OBEDIENCE TRIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Exhibitor is responsible for knowing and complying with the Obedience Rules and Regulations of the Canadian Kennel Club

Chapter 19 – Section 19.7 of the Obedience Rules and Regulations states: It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.

6.5.2 **Bitches in Season** are not permitted to compete. When a bitch comes into season after entry of the bitch has been submitted to the trial secretary, a veterinarian's certificate, certifying that the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, must be submitted to the trial secretary on or before the date of the trial. A refund of the entry fee, service charge and listing fee will be given

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Muskoka District Kennel Club will use care and diligence for the welfare of all dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liabilities in the event of an accident or other mishap, however caused, to either dog or exhibitor. A dog shall not be touched without the permission of the owner or agent.
2. Only dogs entered in Trials will be permitted in the Trial Building.
3. Trial start times will be indicated on the judging schedule.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER

Effective Jan. 1/92, all dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN). The ERN number MUST be applied for within 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC event. Fee is \$58.50 per dog after Jan. 1/12 plus applicable taxes. Please contact CKC for further info.

USA EXHIBITORS

Bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian Funds and personal cheques will be accepted, however, they must be payable in US funds and for the full amount of the entry. Personally discounted cheques will not be honoured. Please do not mark personal cheques Payable in Canadian Funds or At Par as such items are not readily cleared through the banks. Your co-operation is appreciated.

NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE - Effective January 1, 2011:

- a) A non-member participation fee will be charged to a resident of Canada who is a non-member of the CKC. The fee will be \$57.60 plus applicable taxes
- b) The non-member participation fee is paid in any year a title is earned and covers all titles and dogs owned by that individual.
- c) In order for the title to be awarded, the non-member will have a choice to either become a CKC member or pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will result in the title being withheld and the dog cannot be moved up to the next level.
- d) The fee applies only to dogs wholly owned by non-member residents of Canada and is not applicable to CKC members.
