## Handler's Briefing – Chase Ability

**Hello Exhibitors! Please read the following carefully.**

You have signed a club waiver with your online entry. Anyone accompanying you must also complete a waiver. They can print and sign one (attached to the email) and hand it in at check-in **OR** email a completed waiver to the Test Secretary at [carriejdonovan@hotmail.com](mailto:carriejdonovan@hotmail.com) BEFORE the tests. **You are responsible for keeping track of your dog's Qs and knowing if they have achieved any titles.** The title requirements and additional information are available via the Chase Ability Program (CAP) Rules & Regulations from the CKC website.

### Event Overview

- 🐾 To get a qualifying run in Chase Ability, the dog must complete a 150, 300, or 600 yard course (depending on the size, age and/or type of dog) with enthusiasm and without interruption. To earn their Chase Ability (CA) title, they must achieve 3 Qualifying runs under **TWO** different judges.
- 🐾 Please heed the instructions and guidance of The Paddock Master, Starter, and other officials. The Starter is in control of the course and will instruct you on where to stand and when to release your dog. Stay out of your dog's way as they finish their run. **\*DO NOT\*** try to grab your dog while they're still running or the line is moving. Grabbing your dog while they and/or the line is still in motion can easily result in injury to one or both of you. When the Lure Operator stops the bags, the Starter will tell you to retrieve your dog. Let your dog grab/bite the bag if they want, it's their reward!

### On arrival for your scheduled time slot:

1. Please do not arrive more than 30 minutes before your assigned time block. When you arrive, go to the main check-in station for the lameness and in-season inspection. You will need to swab your bitch with a tissue for in season check (regardless if they are intact or spayed). Double check the running order to see if there have been any changes. **\*You must be present for inspection/roll call or you will forfeit your runs.\***
2. Two to three dogs before your turn, warm your dog up and be prepared to head to the start line waiting area. The Paddock Master will let you know when you may cross the pylons and proceed to the start line.
3. Once your dog runs and is caught and leashed, clear the course area, and cool down your dog.
4. There are 2 tests each day this weekend so each dog will run twice UNLESS they have a T1 or T2 behind their name in the Running Order. This means they only run *\*once\** in the test indicated by the number.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

- 🐾 Remember to warm up and cool down your dogs and provide them with plenty of water.
- 🐾 Check your dog's feet/pads/toes after they run.
- 🐾 **Be aware of the line/string at all times.** At best, you will get some bad line burn from a moving line, at worst it can cut quite deeply. The Starter will direct you in such a way as to help you and your dog avoid stepping on the line when it is moving.

## OTHER EVENT INFORMATION

You will need to crate your dog in/by your car. There will be no shade provided so please keep your dog cool by keeping windows open, using shade cloths, and providing fresh water (please bring your own).

There will be a **Title Log** sheet at the main check-in table to record any titles your dogs have earned that weekend if you would like us to include them in our event wrap-up on the ECSA Facebook page. You are responsible for keeping track of your dog's Qs and titles.

Please ask for help when getting your title and Q ribbons from the check-in table. There are different rosettes for each Chase Ability title and club members will help you get the right one.

There will be a "photo booth" set up with title/event boards. Feel free to take some pictures of your dog with their ribbons.

**Important Property Notes:** This is a PRIVATE residence and we are grateful for the use of this location. Parking, potty, and exercise areas will all be designated. Please respect instructions, pick up after your dog, and always maintain control of your dog. Flexi-leads are not allowed on the field. Please bring everything you will need to keep your dog safe and comfortable for the weather. There is a risk of injury for all active sports; you can reduce this risk by warming up and cooling down your dog, only running your dog when you feel the field and weather are appropriate, and staying aware of your environment and any safety hazards. A \$10 fine, payable to ECSA, will be levied for any dog loose on the field from the time of inspection until the completion of all events for the day. A \$10 fine, payable to ECSA, will be levied for any exhibitor not picking up after their dog. Events run rain or shine. Dogs may run "naked" or wear a flat, snug fitting catch collar (no martingale or slip collars, please) as long as there is nothing hanging from it (i.e. no tags) that can become entangled in the line. You may walk your dog to the line in a martingale or slip collar but please remove it prior to releasing them.
