Cal K-9 Obedience Club of Calgary/Chinook Schutzhund Club COVID-19 Requirements

General Required Practices

1. Cal K-9 members, judges and exhibitors are required to follow Federal, Provincial, Local and facility guidelines as presented below. Any changes in guidelines between the posting of this Premium List and the starting of each trial will also be followed.
2. Social distancing must be practiced. Maintain a distance of 6 feet / 2 Metres or more unless individuals are part of a family unit.
3. Masks are recommended unless running a dog in a class. Masks are to be supplied by exhibitors for their personal use.
4. Exhibitors may consider wearing disposable or washable gloves unless running a dog in a class.
5. There will be plenty of hand sanitizer around the facility for personal use and wash stations will be provided in the porta-potty area.
6. Wash hands as frequently as possible.
7. No handshakes or hugging.
8. Do not touch dogs that are not your own.
9. Bring your own pen/pencil. No common use pencils, pens or markers will be available.
10. Benching spaces must be at least 6 feet / 2 Metres apart. The benching space should be used for each exhibitor or "family" of exhibitors. Exhibitors to bring their own shade tents/screens. All tents must be pegged to the ground and dropped when leaving for the night. Leave your belongings at your own risk, there will be no security on site. Dogs are not to be left on the field overnight. No overnight (people) tenting allowed. You may bench your dogs in your vehicle if you wish ensuring you bring proper shade, ventilation, and water for your dogs. Dogs in vehicles will be monitored and dealt with appropriately if they are deemed to be in distress. You cannot bench on the Calgary Horseshoe property.
11. Exhibitor parking will be in the paved lot of the Calgary Horseshoe club. (See map) There will be NO parking in the gravel parking lot of the Calgary Horseshoe Club. You may also park along 78th Avenue which has easy access to the rings as well.

Information applicable to all participants:

1. The trial will be limited to whatever the current provincial outdoor gathering limits will be at the time of the trial. The limit will apply to entrants, judges, Cal K-9 members and all persons present (including spouse, significant other, family members).
2. Due to COVID restrictions – the judges will be using Routine 1 for both Open and Utility. As well, we shall be utilizing Rally jump heights only to minimize the contact of ring stewards on the equipment. You will see the Rally jump heights on the entry form.
3. Score sheets may or may not be available in printed form. If they are not available, exhibitors may request the opportunity to take a photo of their sheet or have a photo of the same sent to them electronically by the steward, time permitting.
4. There will be a self-serve ribbon and prize table. Exhibitors may pick up their own ribbons, and prizes once rounds are completed. Please only touch what you are taking and be sure to maintain social distancing.
5. The trial secretary's designated space will be considered sacred ground. Barriers will be set up using a 6 Feet / 2 Metre perimeter to protect the trial secretary. Anyone who violates the space of the trial secretary will be asked to leave the trial grounds and may not return for the duration of the trials. No refunds for entries will be provided in this instance.

Trial Practices:

1. Each exhibitor will provide a completed waiver of liability for Cal K-9 and Chinook Schutzhund Club. Waivers will be given to the trial secretary as part of your entry package before the first morning of the trials. No one will be allowed to participate who has not completed the required waiver.
2. Anyone exhibiting COVID symptoms will be asked to leave the trial grounds and will not be allowed to return. No refund will be issued.
3. Please carefully read the CKC's recommended COVID obedience protocols document carefully. There have been some temporary rule changes that will most likely affect you!
3. It is recommended all exhibitors wear a mask except when running a dog in a class or while in their personal benching area. This rule may change with the provincial/city guidelines at the time of the trial. The same might require that the wearing of a mask is mandatory at all times even when trialing your dog.
4. The gate board will be available near the rings for exhibitors to indicate they are present and running in the class. DO NOT TOUCH THE BOARD. A steward will mark you as present and make any run order changes that are needed. A 6 Feet / 2 Metre buffer will be marked around the gate steward.
5. Exhibitors will remove and retrieve their own leashes. A chair or other object will be placed in the ring for the leash.
6. MAINTAIN 6 Feet / 2 Metre SPACING at all times.
7. Equipment will be sanitized at the end of each day and if/when stewards are changed.

- All dogs must be on leash at all times.
- PLEASE pick up after your dogs!
- There will be 2 obedience rings, space to warm up and plenty of benching space. You may also park on 78th Avenue SE and walk onto the show grounds from there. You can bench your dogs in your vehicle as well ensuring proper ventilation, shade, water etc.
- Please stay in your benching area until it is your turn to warm up.
- All CKC COVID obedience protocols, as well as local government rules, will be followed at all times.
