<u>IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ENTERING THIS SHOW!</u>

By submitting entries to this show you are declaring that you agree to the following strictly enforced rules and regulations. Please do not enter this show if you have personal or political reasons for not respecting what we must do to abide by the Alberta Government Covid-19 protocol to keep us all safe.

THIS IS A <u>ONE DAY</u> LEARNING EVENT - Please be kind and patient with us, we are doing this to learn and improve your experience for the future! Blatant abuse or disrespect of our volunteers or show staff will NOT be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the grounds with no refund of fees.

All exhibitors, volunteers, NACA members, and judges will be subject to a pre-screening survey and temperature check using a non-contact forehead thermometer at check-in before being allowed on the grounds. The survey is verbal in nature and we will NOT collect or record any personal information.

Numbers of people tracked and entrants will be stopped at the 200 mark.

We reserve the right to deny access to anyone without proof of entry of an exhibit.

The judging schedule will be set up in order to regulate the number of people on the grounds and will be used to stagger the time of arrivals and departures to maintain Alberta Government guidelines on public gatherings. We ask Exhibitors to arrive on the grounds no earlier than one hour to their exhibit entry time, wherever possible. If there is a Gathering Guideline conflict for the number of exhibitors on the grounds, those who are not on until later times will be asked to leave and return closer to their exhibit time.

All exhibitors will be required to check in at the gate, and:

- ★ Proof of entry will be required to enter print and bring your receipts!
- * Exhibitors are to bring and wear their own masks while on the show grounds, if they do not have a mask, one will be provided
- * Carpooling is discouraged
- * Exhibitor benching will be at their vehicle parking site <u>Exhibitors will be expected to remain in their own benching areas at all times when not showing their exhibits</u>

MASKS: This is an outdoor show – masks are required 100% of the time when on the grounds/in public areas. A mask must be worn at all times while at the show REGARDLESS if you can or cannot social distance. *NOTE: If you have a medical reason for not being able to wear a mask, we kindly ask you to consider your health above all and to reconsider entering and wait for a time where we are able to lift the mask restriction.

Mask do not need to be worn in your Vehicle space area as long as you are able to social distance (6') and/or the people around you are staying with you (cohorts).

Social Distancing must be diligently practiced, and all exhibitors will follow the direction of the stewards, judges and show staff at all times. Nice wins are exciting but please ... no hugs or high-5 celebrations!

Hand washing stations and hand sanitizer will be available to all exhibitors throughout the grounds – USE THEM REGULARLY. The hand sanitizer provided on judges tables is for use of the judge and ring steward ONLY. BE SELF SUFFICIENT: please remember to bring personal face coverings, hand sanitizer, gloves, cleaning wipes, etc. for your own personal use.

Exhibitors may enter more than one dog but all dog entries must provide the name of the designated handler* (under "agent" on the entry form) at the breed level. There will be no switching of dogs, exchanging armbands, etc. – the original handler* must stay on the dog through breed judging – PLAN ACCORDINGLY. *in all cases, handler shall mean the person showing the dog.

In order to maintain public gathering and social distancing guidelines, Exhibitors will be required to remain at their vehicle benching area until 15 minutes prior to the start of their breed entry, at which time:

- ★ They must head directly to the ring numbers will be available for pick up at the ring in order to help the process go smoother... KNOW YOUR ARMBAND NUMBER WHICH WILL BE LOCATED ON YOUR dogshow.ca ENTRY CONFIRMATION once the judging schedule is available. There will be no community catalogue at ring side.
- * No ringside grooming is allowed
- ★ Social Distancing must be practiced, and all exhibitors will follow the direction of the stewards, judges and show staff at all times
- * There will be no ring-side seating allowed.

All Exhibitors will respect barriers, partitions, and directions at all times while on the grounds. Each ring will have a separate entrance and exit. Please use as intended. Do not congregate or block ring entrances and exits.

Once exhibitors are done with showing their entry, they are to immediately return to their vehicle benching area, and leave the show grounds.

* Only those who are to continue to the next level of show or those with different breeds are allowed to remain (i.e. on to group or BIS).

There will be no spectators allowed at this show and no children accompanying parents will be allowed. No "helpers/drivers, etc" allowed – we ask for exhibitor attendance ONLY - one dog, one person only will be allowed on the grounds, the exception being an exhibitor who enters more than one dog but identifies "who will be showing" for all the dogs entered. These people need not arrive in the same vehicle but will be on a list generated by your entries.

No overnight parking allowed. Vehicles will be parked to enable car-side grooming while maintaining physical distancing. Pop-Up tents may be set up in your space if needed. Generators may be set-up at your parking spot but **no forced-air dryers will be allowed, heat only.**

Because of Covid-19 Safety Rules - Exhibitors are required to be self-sufficient while on the grounds...

