GENERAL INFORMATION

PAYMENT: Please make all cheques or money orders payable to: **"Forbidden Plateau Obedience & Tracking Club"**. **"**A listing fee as established by The Canadian Kennel Club must accompany the entry of a dog for which a Canadian Kennel Club individual registration number or Event Registration Number (ERN) is not shown on the entry form.

US EXHIBITORS: US Entrants may pay fees by a money order made payable in Canadian funds or a personal cheque in US funds for the full amount of the fee(s). Personally discounted cheques will not be accepted. Please DO NOT mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "at par" as these are not readily cleared by the banks. Tendering a NSF or post-dated cheque will be considered as non-payment of fee(s) and will subject the maker of the cheque to a \$15.00 "handling fee" and disciplinary action by CKC.

ENTRY & ALTERNATES: Due to the limited entry we shall be accepting entries by **CANADA POST MAIL ONLY**, with only **ONE** entry per envelope. Express Post is accepted. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Courier delivery of any kind is NOT accepted. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** Entrants will be notified by phone or email that their entry has been received. Entry fees will be returned within 10 days of the test to Alternates who did not participate in the test.

DRAW FOR ENTRY: A random drawing of all entries received by the closing date and time will take place to determine placement in the test or on the Alternate list. The drawing will be at 6:30 pm on Tuesday, October 24th, 2017 at the home of the Test Secretary, 8575 Reinhold Rd., Black Creek, BC.

CLUB WORKER OPTION: At the entry draw, two UTD tracks and one UTDX track will be reserved as per CKC Rule 6.6.2. "Club Worker" is defined by FPO&TC Policy.

MEETING PLACE AND DRAW: Rendezvous is scheduled for **7:30 am each morning (November 11th and November 12th) at Tim Horton's, 789 Ryan Rd., Courtenay, BC (beside Superstore),** where the draw for tracks will take place. Any primary entrant(s) not present at this time will forfeit their position to the first Alternate present.

BITCHES IN SEASON: Bitches in season may compete; however, they will run last. Please advise the Test Secretary upon arrival.

GALLERY: In Urban Tracking the gallery may follow the dog and handler, but must obey the accompanying Marshal's instructions.

AWARDS AND NO-HOST LUNCHEON: A no-host luncheon will be held following the tracking test at which time the Judge will present ribbons to all the successful teams. The club will also award keepsake trophies to those same teams.

REFUNDS: When an entered dog is withdrawn after the closing date, refunds will **only** be permitted when the vacancy is accepted by an "Alternate". If a position becomes available, Alternates will be contacted in catalogue order and asked to either accept or decline the position. (ie. if #1 declines #2 will be contacted, etc.)

Rule 14.7: It shall be the duty and obligation of the test-giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Tracking Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

Effective January 1, 2011 Non-Member Participation Fee

- A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of CKC.
- The Non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- In order for the title to be award, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the nonmember participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- All Premium Lists will carry a not stating the fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.
