# JUDGES PROFILE



#### **Lee Anne Bateman**

Thank you for the opportunity to introduce myself to your Club Members and your Exhibitors.

My main breeds are Samoyed, Shih Tzu and Japanese Chin. I bred **Samoyed** under the *Snowghost* prefix for almost 30 years and have proudly showed many of them to #1 Samoyed in Canada. My **Shih Tzu** were also bred under the *Snowghost* prefix. I now breed **Japanese Chin**, with three partners, under the prefix *Xclusive Chins*.

Other breeds that I have lived with, owned and shown include Greyhound, Pomeranian, Siberian Husky, Basset Hounds and German Shepherd Dogs.

I have been judging dogs since 1999, and over the years, I have judged in every province across Canada, and have been privileged to have judged in Australia, Brazil, China, Colombia, Denmark, Korea and Singapore. I have had the honour of judging the Canadian Samoyed National Specialty, a Doberman Specialty in Brazil, and a Papillon/Phalene Specialty in Denmark as well as that country's prestigious invitational event, The Show of Winners.

By profession, I am an artist and writer. Judging dogs is a passion that I am always happy to indulge.



#### **Stephen Dainard**

Steve Dainard comes from a second generation dog show family. He began showing dogs in his early teens in the late seventies. His family started with Flat Coated Retrievers and later found their breed of choice to be English Springer Spaniels.

Steve and his wife Kelly, breed English Springer Spaniels under the 'KAS' prefix. He has shown Springers to the top winning male in Canadian history, as well number one all breed status. 'KAS' bred and showed the top winning female in the history of the breed as well, attaining number four all breed status. He also owned at the time of his showing, the top winning/producing sire in the history of the breed in the U.S.A.

Steve was an all breed handler specializing in Sporting and Herding dogs. He has also owned top winning Australian Shepherds.

Steve has served terms on the executive of the Canadian Dog Judges Association managing programs and education and Treasurer. He holds a Bachelor of Commerce degree.

He is licensed for the Sporting, Hounds, Working, Toy, Non-Sporting and Herding groups as well as Best in Show and has judged in Canada, the U.S.A., Mexico, Australia, and Colombia.

In his professional life he is a retired Manager with the Toronto Transit Commission in Administration and Financial Control and started his second career as a Mortgage Professional in 2014 with the professional designation of Accredited Mortgage Professional. In his personal life, Steve and his wife Kelly have three children and live in Niagara Falls, Ontario.



#### **Tempest A Deptuch**

I started exhibiting dogs as a junior in 1974, showing standard poodles, miniature poodles and afghan hounds for my parents. In 1975 I left home and lived/worked at a grooming shop and a kennel that bred poodles. From that point on I was hooked.

Over the past 40 years I have bred and shown standard poodles under the prefix Diplomat. As a breeder/owner/handler I have finished multiple American, Canadian Champions, as well as achieved many Best in Shows and Group wins on our homebred dogs. I have also competed in obedience trials putting CD's and CDX's on my poodles.

In 1987 I met my husband (Sandy) Russel Fletcher and for the past 25 years we have exhibited our own dogs as well as handled for many other breeders. We have also bred and exhibited pure bred Hereford cattle.

In 2008 I had the privilege of becoming a CKC conformation judge. I am currently licensed to judge all Non-Sporting, Sporting, Working and Hounds.

I am a contract computer instructor, specializing in electronic health records software. I work with First Nation Health Centre's in British Columbia, Alberta, Saskatchewan and Manitoba.



#### **Richard Felher**

During his working career Rick was Production Manager of the Regina Leader-Post, a large daily newspaper in Regina, Saskatchewan, Canada. Rick retired in 2009.

Rick and Carman purchased their first Doberman Pinscher in 1968 and started breeding under the SONDOU prefix in 1974. In the early eighties they added their first Bichon Frise. Rick has bred and owned many Champion Doberman Pinschers and Bichon Frises.

Rick now owns two Champion Australian Shepherds.