- ★ No drinks, snacks or food will be provided.
- **★** No power will be provided
- ★ No water or bathing stations will be provided
- ★ No force dryers will be allowed

Because of Covid-19 Safety Rules there will be no Commercial Booths at this show.

THERE WILL BE A ZERO TOLLERANCE POLICY ON COVID-19 VIOLATIONS, INCLUDING NOT WEARING A MASK OR NOT SOCIAL DISTANCING WHEN IT IS POSSIBLE. DEPENDING ON THE LEVEL OF THE VIOLOATION YOU MAY GET A FRIENDLY REMINDER OR YOU MAY BE ASKED TO PACK YOUR STUFF AND LEAVE IMMEDIATELY.

ENTER THIS SHOW AT YOUR OWN RISK

We ask all our Volunteers and Exhibitors to make their own health and safety a priority. NO ONE who is feeling ill, or showing signs of illness, or who has been exposed to someone who is ill should be attending this show or going out in public. Anyone with a probable case of illness shall utilize the on-line assessment tools and health link services to determine their risk and necessary precautions.

AGAIN - Please be DILIGENT - DO NOT attend this show if (in the last 14 days before the show date):

- ★ You have traveled outside of Canada
- **★** You, your child or a cohort have had close unprotected contact with someone who is ill
- ★ You, your child or cohort have been in close unprotected contact with someone who is being investigated, or confirmed to be a case of COVID-19

DO NOT ATTEND if you are experiencing any of the following symptoms:

Fever, Difficulty Breathing, Persistent Cough, Sore Throat, Runny Nose

Exhibitor entry information can be used for contact tracing efforts upon request of the Alberta Government. Information about attendees will only be requested by AB Health if a potential exposure occurs on site.

All Albertans must follow CMOH Order 05-2020, which establishes legal requirements for quarantine and isolation.

- Anyone with symptoms of COVID-19; with a history of international travel in the last 14 days;
- or with close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days must remain at home.

IMPORTANT FOR YOU TO KNOW

If there are changes to the Alberta Government or City of Edmonton protocols and our show must be cancelled <u>all entry fees will be refunded</u> (less c/c service charges).

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS - CKC Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.
- b) In order to protect awards/titles earned, the non-member may EITHER become a CKC member OR pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.

Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made. An error in an age-specified class, date of birth or sex, may be amended up to one hour before the start of the show.

WITHDRAWAL OF ENTRIES

An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing. Rule books are \$6.00 and can be obtained by contacting the Canadian Kennel Club.

Whether you enter by mail, fax, courier, hand-deliver, or on-line, it is important that you include an email address ... you will receive instant acknowledgement of your entry once processed. Open an account at **www.DogShow.ca** (it's free) and check your own entry for accuracy.

The following CKC conformation classes (divided by sex) will be offered:

Junior Puppy: for dogs 6 mths of age but under 9 mths of age. **Senior Puppy**: for dogs 9 mths of age but under 12 mths of age

12-18 Months: for dogs 12 mths of age and under 12 mths of age

Canadian Bred: for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded. **Bred by Exhibitor:** for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder.

Open: for all dogs.

Specials Only: dogs which are registered individually in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club and have attained championship status may be entered in the 'Specials Only' class. Exhibition Only: for all dogs over 6 mths of age and eligible for registration with the CKC (non-competitive class).



ENTRY AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules" and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the Northern Alberta Canine Association has the right to refuse this entry for just cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of entries made in this all-breed show and of the holding of this show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or certificates I (we) agree to hold the Northern Alberta Canine Association, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or show secretaries, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

All participants attend this show at their own risk and agree to hold the Northern Alberta Canine Association, the Oilfield Technology Society, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, and volunteers harmless in case of accident, injury or illness including any and all issues connected to or with the Coronavirus (Covid-19.) I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times on the show grounds.
- The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of this show which will be governed by CKC rules.
- A judge officiating at this show held under CKC rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. (4.7.1)
- A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent (5.1.6)
- There is to be NO SMOKING in the show ring area.
- Dogs must be on the show grounds 1/2 hour prior to judging of their breed. No one will be allowed on the grounds until the times
 indicated in the judging schedule, the exception being those with dogs in multi-groups who must remain in their vehicles until required for
- No abuse of show personnel, NACA members or volunteers will be tolerated!!

In order for a dog to be recognized as a Champion and its owner provided with a Championship certificate, the dog must:

- (a) earn at least ten (10) championship points under at least three different judges and.
- (b) be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number or a Miscellaneous Certification Number.
- (c) have earned at least one 2-point win either at the breed or group level.
