Eligibility to Compete - To be eligible to compete in these trials, the dog must be 6 months of age and registered or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN or a CKC Miscellaneous Certificate number. A dog may be spayed, neutered or debarked.

Rally Obedience Classes offered - All regular classes will be offered.

Rally Obedience Information - The precinct of the trials is the interior large barn hall building only.

Rally Obedience Trophy List - Flat ribbons for all qualifying scores will be given. Rosettes for qualifying First placement for Novice A and Novice B, Advanced A and Advanced B and Excellent A and Excellent B.

Bitches in season - Bitches in season are not permitted to compete under C.K.C. Rules. We will refund all entry and listing fees if a bitch comes into season after closing date, upon presentation of a veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10-day period preceding the trials. This certificate must be delivered to or reach the Trial Secretary before the trial commences.

Important Notice to Rally Obedience Exhibitors - There is no limitation on the number of trials at which a dog may be entered as a 'listed dog', except that a dog which has obtained three qualifying scores at obedience trials held under C.K.C. rules, may not continue to compete at licensed obedience trials held under the Club's rules until the dog is registered individually with the C.K.C. Foreign born and owned dogs, please refer to Event Registration Number (ERN) information listed elsewhere.

Rally Obedience Trial Rules and Regulations - The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club. Chapter 3 - Section 3.5.1 of the Rally Obedience Rules and Regulations states: A judge officiating at a trial held under these rules shall not be subjected to indignities of any kind during the progress of the trial. It shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the trial to see that this rule is effectively carried out.

Moving Up - A dog that is registered in the records of the CKC or has a PEN, an ERN or a MCN and has fulfilled the requirements for a title in accordance with the rules may be moved to the next level of competition. The transfer must be submitted to the trial secretary on the appropriate move-up form by the owner or handler one hour before the opening of the first trial on that day, schedule permitting.

To comply with CKC regulations, no entries may be accepted, altered, cancelled or substituted after the official closing date and time for entries except for as provided in the CKC Rules. These events held under the rules of The Canadian Kennel Club.

If no CKC individual registration number, an E.R.N. or a P.E.N. is required and must appear on the entry form. A listing fee of \$10.00 per entry is also required.

NSF Cheques: Tendering of a dishonoured cheque for entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees, and is an offence punishable by disciplinary action and cancellation of awards (6.3.3 of the Obedience Trial Rules & Regulations)

All fees include H.S.T. and must be paid in Canadian Funds. USA Exhibitors we require money orders in Canadian funds, negotiable in Canada.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee / Non-member participation fee - An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be canceled. The Premium List must carry a note stating that "these fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.
