

CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS:

Section 15.1.1. A dog awarded WINNERS at a championship show held under these Dog Show Rules shall be credited with a number of championship points (ranging from 0-5) and the determination of the number of championship points to be credited to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as provided hereunder.

Section 2. The schedule to be employed in the determination of the number of points to be allocated to a dog awarded WINNERS shall be as follows:

*Dogs Competing	1	2	3-5	6-9	10-12	13 and over
Points Allocated	0	1	2	3	4	5

*includes dog awarded winners.

In counting the number of eligible dogs in competition a dog that is disqualified, dismissed, excused or ordered from the ring by the judge shall NOT be included in the calculations for Championship points.

In order for a dog to be issued a CKC Championship Certificate the dog must: earn at least 10 Championship points under at least 3 (three) different judges, be individually registered in the records of the CKC or have an Event Registration Number, and have earned at least one 2 (two) point win at the breed or group level.

ENTRY AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the “CKC Dog Show Rules” and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that Lhasa Apso Canada has the right to refuse this entry for just cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of entries made in these all-breed shows, obedience trials, agility trials or any of the associated Specialties, and of the holding of these shows and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Northern Alberta Canine Association and associated Specialty Clubs, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, or show secretaries, and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club(s) or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in these shows and trials, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.

SWEEPSTAKES

JUVENILE SWEEPSTAKES

As per CKC rules, all dogs entered in these sweepstakes must be entered in a regular official class at this specialty show, with the exception of the 3-6 month puppies who must also be entered in Exhibition Only 3-6 months.

Classes will be divided males and females in the following age categories:

3-6 months 6-9 months 9-12 months 12-18 months

The winners of all eight classes will compete for Best in Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes. Rosettes will be provided for 1st to 4th place in each class. The club will retain 25% of the entry fees collected for expenses, the remaining fees will be awarded as follows:

1st in each class – 30% of entry fee for that class
2nd in each class – 20% of entry fee for that class
Best in Sweepstakes – 15% and a rosette
Best of Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes – 10% and a rosette

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

As per CKC rules, all veterans entered in these sweepstakes must be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition only. Spayed or neutered dogs may compete provided they are also entered in Exhibition Only or the official Veterans class.

Classes will be divided males and females in the following age categories:

7-10 years 11+ years

The winners of all four classes will compete for Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex in Veterans Sweepstakes. The remaining fees will be awarded as follows:

1st in each class – 15% of entry fee for that class
2nd in each class – 15% of entry fee for that class
Best in Veteran Sweepstakes – 25% and a rosette
Best of Opposite Sex in Veterans Sweepstakes – 20% and a rosette

RULES GOVERNING THESE SHOWS

1. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times on the show grounds or within the show building.
2. The Club reserves the right to remove any person from the show. The Show Superintendent shall have full control of these shows and trials, which will be governed by CKC rules.
3. ANYONE PARKING IN THE FIRE LANES OR OTHER AREAS DESIGNATED AS “OFF LIMITS” WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE SHOW.
4. A judge officiating at this show held under CKC rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show. (4.7.1)
5. A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent (5.1.6)
6. There is to be NO SMOKING in the large show tent, nor entrances to it, and NO SMOKING is allowed in the show building.
7. Dogs must be on the show grounds 1 hour prior to judging of their breed.
8. All vehicles are left on the show grounds at your own risk. No security is provided.

For the benefit of the health of the animals, and the pleasure of the exhibitors and spectators, we insist upon keeping our grounds as clean as possible. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs and for maintaining a clean camping/benching area. Please report any areas that require cleaning to the N.A.C.A. show office. Thank you!

Foreign born and foreign owned dogs may compete with an **Event Registration Number (ERN)**. This must be obtained within 30 days of obtaining points, awards or scores to avoid cancellation and can be obtained by submitting a copy of your foreign certificate of registration and a fee of \$62.37 with a letter of request to the CKC. This ERN replaces a CKC individual registration number for entering events only.

ATTENTION CANADIAN EXHIBITORS WHO ARE NOT CKC MEMBERS NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION FEE

CLASSIFICATION:

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Junior Puppy:	dogs 6 months of age/under 9 months
Senior Puppy:	dogs 9 months of age/under 12 months
12- 18 month:	dogs 12 months of age/under 18 months
Canadian Bred:	dogs born in Canada, champions in any country excluded
Bred by Exhibitor:	dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder
Open:	for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC
Veterans:	for any dog 7 years or older on the day of the show. This class is divided by ages 7-10 years and 11+ years.

*Note: Veterans dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. **DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.***

Specials Only: dogs which are **registered individually** in the records of the Canadian Kennel Club or have an ERN (Event Registration Number) and have attained championship status may be entered in the "Specials Only" Class. Entry of a dog in "Specials Only" is not prohibited on the grounds that the title of champion has not been confirmed by the C.K.C., but if it is found later that the dog had not attained championship status before the entry had been made, then all awards attained at the show will be cancelled. The entry of a "Listed Dog" in this class is NOT allowed.

Exhibition Only: for all dogs over 6 months of age and eligible for registration with the CKC (this is a catalogue listing only.)

Exhibition Only 3 – 6 months: for dogs 3 months of age and under 6 months of age on the day of the show (catalogue listing only but may compete in Puppy Sweeps).

NON-REGULAR & UNOFFICIAL CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following additional Non-Regular / Unofficial classes will be offered. Any dog entered in these classes **MUST** also be entered in one of the regular classes or for Exhibition Only

Non-Regular / Unofficial Classes

Sire & Get:	Stud dog and two of his get, not necessarily owned by the same owner.
Dam & Progeny:	Brood bitch and two of her progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.
Brace:	For 2 dogs of the same breed (not necessarily the same sex). A brace must be handled by 1 person on 1 lead (two dogs are considered one entry).