Rick first began to attend shows involved in obedience. With the purchase of his first Doberman bitch he soon moved to the Conformation side. He also handled dogs for friends and clients. Most of these dogs were German Shepherds, Boxers, Golden Retrievers and Flatcoat Retrievers. From there it seemed a natural progression to move into judging. Rick became an All-Breed judge in 2002.

Rick is a life member of the Canadian Kennel Club, an honorary life member of the Wascana Training Club (formerly the Wascana German Shepherd Dog Club), Past President and Executive member of the Bichon Frise Club of Canada, member of the Australian Shepherd Club of America, member of Prairie Australian Shepherd Enthusiasts and President of the Prairie Canine Academy.

I have been involved in our sport for 40 years, and have been breeding Shetland Sheepdogs under the Coastwynn (Perm Reg'd) prefix for that time. I have produced many BPIS, BPISS winners, Group winners and Specialty winners, including U.S. Specialty wins. I look forward to judging the CDKC Puppy Sweeps in 2016!



#### Sandra Orford

Sandra Orford Certified Master Groomer (CMG) has shown and groomed dogs for over 40 years. She started as a Professional Dog Handler's Assistant when she was 16 years old, and continued in the profession ever since. She then progressed to be a Professional Dog Handler where her specialty was showing and grooming coated breeder, such as Poodles, Bichons, Maltese, Shih Tzu, Pomeranians, Airedales, Lakelands, and American Cockers. Sandy has bred Airedales, Lakelands, Poms, and currently breeds Shih Tzu's with her eldest daughter. After working at several dog grooming salons, Sandy opened *Classy Clips* in 1984 and it is still one of Winnipeg's top salons. She is currently working towards her CKC judging license.

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all puppies six months and under eighteen months of age regardless of the place of birth. All puppies must be entered in a regular class in the show on the same day. Puppies will be judged in one of the following six classes (divided by sex)

Junior Puppy Male/Female – 6 months and under 9 months Senior Puppy Male/Female – 9 months and under 12 months

Yearling Male/Female – 12 months and under 18 months

Veterans Male/Female – 7-10 years

Veterans Male/Female – 10 years and over

For final judging, the first place puppy in each of the classes will be brought together for Best in Sweepstakes. A rosette will be awarded to Best In Sweepstakes.

Prizes: Best in Sweepstakes 5% of total entries

First in each class
Second in each class
Third in each class
Fourth in each class
Third in each class

The remaining 25% of the entry will be retained by Club to defray costs.

# JUNIOR HANDLING

Junior handling competition will be held August 27, 2016, during the lunch break.

Please note that effective January 1, 2016, in accordance with Section 3.4.1 of the Junior Handling Rules & Regulations, Junior Handlers will be required to apply to CKC Head Office for a Junior Handling Number.

**Section 3.4.1** "Junior Handler with the exception of PeeWees, must apply to CKC Head Office on the appropriate form for a Junior Handling Number within 30 days of competing in their first Junior Handling event. This Junior Handling Number will be used by the Junior Handler for the duration of their Junior Handling career. If a Junior Handling number is not obtained, Junior Handling points earned will not be tracked."

# GENERAL RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Copies of the Conformation Rule book are available from the CKC, 400 200 Ronson Dr., Etobicoke, ON M9W 5Z9

