NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Below is a brief summary of NADAC rules. Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.

Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.

The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Cheques not honoured by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned cheques.

NON-JUMPING CLASSES – VETERAN OR DISABLED HANDLER

Handlers who are 60 years or older, or who have a disability that restricts mobility, may choose to enter the non-jumping classes as a Veteran Handler and receive 10% more standard course time. ***This option is for Veteran/Disabled handlers in non-jumping classes only.***

The Veteran/Disabled Handler division is designed for handlers who, due to age or impairment, are mobility limited and need extra time to guide their canine partners through an agility course.

When entering as a Veteran/Disabled Handler, you must enter all dogs in all classes for the entire trial in this Division and must jump four 4 inches lower than your Standard Division jump height requires. In the non-jumping classes, dogs will be scored and placed with their Standard Division jump height.

CHECKING YOUR RESULTS

IMPORTANT. Please check your dog's NADAC registration number on your trial confirmation as soon as you receive it; also please check the copy of the results posted at the trial. You should report any errors to the Trial Secretary immediately.

NADAC records trial results as they are submitted by the host clubs/groups. The individual trial results submitted by the club are uploaded to the www.NADACForum.com list within two weeks after the NADAC office receives them from the club. **Please accept the responsibility to review those results and check that your registration number and qualifying points, as reported by the club, are correct.** You can join the Forum by going to www.NADACForum.com and submitting your request. **If you find an error the reporting of a dog's qualifying points or registration number, please contact the host club. The host club is responsible for correcting any errors and informing NADAC.**

Levels: Points earned at a higher level of a class, prior to the completion of the lower level title, will not be recorded by NADAC for future use. If a dog earns points in a level of a class that they are not eligible to title in, those points will not be added to the dog's records.

PROFICIENT/SKILLED CATEGORIES

Each class will be split into two categories – Proficient and Skilled. **A dog may only be entered in ONE category per weekend. The dog must be entered in all Proficient or all Skilled category for all classes entered on a particular weekend.**

In the Proficient Category, dogs must jump their measured jump height per the current jump height table. With the exception of Regular Agility, runs in Proficient must be clean with no course faults or time faults, in order to qualify. In the Regular Agility class, the run may receive a 5-point qualifier if the total number of faults (time or course faults), are 5 or fewer.

In the Skilled Category, exhibitors **MUST** jump their dog one jump height lower than they are required to jump in the Standard Division in the Proficient Category. With the exception of Regular Agility, runs in Skilled must be clean with no course faults or time faults, in order to qualify. In the Regular Agility class, the run may receive a 5-point qualifier if the total number of faults (time or course faults), are 5 or fewer.

All qualifying points earned in either the Proficient Category or the Skilled Category will be combined and credited toward titles and special awards.

Performance Agility Club of Edmonton LIMITED ENTRY RULES

In an effort to promote fairness, P.A.C.E. will ensure the following:

- **Only mailed or couriered entries will be accepted.** Please ensure couriered entries do not require a signature. Please complete a separate Trial Entry Form for each dog entered.
- **Only envelopes containing entries from a single household will be accepted.**
- **Entries are to be signed by the owner of the dog(s).**
- **Entries will be accepted based on the postmark date.** In the event that the number of entries received with the same postmark date exceed the maximum number of runs per day, P.A.C.E. will conduct a random draw from all entries received with the same postmark date to the maximum number of runs per day being accepted.

ENTRIES POSTMARKED BEFORE MAY 17, 2013 AND AFTER JUNE 17, 2013
WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Exhibitors that are not successful in gaining entry into the trial will be notified by phone or e-mail as soon as the trial has filled.

Confirmations and any other information regarding the trial will be mailed or e-mailed to the owner of the dog(s) no later than one (1) week after the closing date. If you do not receive your confirmation by June 24, 2013, please notify the Trial Secretary.

RIBBONS AND ROSETTES

Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying rounds and for 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th in each jump height category (including 20+) for each level. For the *Chances* class, ribbons will be awarded for each Pass. ***In accordance with NADAC rules, no placements or placement ribbons will be given in the Chances class.***

P.A.C.E. will be offering a Q/NQ prize draw for each day of the trial.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From North (outside Edmonton area):

South on Highway 28 to Yellowhead Trail. East on Yellowhead Trail to Highway 216. South on Highway 216 to Sherwood Park / Wye Road exit. East on Wye Road to Ordze Road (which is first set of lights). North on Ordze Road to Fir Street (at t-intersection). West on Fir Street and follow road around to a large sign – “Outlaws Rugby Park”. Turn right at the sign and go left into first entrance to facility parking lot.

From North or West (within Edmonton area):

East on Yellowhead Trail to Highway 216. South on Highway 216 to Sherwood Park / Wye Road exit. East on Wye Road to Ordze Road (which is first set of lights). North on Ordze Road to Fir Street (at t-intersection). West on Fir Street and follow road around to a large sign – “Outlaws Rugby Park”. Turn right at the sign and go left into first entrance to facility parking lot.

From South (outside Edmonton area):

North on Queen Elizabeth Highway (Highway 2) to Anthony Henday. East on Anthony Henday to Highway 216. North on Highway 216 to Sherwood Park / Wye Road exit. East on Wye Road to Ordze Road (which is first set of lights). North on Ordze Road to Fir Street (at t-intersection). West on Fir Street and follow road around to a large sign – “Outlaws Rugby Park”. Turn right at the sign and go left into first entrance to facility parking lot.

