Day of Event Entries are available only if scheduling permits and must be submitted to the show secretary and paid in cash ONE hour before the start of the trial.



GENERAL RULES

- Entries must be received by the Show Secretary prior to closing date. Withdrawal of entries prior to closing date may be made by telephone but must be followed up in writing to reach the Show Secretary by closing day (mail, email, fax).
- 2. No entry form will be accepted unless all particulars called for on the entry form are complete. Incomplete or unreadable entries will be returned. No entry will be accepted unless accompanied by the entry fees. Telephone entries will not be accepted by the show secretary.
- 3. Exhibitors must abide by errors made in entering their dogs regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. Changes after the closing date are prohibited.
- 4. COKC reserves the right to refuse any entry subject to CKC Rules.
- 5. The Show Superintendent will have full charge of the show. CKC Dog Show rules will be followed.
- 6. All dogs must be exercised in the exercise areas provided. Please clean up after your dog. Exhibitors must also clean up outside the buildings.
- 7. No dog will be allowed in the show building unless entered in the show or exhibition only.
- 8. Any person found with dogs in the show building that are NOT entered as exhibition only will be subject to a fee of \$20 per dog per day. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 9. No refund of entry fees will be made if it is impossible to open or complete the shows because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the COKC.

- 10. COKC will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors but will not be responsible for or assume any liability in the event of accident or other mishap caused to either dogs, exhibitors, or spectators whether the results of accident or otherwise. A dog should never be touched without the permission of the owner or handler.
- 11. There is no night watchman. Exhibitors leaving dogs in the building do so at their own risk and <u>must</u> leave contact information prominently displayed on or near their crate(s).
- 12. Dogs should be in the show building 1 hour prior to judging. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside. Handlers are requested to report any absentees and have assistants at ringside if they are engaged elsewhere.
- 13. Any person using the obedience/rally ring without the express permission of the show superintendent will be subject to disciplinary action.
- 14. Live streaming of the event may take place. The CKOC takes no responsibility or liability regarding live streaming of these events and their distribution. All participants are to be aware that this may take place.

Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they must be payable in U.S. funds for the full amount of the entry. **DISCOUNTED CHEQUES OR MONEY ORDERS WILL NOT BE HONOURED.** Please do not send personal cheques marked "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At par". Your cooperation is appreciated.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

APPLIES ONLY TO DOGS WHOLLY OWNED BY A NON CKC MEMBER AND ARE NOT APPLICABLE TO CKC MEMBERS

An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

<u>ERN</u>

Effective Jan. 1, 1992, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). This ERN number does not register a dog with the CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act, but rather enables a foreign born and foreign owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Canadian born dogs of breeds that are registerable by a breed association in Canada recognized by Agriculture Canada may obtain an Event Registration Number (ERN)Each dog must have its own number.

To obtain an ERN number, simply do the following:

Send a photocopy of the dog's registration certificate reflecting current ownership, for example: AKC Registration Certificate, with a written request for an ERN number.

The ERN number must be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Dogs may be entered as "listed", however, failure to apply for an ERN number within 30 days of the first event will result in the cancellations of any wins, awards, and scores.

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS

SECTION 1 – A dog awarded *Winners* at a championship show held under the Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0 to 5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be accredited to a dog awarded Winners shall be provided hereunder. **SECTION 2** – The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded. *Winners* shall be as follows.

DOGS COMPETING	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 or more
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused, or ordered from the ring by the judge **shall not** be included in the calculation for championship points. The new system provides for additional points if a dog awarded *Winners* also places in the **GROUP** as listed below.

A class dog awarded **Best in Show** at an all-breed championship show will be credited with five (5) points inclusive of any points earned at the breed or group level. In **no** case may a dog earn more than **five (5)** points at a **single show.** In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship Certificate, the dog must: (a) earn at least 10 championship points under at least 3 different judges; and (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number. (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level. (15.1.13).