\_\_\_\_\_

- 1. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of the above shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
- 2. Any dog excused by the Show Superintendent or the Show Veterinarian for any reason shall not, after being excused, compete in any class for any award for the balance of the show.
- 3. The show committee will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, or assume any liability in the event of accident, or other misfortune, to either dogs, exhibitors or patrons.
- 4. A Judge or any person participating in any capacity at a Dog Show held under CKC Rules shall not be subjected to any indignity of any kind during the progress of the show and it shall be the duty and obligation of the Club holding the show to see that this rule is effectively carried out. The Show Superintendent shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of the rules, and the Discipline Committee shall have the power to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this rule has been violated.
- 5. Exhibitors are solely responsible for the conduct or actions of their animals while they are on the show grounds.
- 6. DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club will not be responsible for and is not obligated to provide any service for notifying owners or agents of breed or class judging. No ring shall be held up waiting for exhibitors or handlers. Exhibitors & Handlers with more than one dog shall have substitute handlers available so the judging will not be delayed. All start times are **MOUNTAIN DAYLIGHT TIME.**
- 7. The owner of a dog entered in these shows is entirely responsible for any error in entering his/her dog, regardless of how or by whom the entry was made.
- 8. A dog once disqualified for any reason at a championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown at a show held under these rules until the dog has been examined by an official committee appointed by the CKC and the committee finds the dog is free from the condition which prompted the disqualification. Application for reinstatement must be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 plus GST which shall be forfeited to the CKC if the examining committee is satisfied that the dog should remain disqualified. All awards earned at a dog show in violation of this rule shall be canceled by the CKC and the owner of the dog is subject to disciplinary action.
- 9. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for their dogs and for their equipment left at the Show Grounds.
- 10. For the benefit of the health of animals and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators we insist upon keeping our grounds and buildings as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Please exercise your dog BEFORE taking it to the Judging ring. Dogs are to be exercised in the designated areas only, not in the vicinity of the ring areas.
- 11. No entry fee will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and Act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club
- 12. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

#### CANADIAN KENNEL CLUB SCHEDULE OF CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows: (\*Includes the dog awarded Winners.)

Dogs Competing\* 1 2 3 to 5 6 to 9 10 to 12 13 or more

Points Allocated\* 0 1 2 3 4 5

To determine the number of championship points earned by a dog awarded Winners, total all the dogs in competition which the dog defeated, directly or indirectly, for the highest of the following official breed awards: Winners, Best of Winners, Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex and then consult the schedule set forth above. A dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for championship points. Further section 15.1.12 {C} has been added and states the dog must: "have earned at least one 2 point win either at the breed level or group level."

The system provides for additional points if a dog awarded winners also places in the Group as listed hereunder.

A class Dog awarded Best In Show at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In no case may a dog earn more than five (5) points at a single show. To earn a Canadian Championship, a dog must earn at least ten championship points under at least three different judges; and be individually registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, or have a CKC EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (ERN).

**SENIOR PUPPY-** 9 months & under 12 months on the day of the show

**12-18 MONTH CLASS** - for dogs 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show **CANADIAN BRED** - for dogs born in Canada, Champions in any country excluded.

**BRED BY EXHIBITOR** - shall be for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

**OPEN CLASS** - shall be for all Dogs.

**SPECIALS ONLY** – Dogs which have a recorded CKC registration, Event Registration Number (ERN) or Miscellaneous Certification Number (MCN) and have attained the required points for Championship status. All awards earned at the show will be cancelled if it is found that a dog is not registered or has not completed the requirements for a CKC Championship.

The following classes will be provided, divided by sex. Dogs entered in this class will compete for Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex and Best Puppy if eligible.

#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES

**VETERAN CLASS** - In this optional class for All Breed Shows, dogs must be 7 years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in this class may be spayed or neutered. The awards for this class are: Best Male Veteran and Best Female Veteran Best Veteran in Breed, Best Veteran in Group Best Veteran in Show A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Breed is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Group. A Veteran awarded Best Veteran in Group is not required to stay to compete for Best Veteran in Show.

**BABY PUPPY CLASS** – Dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show. The award for this class are: Best Baby Male and Best Baby Female Best Baby Puppy in Breed Best Baby Puppy in Group Best Baby Puppy in Show

**EXHIBITION ONLY** - Dogs entered in this class may not compete in the regular breed classes.

DOGS **MUST** BE ENTERED IN THE SHOW OR FOR EXHIBITION ONLY TO BE ON THE SHOW GROUNDS. THE PRECINCTS OF THIS SHOW SHALL BE A 25 FOOT PERIMETER AROUND THE RINGS.
