Acceptance date - 8:00 AM, Thursday, Sept 6, 2012. As per the rules (6.5.1) any entries received prior to this date and time will be returned.

Closing date – 5:00 PM, Tuesday, Sept 25, 2012. Entries must be delivered to the Test Secretary by the closing date. The club cannot accept entries delivered after this date and time.

CKC rules (6.6.1): The trial secretary will notify the entrant on the day the entry is received. Confirmation of entries and position on the exhibitor or alternate list will be provided on the closing date. When the advertised limit has been reached, all remaining entries shall be assigned a position on an alternate list in the order received. At the time of the draw, entries from the alternate list may fill any absentee spaces. An absentee is defined as an entrant who is not present at the time of the draw. The person making the entry shall be notified of his position on the alternate list.

Entries must be mailed or sent by courier to the postal address of the Test Secretary. Faxed, e-mailed or hand delivered entries are not acceptable. Each entry must be mailed in a separate envelope. Entries will close automatically when the advertised limit has been reached, even if the official closing date for entries has not arrived. All entries must be made on an official CKC entry form. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, regardless of who completes the entry form. *Incomplete or improper entry forms will not be accepted.* To prevent delays in delivery, entrants using couriers are encouraged to mark their envelope with the instructions “no signature required” in case no one is at home to sign for the delivery.

Prizes: Passing dogs will receive a rosette and a toy.
Entry fees: UTD: \$75 / UTDX: \$100
Listing fee: \$9.49 (\$8.40 + HST) "A listing fee as established by the Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form."

Fees are payable to: River Valley Obedience and Field Trial Club. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted. NSF Cheques will be considered non-payment of entry fees. Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Bank drafts or INTERNATIONAL money orders payable in Canadian funds are acceptable. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated.

Withdrawals and Entry Fee Refunds - If an entry withdraws between the closing date and the test date and is replaced by an alternate, the entry fee will be refunded. Withdrawals must be made in writing to the Test Secretary.

CKC rules (6.6.1): Entries will be refunded within 10 days of the tracking test to those on the alternate list who did not participate in the test. If an entrant pulls out of the test and is filled by an alternate who accepts the position, then the alternate is now responsible for the entry fee paid to the club. The original participant will be refunded the entry fee in full. If the alternate pulls out after accepting the position, after the closing date, and there are no additional alternates, then this alternate forfeits the entry fee to the club.

Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee.

Bitches in Season - Bitches in season will be allowed to participate but must run last and must be kept separated from all other dogs during the event. You must advise the Test Secretary before the draw if your bitch is in season.

NEW An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled. These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

RVO will use all reasonable care to ensure the safety of dogs and persons at the test. However neither RVO nor any individual will accept the responsibility for loss or injury, however caused, to any dog, person or property.

CKC Tracking Rules (13.7): It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred. A copy of this regulation shall be prominently placed in every premium list and catalogue
