Each dog may only be entered in ONE of the WC, WCI or WCX test. A dog must have a WC title before entering the WCI test, and have achieved a WCI title before running the WCX test. Bitches in season MAY NOT compete in the tests.

Entry and listing fees paid for any dog withdrawn because of a bitch being in season, injury, illness or death shall be refunded in full. An appropriate veterinary certificate must be given to the Test Secretary BEFORE the start of the tests to qualify for a refund.

Running order will be pre-selected by a draw. A running list will be available at the tests.

Qualifying Tollers are eligible for the Fair Dinkum award and the Shilo Trophy. Entry Fee: \$5.00 per dog (please bring fees to event)

Age Range: 7 years or older

Requirements: Dog must have at least 1 CKC or equivalent field title

Test: Each dog will run 2 single land marks. Ducks will be used

Running Order: Youngest veteran to Oldest veteran

**Entry is Limited with preference given to the oldest dogs.**

Every dog is a winner and will receive an award! Entry forms can be found on page 6 of this premium list.

Ducks will be used for both the land and water stakes.

All Bird Boys, Judges and Competitors should wear dark or camouflage clothing. Handlers shall not wear white or light coloured at any time, but handlers may wear handling jackets for the blinds in WCX.

All qualifying dogs will be awarded a CKC rosette.

Electric collars (either dummy or alive), prong or pinch type collars shall not be worn by any dog on the grounds, at any time during the event.

There will a designated area (land and water) available for relaxation and training on the test grounds.

The Test Committee is pleased to offer coffee and tea in the morning. A homemade lunch will be available on site.

The Official Specialty Videographer will be ShowDog VideoPros. No other Official Videos may be taken for resale on the Specialty Premises. Only video for personal use may be taken.

The Specialty Photographer is Walt Norris Photography. No other Official Photographs may be taken for resale on the Specialty Premises. Only pictures for personal use may be taken.

***The Shilo Perpetual Trophy***  
***To be awarded at the 2013 Canadian National Speciality***

The SHILO Perpetual Trophy is to be awarded to the oldest Toller, aged seven or more on the day of the Speciality Working Certificate Tests that successfully passes a WC or WCI test.

Eligible Tollers must be trained and handled by their owner and must not have entered any field or hunt test title by any other organization that required double marked retrievers.

While owner/handlers may seek training instruction from others, eligible Tollers must not have been trained by anyone other than the owner/handler as this Trophy is meant to reward a senior Toller and his/her companion.

Applicants will indicate on the Field Premium List if they are eligible for the SHILO Perpetual Trophy and will fill out and sign the accompanying form which is to be sent in with the Entry Forms.
