A separate entry form for EACH DOG in EACH STAKE is required.

All entries must be accompanied by the full entry fee (and listing fee of \$8.50 if applicable). A listing fee per dog event is payable unless the dog's entry carries a CKC individual registration number or ERN number.

ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Please note that fees are due and payable in CANADIAN DOLLARS. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. If you send a cheque in US funds, it must be made out for the full amount of the entry and no exchange will be refunded to the exhibitor. Please do not mark cheques 'PAYABLE In CANADIAN FUNDS or AT PAR'.

They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process we urge that you purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds. Your understanding and cooperation is greatly appreciated.

Canadian Kennel Club Non Member Participation Fee as of January 1, 2011

An annual fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have the option to become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in all awards and titles being cancelled.

All Premium Lists will carry a note stating the non-member participation fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-members and is not applicable to CKC members.

ENTRY INFORMATION

No entry will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are completed in full. Incomplete entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the Entry Fee. Telephone entries cannot be accepted. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering dogs regardless of how or by whom the entries are made. The committee reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC rules. Any NSF cheques will be subject to a \$20.00 service charge. Entry fee plus service charge for NSF cheques must be paid prior to the test.

TEST DETAILS

- Running order will be determined by a draw. Multiple entries by the same OWNER/HANDLER will be automatically separated unless otherwise requested.
- WC followed by WCI followed by WCX on land and then on water
- Ducks will be used in all stakes, land and water
- Meet at 8:30 am on the test grounds, dogs to line at 9:00 am
- Check in with marshal at the test site
- All handlers must wear dark or camouflage clothing
- Standard CKC rosettes to all dogs qualifying in each stake

- Bitches in season shall not be eligible for entry and shall not be allowed on the test grounds. Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of estrus shall be refunded in FULL. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Test Secretary BEFORE the start of the test to qualify for a refund.

Excerpt from CKC Rules and Regulations for Working Certificate Tests (section 14.7)

It shall be the duty and obligation of the test giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participants at an event held under these rules, is NOT subject to indignities of any kind. The Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

GROUNDS

Travel east from Winnipeg on Hwy #15 to Anola. Turn right on Hwy #12 and travel about 4.3 km south to Win-Toba Kennels (on east side of Hwy#12).