<u>Best Puppy in Breed</u> – Where a dog awarded Best of Breed is not a puppy, those puppies which have not been defeated either directly or indirectly by another puppy in the breed will compete for this award. Judging follows the award for Best of Breed. A puppy awarded Best Puppy in Breed, is <u>NOT</u> required to stay to compete for Best Puppy in Group (15.3.1f)

Grand Champion (GCh) The title of Grand Champion may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation championship. Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the conformation championship and do not include the points earned in attaining the conformation championship. To be awarded a Grand Champion title, a dog must attain a minimum of 20 points, which must include a minimum of two (2) wins of at least two (2) points each. Points may be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

(a) Grand Champion Point System Points towards the Grand Champion title are attained at breed level and are awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, Select Dog and Select Bitch. Points are calculated based on the number of animals competing at the breed level for the Best of Breed winner and the number of similar-sex dogs competing for the other three (Best of Opposite, Select Dog, Select Bitch). The following schedule shall be employed in the determination of points awarded at breed level for all levels of GCh:

(c) In order to obtain a Grand Champion title, a dog must obtain at least two (2) points after 12 months of age. In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition, a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall not be included in the calculation for Grand Champion points. (d) Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Bronze (GChB) The title of Grand Champion Bronze may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Championship, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Bronze title, a dog must attain a minimum of 50 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward. (c) Points accumulated prior to July 1, 2021 may be used to attain the GChB title, however, a minimum of five (5) points must be earned after July 1, 2021.

Grand Champion Silver (GChS) The title of Grand Champion Silver may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Bronze is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Bronze is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Bronze. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Gold: (GChG) The title of Grand Champion Gold may only be earned after the completion of the CKC conformation title Grand Champion Silver is attained. (a) Points for this title are only accumulated after the completion of the Grand Champion Silver is attained, and do not include the points earned in attaining the Grand Championship Silver. (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Gold title, a dog must attain a minimum of 200 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each. Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Grand Champion Excellent (GChEx) The title of Grand Champion Excellent may be granted only after the completion of the CKC Grand Championship Silver Title. Exhibitors will be required to submit to Shows & Trials the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet documenting the additional requirements. The Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet Form is located on the CKC website. To earn the title a dog must have earned the following during their career as a Special: (a) one (1) Best in Show or a Best of Breed at a breed national specialty (where a minimum of 10 dogs have competed) (b) three (3) Group 1st, or three (3) breed specialty best of breed wins. (c) a CKC performance title from any CKC Event. Titles excluded are: CGN, Herding Novice Tested Certificate, all Instinct titles from all events, as well as all Sprinter titles and all Chase Ability Program titles, (b) To be awarded a Grand Champion Silver title, a dog must attain a minimum of 100 points, which must include a minimum of two wins of at least two (2) points each.

Points must be gained at breed, group or Best in Show/ Specialty level. Only the highest points earned at a single show are carried forward.

Best in Show, Best of Breed at a National Specialty, 3 Group wins, or 3 Specialty Best of Breed wins, must be attained after the completion of a regular championship. The performance title may be attained at any time in the dog's career. NOTE: 1. Exhibitors are required to complete the Grand Champion Excellent Record Sheet form located on the CKC website and forward to CKC upon completion of requirements above.

MOVING CLASS DOGS TO SPECIALS

A dog which is individually registered in the records of the CKC or has an ERN number at the time of closing of entries, and has completed the requirements for a championship in accordance with the provisions of **Chapter 20** of the **Dog Show Rules**, after the closing date and time for entries for a show, but whose championship is yet unconfirmed by the CKC may be transferred from one of the regular classes to "Specials Only" providing the transfer is submitted to the show secretary in writing **at least one (1) hour prior to the beginning of the judging of the group,** by the owner or handler. **Effective January 1994:** If your dog has the required number of Championship points and you do not have your registration number before entries close, and you receive your registration **BEFORE** the date of the show, you may move your dog up to Specials if you provide the Show Secretary with the registration number and the dog has been entered in the classes as a **TCN** dog. TCN fees, however, **WILL NOT be refunded.**

An error in the class, date of birth or sex may be amended on the entry form up to one hour before the start of the show. Rule (8.2.5)
