 Vanneck Road.

From Windsor: Take 401 East, Exit 157 road 14 Iona Road, Melbourne, Iona. Turn left towards Melbourne on County Road 14. This will change to County Road 9. Follow through Melbourne, Second Road is Glendon Drive, Turn Right onto Glendon Drive and follow through Mount Brydges and Komoka until you get to lights at Glendon Drive and Vanneck Road, Turn left onto Vanneck Road. As you start up first hill it is on the left at 20215 Vanneck Road.

From North: Take Vanneck Road south to 20215 Vanneck Road. Facility is on your Right as you descend hill.

Exercise your dogs on the grass out front of first green building. Remember to clean up after your dogs.
