All Regular Classes.....	\$32

Day of Entries.....	\$40

Day of trial entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. Entries must be made at least 60 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of each trial. Entry fee is \$40 per class – payable in cash only.

All entries must contain complete information as required by CKC rules. All entries must be accompanied by the entry fee, in full, and all listing fees where applicable. A listing fee as established by the CKC must accompany the entry of a dog for which a CKC individual registration number is not shown on the entry form or ERN notice.

CKC Non-Member Participation Fee (24-1-23) a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee. b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled. c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by Canadian resident non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members. Please note that the CKC Membership Application and the Non-Member Participation Fee forms are available on the CKC website, <http://www.ckc.ca> under CKC Services, then Forms Online. If submitting a membership application, please ensure that you also complete the Non-Member Participation Fee form so that we are aware of the dogs involved.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or the Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because it has been entered incorrectly. If because of riot, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the

Club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries will be made. Overpayments will not be refunded.

- ENTRY FEES WILL BE REFUNDED WHEN A BITCH ENTERED IN THESE TRIALS COMES INTO SEASON after entry of the bitch has been submitted, if a veterinarian's certificate (certifying that the bitch was in season within the ten day period preceding the trial) is delivered to the Trial Secretary on or before the date of the trial.
- ENTRIES MUST BE TYPED OR CLEARLY PRINTED. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms. The ACDCC does not assume any responsibility for incorrect information or errors due to illegibility of information on any entry form.
- ENTRIES WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED BY EMAIL. Receipts, judging schedules, and armband numbers will be available at www.dogshow.ca.
- ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL AT ALL TIMES. If not in competition, the dog must wear a collar and be on a leash a maximum of 6' or appropriately confined in the benching area.
- DOGS MUST BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.
- ALL EMPTY RINGS ARE TO BE KEPT FREE OF DOGS.
- AN EXHIBITOR HAS THE RIGHT TO WITHDRAW AN ENTRY. This Notice of Withdrawal must be in writing and received by the Trial Secretary on or before the official closing date and time as published in the premium list.
- ALL MISCELLANEOUS LISTED BREED DOGS MUST HAVE A CKC MISCELLANEOUS CERTIFICATION NUMBER PRIOR TO ENTERING ANY CKC EVENT. • ALL MIXED BREED DOGS AND CKC UNRECOGNIZED BREEDS MUST HAVE A CKC CANINE COMPANION NUMBER (CCN) PRIOR TO ENTERING ANY CKC EVENT. • PERFORMANCE EVENT NUMBER (PEN) ALLOWS an un-registerable dog of a CKC recognized breed to participate in competitive events that are appropriate for the breed. For more information or to apply for a PEN, visit www.ckc.ca. These dogs must have a PEN number prior to entering any CKC event.
- THE AUSTRALIAN CATTLE DOG CLUB OF CANADA, its members and volunteers will use due care and diligence for the welfare of the exhibitors and dogs, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or other misfortune to either dogs, exhibitors, or patrons.
- IN TRANSIT PERMITS WILL BE AVAILABLE from the Trial Secretary if needed. Dogs not entered in the trials in regular classes or exhibition only will not be permitted in the building without an In Transit Permit.
- THE TRIAL SUPERINTENDENT HAS THE AUTHORITY to expel any dog deemed to be a danger to other dogs or people. There will be no refund for dogs that are expelled. CKC Obedience Trial rules - 20.7 " It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial-giving club to see that a judge, club official, ring steward, volunteer, or competitor at an Obedience Trial held under these regulations, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Obedience Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any

infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred.”

It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to know the CKC rules governing rally trials.

Official Classes

Rally obedience ring size 50 x 60

The following CKC Rally Obedience Classes will be offered:

All regular rally obedience classes (Novice A, Novice B, Intermediate, Advanced A, Advanced B, Excellent A, Excellent B, Masters).

To be eligible to compete in these rally obedience trials, the dog must be at least 6 months old and registered, or be eligible for registration with the CKC, have an ERN, PEN, CCN or a CKC miscellaneous certificate number. A dog may be spayed or neutered.

Additional Information

There will be limited indoor benching available at no charge. Exhibitors may set up 1 hour prior to the start of the first trial (May 31).
