# Thank you for coming on this adventure with us!

Your safety is our #1 concern so please follow all the rules you accepted when entering this show-we advise you to print off and read the flyer available at dogshow.ca under the NACA show file.

Wash your hands, stay in your bubble, and help us prove that a show is possible when everyone is committed to making it work. And, in two weeks send us a message on our FB page letting us know that you are healthy and very happy to have had a dog show!

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING ACCESSING THIS SHOW SITE

We selected this venue as it is totally fenced and locked and we are therefore able to control the number of people on the grounds as per Alberta Health Services protocol. As stated in the entry rules, the only people allowed to enter the grounds are those showing dogs – no spectators, no drivers, no children. The beautiful grounds of OTS are a tribute to our Alberta heritage – an Oilfield Technology Museum – and we ask you to respect this site by cleaning up after your dogs, putting garbage in cans, and cleaning up your parking site before leaving.

## DO NOT USE GOOGLE MAPS FOR DIRECTIONS

New-home construction around OTS Centennial Park has meant that streets have changed or disappeared. Follow these directions and you should have no problems:

From Anthony Henday Drive East or West turn south onto Rabbit Hill Road, travel south to lights on Ellerslie Road, go through <u>lights</u> and take the 2<sup>nd</sup> left onto Glenridding Ravine Road, follow around to 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue where you will turn left (sign says no exit), proceed to end of the road, turn right and travel down 156 Street to OTS. PLEASE KEEP YOUR VEHICLE TO THE FAR RIGHT ON THIS NARROW ROAD SO THAT VEHICLES TRAVELLING IN THE OTHER DIRECTION MAY GET BY YOU.

You will be stopped at the gate, your name crossed off the AGENTS list, your temperature will be taken, you will be asked some safety questions, you will be issued a wrist band and will then be escorted to a parking space. Be self-sufficient – bring your own personal use mask, sanitizer, water, snack/lunch, chair, writing utensil (avoid common use pens/pencils). No hand shaking/hugging, avoid touching dogs that are not your responsibility. Social Distancing 2 meters-6 feet is mandatory. No dog bathing facility available. No food vendors or commercial booths will be at this show. Portable toilets on the grounds.

NEW!! For those who have not been able to make arrangements to get your dog to their handler prior to the show - you will be allowed onto the show grounds, you will have your temperature taken and will be escorted to your handlers set-up, YOU MUST STAY IN YOUR VEHICLE AT ALL TIMES while the handler removes the dog, and then you must leave the grounds immediately! This same procedure will be followed if you return a second time.

Each ring will have an Entrance, an Exit and Social Distancing Markers. Exhibitors will pick up their armbands at the ring Entrance – no community catalogue will be available, know your armband number before coming to the show. Do not leave personal items at ringside. There will be no ringside viewing of judging. Exhibitors will pick up their placement ribbons as they exit the rings. NO RECYCLING of ribbons. Ring grooming tables will be cleaned frequently. Hand sanitizer on judges table is for the use of the judge and stewards only.

Prepaid catalogues will be available at the Show Secretary table, south of the building.
