Rally Obedience Rules & Regulations Chapter 20.7:

It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Rally Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Bitches in Season Rules and Regulations Chapter 6.5:

Bitches in Season are not permitted to compete. The judge of a Rally obedience trial must remove from competition any bitch in season, or any bitch which appears so attractive to males as to be a disturbing element. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the Trial Secretary and a Veterinarian's certificate that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, the Trial giving club will refund entry, service charges and listing fees.

Entry in each obedience trial will be limited to the capacity of the judge to judge at an hourly rate of 9 Pre-Novice dogs, 8 Novice dogs, 8 Novice Intermediate dogs, 7 Open dogs, and 6 Utility dogs. The judge will be limited to 7 hours total judging time for the day of the trial and 3.5 hours per individual trial. Once the judge has reached his capacity, entries for that trial will be closed even if the closing date has not been reached. In the case of the entry limit having been reached, remaining entries will be assigned a position (by class) on a waiting list. Exhibitors will be notified of their position on the waiting list. If the entry of a bitch in season is pulled after entries are closed, it may be substituted with one from the waiting list up to and including the day of the trial. If the entry of another dog is pulled prior to the trial, it may be substituted with one from the waiting list up to 24 hours prior to the trial.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Section 19.7 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Bitches in Season Rules and Regulations Chapter 6.5:

Bitches in Season are not permitted to compete. The judge of a Rally obedience trial must remove from competition any bitch in season, or any bitch which appears so attractive to males as to be a disturbing element. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the

Trial Secretary and a Veterinarian's certificate that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial, the Trial giving club will refund entry, service charges and listing fees.

Directions:

From HWY 401, take exit for HWY 416, towards Ottawa. Follow HWY 416 until its conclusion, taking the left hand lanes at the split, following signs for HWY 417 Kanata and Pembroke. Follow HWY 417, which will eventually become HWY 17. Travel on for approximately 20 minutes. Take exit for Kinburn Side Road. Follow until the town of Kinburn is reached. Take the right hand turn at the main crossroads in Kinburn, (Esso Station on the right), onto Logger's Way. The 'Training Hall' is located in the business area on the right, approximately 200m from the gas station.

Notes For Exhibitors:

- ***The second trial will follow the first trial. The judge will break at their discretion.**
- ****There are no vendors at the event venue. Please bring your own lunch, if required. The town of Arnprior is 10 minutes to the west of Kinburn for the nearest restaurants.**
- *****Crating-indoor crating is very limited at this venue and as a result exhibitors should plan to crate their dogs from their vehicles. Indoor crating will be prioritised for exhibitors with disability/special needs considerations. Once entry has been confirmed, those wishing to secure an indoor crating spot should contact the Trial Secretary, Lynn Benson by email at lynnbenson931@gmail.com After entries close, spots will be assigned by special needs requests and then on a limited first come-first served basis, if spots are still available.**