From South or West (within Edmonton area):

East on Whitemud Drive to Highway 216. North on Highway 216 to Sherwood Park / Wye Road exit. East on Wye Road to Ordze Road (which is first set of lights). North on Ordze Road to Fir Street (at t-intersection). West on Fir Street and follow road around to a large sign – “Outlaws Rugby Park”. Turn right at the sign and go left into first entrance to facility parking lot.

From East (outside Edmonton area):

West on Yellowhead Trail to Highway 216. South on Highway 216 to Sherwood Park / Wye Road exit. East on Wye Road to Ordze Road (which is first set of lights). CAMPING

On-site camping with no hook-ups is available at the trial site and is limited to 10 spots. ***If you are interested in camping at the site, please contact the Trial Secretary. On-site camping spots will be assigned on a first-come-first-serve basis.***

Camping facilities are also available at the Rainbow Valley Campground, 13204 – 45 Avenue, Edmonton. Toll Free: 1-888-434-3991. Rainbow Valley Campground is located in south Edmonton, next to Whitemud Drive and is approximately a half-hour drive from the trial site.

P.A.C.E. TRIAL RULES

A dog that has entered this trial and subsequently earns a title at another trial shall be permitted to move up to the next level providing the Trial Secretary is notified by phone or e-mail at least one (1) week prior to the date of the trial.

When not competing, dogs must be penned, crated, or leashed. Dogs must be under control at all times when entering and exiting the trial ring and warm-up areas. Exhibitors are required to supply their own chairs, crates/pens for benching.

Exhibitors must keep benching and exercise areas clean. ***Please clean up after yourselves and your dogs.*** Anyone who does not do this may be excused from the trial by the Trial Committee.

Any dog demonstrating aggression towards a person or dog, whether inside the ring or outside the ring, will be excused from the trial. Aggression does not mean there must be actual physical contact. ***Please note that there will be no refund of entry fees for any dog or handler excused from the trial for any reason.***

An administration fee of \$2.50 per run per dog will be charged for dogs that are pulled for any reason after the trial closing date. Refunds will not be given for dogs that are pulled on the actual days of the trial. Coupons issued by P.A.C.E. are not redeemable for cash. Coupons submitted with trial entries will not be returned unless P.A.C.E. has refused an exhibitor's entry.

It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises. P.A.C.E. will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result was by accident or any other cause. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee be asked to leave the show site.

In accordance with P.A.C.E. policy, a dog or handler that has been suspended for any reason by any organization that sanctions competitive dog events of any kind will not be allowed entry into the trial.

Release and Indemnity

The “Releasor” is:

The Handler, being the person exhibiting the dog at the event, if other than the owner of the dog.

The “Releasees” are:

The Sanctioning Body, being the following and including it’s officers, directors, employees and agents:

North American Dog Agility Council (NADAC); and

The Club, being the Performance Agility Club of Edmonton (PACE) and including it’s officers, directors, employees and agents; and

The Premises Owner/Operator, being the owner/operator of the facility at which the Event is being held, which is more particularly described as;

Strathcona Druids Rugby Football Club, 524a Highway 14X, Sherwood Park, Alberta

Definitions:

“**Aggressive Behaviour**” means that the Dog has attacked, or threatened to attack.

“**Dog**” means any dog, or dogs, at the event with the Releasor whether competing or not.

“**Event**” means but is not limited to, agility trials, demonstrations, instructional classes, scheduled practices and seminars.

“**Hazards**” mean and include, but are not limited to, the condition of the grounds, floors, stairways, halls, lighting, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people.

“**Loss**” means any damage or injury (including death).

“**Rules**” means the Official Rules and Regulations of the Sanctioning Body, the Club and the Premises Owner/Operator, and the additional rules appearing in the Agility Trial schedule for the Event and/or posted at the Event, if any.

Certification

I certify that:

1. I am the Owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized Handler of the Dog;
2. I have read, understand and will abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Releasees in effect at the time of the Event;
3. The Dog does not have a history of Aggressive Behaviour and is not a danger to persons or other dogs;
4. The Dog’s vaccinations are current and in accordance with the requirements of the Sanctioning Body and the Club.

Acknowledgment

I acknowledge that:

- 1. Attendance at or participation in the Event will expose the Dog and myself to a number of Hazards which could result in Loss to the Dog or to myself;
- 2. There is a risk of Loss to the Dog caused by its attendance at or participation in the Event, including but not limited to, Loss caused by the premises, equipment, other dogs and other people;
- 3. There is a risk of Loss to myself and other persons in attendance with me caused by my attendance at or participation in the Event, including but not limited to, Loss caused by the premises, equipment, other dogs and other people.

Release

In consideration of the acceptance of my application for attendance at or participation in the Event, I hereby:

- 1. Release the Releasees from all nature of liability, including liability for negligence, whether gross negligence or otherwise, arising from my attendance at or participation in the Event, and freely assume all risks, including the risk of injury to my person, my property or the Dog, which may occur because of my attendance at or participation in the Event;
- 2. Release the Releasees from all liability of any nature, including liability for negligence, whether gross negligence or otherwise, for all loss, in relation to claims against me or through me, or against or through any member of my family or any other person accompanying me or attending as my guest or in my place, or arising as a result of any action or inaction by me or by the Dog, or its Owner or Handler, or by any member of my family or any other person accompanying me or attending the Event as my guest or otherwise. I expressly assume all responsibility and liability for all such claims.

Indemnity
