There will be NO late or day of show entries accepted.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all public health restrictions for travel and social gatherings at the time of the event will dictate access and/or cancellation of the event.

All participants must sign the COVID-19 Waiver prior to participation in the event.

Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of your participation and entry fee.

Face coverings must be worn and social distance must be maintained.

Schedule

As per BHA COVID-19 Rules, the **General Briefing** will be emailed as part of the entry confirmation, as well as posted within the building on the day of the trial.

Classes Offered: Instinct, Novice, Open, Senior, Master

- 🐾 Judges are limited to 8 hours of judging and a maximum run value, which will require this club to limit entries accordingly.
- 🐾 Dogs will be run in height order with dogs being handled by the same person separated into different staged groups.
- 🐾 Judge of Record and Event Official dogs may be judged prior to the official start time or as the first blind(s) of the Event.

Entry Information

- 🐾 Dogs are not required to have a Barn Hunt Registration # for the Fun Test.
- 🐾 Dogs may be entered in more than one class in a fun test. This is the only time that dogs can be entered in multiple classes in a barn hunt event. Each dog will be limited to 3 entries.
- 🐾 No toys or food will be permitted in the ring.
- 🐾 Entries will be accepted by mail, in-person and by email. Cheque, cash or e-transfers are acceptable forms of payment. An entry is not considered valid until payment is received.
- 🐾 A returned cheque does not constitute a valid entry. A \$50.00 fee applies for all returned cheques. All dogs must be on a short leash and under control while on trial grounds except while showing. FLEXI LEASHES ARE NOT PERMITTED ON SITE.
- 🐾 Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or a person may be dismissed from the trial if justification is found to do so by the judge and/or the trial committee.
- 🐾 The safety of the dogs and the rats are our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and physically able to perform all course elements

Withdrawal and Refund Information

- 🐾 **Withdrawing due to COVID-19:** Attendees who enter a scheduled Event but then must withdraw due to suspected or confirmed COVID-19 or direct exposure to/close contact with a COVID-19 patient will receive a full refund minus a Club administration fee.
- 🐾 **Refunds** offered only for injured or sick dogs with veterinary note. Requests for refunds must be made by the closing date. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.
- 🐾 **Bitches in season** are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until closing time of the trial if you wish to withdraw. After the trial closes, entry fees will not be refunded. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the trial
- 🐾 **Cancellation Policy:** Every attempt will be made to hold this event as scheduled. In the event of changes to Provincial/Local COVID-19 restrictions, or an "Act of God" such as fire, flood, etc., the event may be cancelled. We will make every attempt to contact entrants and inform them of the cancellation. Entry fees will be refunded as appropriate.

Event Grounds / Ring / Blind Information

- 🐾 Please pick-up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers on site.
- 🐾 Event grounds include the private property located at 4500 Fairgrounds Road, Severn, ON specifically Building 3, parking lot and surrounding grass areas. Training building is accessible from Gate 2 only. Event grounds are handicapped/wheelchair accessible. Ample parking available. Ring is located indoors with cement floor, enclosed with 4' snow fence.
- 🐾 Blind area is 10'x20' and is located 20' from the ring gate. Each competitor will be assigned a numbered chair corresponding to their number in the blind. Competitors must stay in their numbered chair, not move their chair around, and exit the blind in order, not crossing the path of another competitor. Competitors must wash their hands just prior to entering the blind, and wash their hands as soon as possible after leaving the ring.
Competitors are encouraged to crate out of cars. **There will be NO INDOOR CRATING.**
- 🐾 Please bring adequate water for you and your dogs.
- 🐾 There are limited restaurant options near the trial. A portable washroom will be available at the trial site.
